



Global Overview:

United States:


The US stock market closed the session with mixed results among its main indices. The indexes that closed higher were driven by a rebound in financial sector stocks, although gains were limited by new geopolitical concerns after President Donald Trump tweeted a strong warning to Iran. The S&P 500 rose + 0.18%, led by the shares of Hasbro Inc. that rose + 12.89% after reporting second quarter results that exceeded forecasts, also the financial sector boosted the index thanks to the rebound of IP Morgan Chase (+16.89) and Bank of America + 2.069%, For its part, the Nasdaq index rose + 0.28%, while the Dow Jones industrial fell -0.06%. Currently, the 10-year treasury benchmark rate stood at 2,957%, compared to 2,884% on Friday. As for oil, it settled down on Monday, yielding previous gains, as the market played down rhetoric between the United States and Iran, which boosted the potential for global supplies. Expectations of higher profits in OPEC production and its allies and a possible slowdown in world oil demand put more pressure on oil.

Europe:

The European market finished the day on Monday with negative results among its main indices due to the global tensions of the weekend. The FTSE100 of the United Kingdom closed downwards with -0.30%, while France the CAC40 closed at -0.37% and the regional index Euro Stoxxs600 fell -0.19%. Shares of carmakers Flat and Ferrari fell -1.50% and -4.88% respectively, after it became known that the company's leader, Sergio Machionne, considered a legend in the field, stepped aside due to health problems. This increased the Italian losses and the FTSE MIB closed at -0.37%, one of the biggest losses in the region. The weekend concluded the meeting of the ministers of economy and central bankers of the C20 countries, where it was said that geopolitical tensions pose risks that endanger global economic growth, however, for the moment it remains robust. The president of the European Commission will be in Washington on Wednesday to discuss with the president of the United States his tariff policies, after the secretary of the American Treasury said that the European Union has to eliminate part of its tariffs before being able to debate the issue.

The Asian stock market finished the day with mixed results among its main indices. Japanese stocks were the worst performers in the face of a decline in the US dollar, added to renewed commercial concerns that ended up slowing the market's advance. The Nikkel index of Japan fell -1.33% with a stronger yen which harms the exporters more. The Yen began to recover on Friday showing a new momentum on Monday after Reuters' weekend reports on possible policy adjustments to be discussed at the Bank of Japan. On the other hand, Japanese bond yields were higher after rumors of a rise in interest rates by the Central Bank of Japan increased, as part of the modification of its stimulus program. This was interpreted to mean that the bank would be taking away support for its economy faster than expected. The performance of the bonds reached its maximum in the last 6 months and the yen was recovering, closing at -0.03%. In the case of South Korea, the SEU index fell -0.87% caused by a fall of the giant Samsung (-2.00%), while the shares of Korea Electric Power and the giant Posco rose + 1.97% and +3.59% respectively.


