Lima, April 23, 2024

Peru: The General Index of the BVL ended today's session with a positive result of +0.52%. The index maintains a positive annual cumulative trend of +7.48% in local currency and a positive cumulative trend of +7.43% in dollar-adjusted currency. Regarding the S&P/BVL Perú SEL changed by +0.61% while the S&P/BVL LIMA 25 changed by +0.52%. The PEN spot reached S/.3.6924. **Headline:**New withdrawal of AFP funds: a boost to the real estate market?

Chile: The IPSA index ended the day with a positive return of +1.47%. The sectors that benefited the most from the day were Consumer Discretionary (+2.50%) and Materials (+2.36%). The stocks with the best performance were BANCO DE CHILE (+3.46%) and CIA SUD AMERICANA DE VAPORES (+3.44%). **Headline:** Chileans have accounts abroad for more than 32 billion USD and the SII begins an inspection plan.

Colombia: The COLCAP index concluded the session with a positive return of +0.28%. The most benefiting sectors of the day were Financials (+0.69%) and Energy (+0.69%). The stocks with the best performance were GRUPO DE INV SURAMERICANA (+4.89%) and CELSIA SA ESP (+3.36%). **Headline:** Ban100 and Chubb announce alliance to increase financial inclusion in Colombia

Mexico: The IPC index closed the day in positive territory with +0.14%. The sectors that benefited the most from the day were Industry (+5.70%) and discretionary consumption (+1.73%). The stocks with the best performance were GRUPO AEROPORT DEL PACIFIC-B (+10.59%) and GRUPO AEROPORTUARIO DEL CENT+6.31%). **Headline:** Mexican peso recovers ground due to weakening of the dollar

Brazil: The IBOVESPA index closed the day in negative territory of -0.34%. The most affected sectors of the day were technology (-1.56%) and Materials (-1.33%). The stocks with the worst performance were USINAS SIDER MINAS (-13.91%) and MAGAZINE LUIZA (-5.88%). **Headline:** Lira, Bolsonaro, spending cuts and Petrobras: Lula's seven messages in a coffee with journalists

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WORLD

United States:

The US market closed with positive returns. The DOW JONES closed with gains as US stocks maintained their upward trajectory on Tuesday, building on the positive momentum from the previous session. Market sentiment was boosted by optimism surrounding earnings reports. The S&P 500 index ended with positive returns as earnings from several companies, including GM, GE Aerospace, PepsiCo, UPS, and Lockheed Martin, exceeded expectations, contributing to the upbeat mood. Additionally, Tesla (1.9%) and Visa (0.7%) are expected to release their quarterly results after the market close. Finally, the NASDAQ index finished the day in positive territory, following corporate news. Danaher's stocks surged 7.1% after the company reported better-than-expected earnings and revenue. UPS added 2.2%, General Motors' stocks rose 4.6%, and GE Aerospace soared 7.5% following positive results. Thus, DOW JONES +0.69%, S&P 500 +1.20%, NASDAQ +1.59% with the market posting positive returns.

Europe:

Major European indices closed with positive returns. The pan-European STOXX 600 index closed with gains as investors digested Eurozone PMI data and a series of earnings reports. The latest survey revealed better-than-expected output growth in April, the fastest in almost a year, driven by the services sector. In the UK market, the FTSE index closed the session in positive territory, as upbeat corporate gains offset a slight pullback in hopes for looser monetary policy in the wake of a strong domestic PMI. AB Foods led gains with a 9% rise after announcing that profits rose at its key retail arm, Primark, and its sugar division in the first quarter. Similarly, the Germ an market closed in the green as investors braced for crucial U.S. inflation data on Wednesday and the key European Central Bank meeting on Thursday. The U.S. inflation rate is expected to rise slightly for the second month in a row, which could signal, along with strength in the labor market, a less immediate need for the Federal Reserve to cut interest rates. In the French market, the session closed similarly in the green, as investors digested the latest Eurozone PMI figures along with a series of corporate reports. The release of results from the European banking and US technology sectors was also eagerly awaited. The latest PMI survey for April revealed stronger-than-expected output growth in the euro zone, reaching its fastest pace in almost a year, with activity in Germany expanding for the first time in 10 months. Thus, FTSE 100 +0.26%; CAC 40 +0.81%; DAX +1.55%; STOXX 600 +1.09% closed with positive performances.

Asia:

The main Asian indices closed with mixed performances. The Chinese market closed lower, given the negative impact on investor sentiment due to the lack of new supportive policies. On the other hand, the People's Bank of China maintained interest rates after better-than-expected GDP figures for the first quarter and measures to stabilize the yuan. In the face of this, the signs only indicated that monetary policy easing was long overdue. At the moment, investors' concerns are directed towards the upcoming April manufacturing and services sector data. On the other hand, the Hang Seng index ended with gains, driven by more than 3% growth in technology stocks. The South Korean market ended with negative results. Investors are now focused on the upcoming first quarter results of major companies. In more local news, annual producer inflation rose to 1.6% in March, reaching the highest level since April 2023. Also, the Japanese market closed higher, while following the rally in technology stocks on Wall Street, as concerns over Middle East conflicts dissipated. The Bank of Japan's policy decisions are expected this week, but it is under pressure to raise rates again due to persistent inflation and the depreciation of the yen. The Australian market ended positive, after investors processed data indicating that private sector activity in Australia reached its highest point in two years in April, while manufacturing activity showed signs of being almost stable. Thus, NIKKEI +0.30%; HANG SENG +1.92%; CSI 300 -0.70%; S&P/ASX 200 +0.45%; KOSPI -0.24%, SHANGHAI COMPOSITE -0.74% ended with mixed performances.




