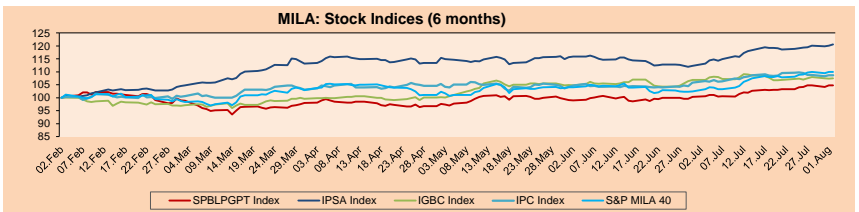
### MILA

**Peru:** The General Index of the Peruvian BVL ended the session today with a positive result of +0.04%. The index maintains an accumulated annual positive trend of +8.20% in local currency, while the adjusted performance in foreign currency is +12.08%. Then, the S&P/BVL Peru SEL obtained a negative performance of -0.14%, while the S&P/BVL LIMA 25 grew +0.36%. The spot PEN reached S/ 3.2395.

**Chile:** The IPSA index ended the day with a positive return of +0.39%. The index sectors with the results on the rise were Industrial (+2.23%) and Basic Products (+0.75%). On the other hand, the values with the most positive results were LAN Airlines SA (+3.31%) and Sociedad de Inversiones Oro Blanco SA (+3.25%).

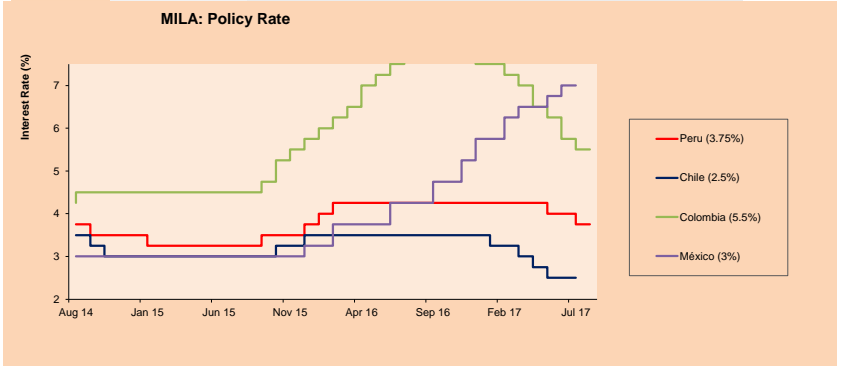
**Colombia:** The COLCAP index closed the day with a positive yield of +0.20%. The index sectors with the results on the rise were Industrial (+0.99%) and Energy (+0.67%). Finally, the shares with the highest yields were Concreto SA (+3.35%) and Argos SA (+1.03%).

**Mexico:** The Mexican IPC index closed today with a positive result of + 0.01%. The index sectors that generated the highest returns were Telecommunications services (+ 0.70%) and Finance (+ 0.70%). Finally, the shares with the highest yields were OHL Mexico SAB de CV (+ 4.47%) and Grupo Financiero Banorte SAB de CV (+ 2.08%).

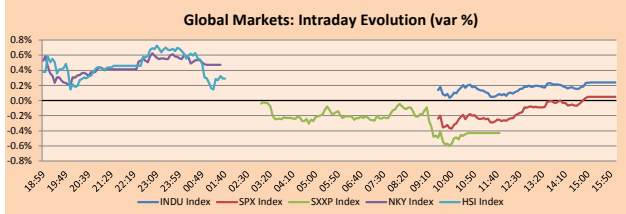

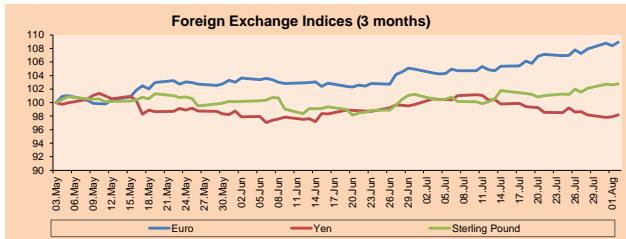

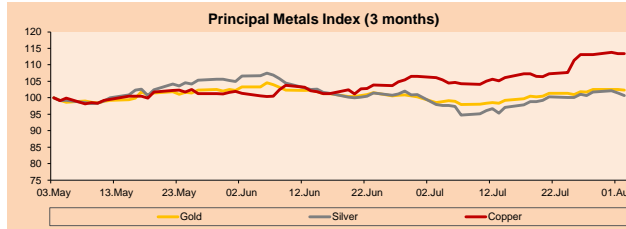

## Global Overview

### United States:

The US stock market ended today's session with mixed results among its main indices. So far, Wall Street remains solidly higher in 2017. But as gains have been reaching record highs, worries have arisen over valuations. An example that reflects this is Apple, which has been one of the biggest winners in the market. From the beginning of this year until today, the yield to date it has had is of 36%. This has led to the possibility that the valuations of stocks related to the technology sector are justified by their levels of growth. Referring to the US dollar, today it fell to a minimum in 15 months after data was published on contracting in the private sector, which were lower than expected. On the other hand, the president of the Federal Reserve of the United States (FED) of Cleveland, Loretta Mester, affirmed that the FED must maintain its slow rhythm of adjustment, still with the soft inflation that is being witnessed. Investors will also be watching the conference to be hosted by San Francisco FED President, John Williams, in the afternoon, in Las Vegas.

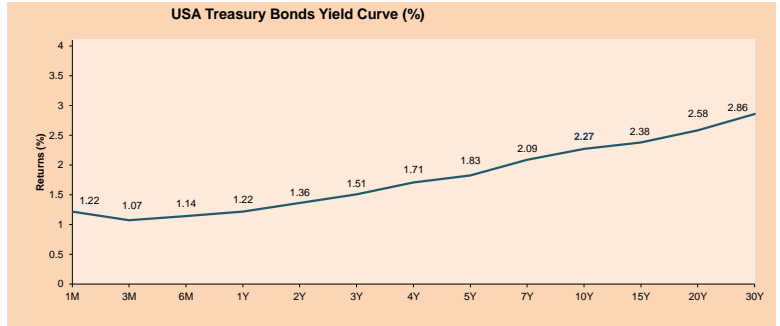
### Europe:

The European stock market ended the session with negative results as banks fell after France's Societe Generale SA posted a decline in profit and metal-related stocks declined following an upgrade of Rio Tinto PLC. On the other hand, Standard Chartered PLC's negative news about dividends triggered a liquidation in the shares of the lender, which added to the pressure on the market barometer, the company fell -6.05%, which was due to the statements in which he claims he is not ready to start paying dividends again, but will reconsider later this year. The Asia-focused bank, which has been working to readjust its business after a slowdown in growth, posted an increase in earnings and income for the first half. On the British side, commodity stocks ended negative after Rio Tinto PLC mine posted underlying gains that fell below expectations. Finally, another factor that caused the fall of the European market was the appreciation of the pound sterling, which rose against the dollar + 0.14% quoting \$ 1.3225, causing a fall to multinationals listed on the London Stock Exchange.

### Asia:

The Asian stock market closed the day with mixed results among its main indices. With regard to India, the Central Bank cut its main lending rate by a quarter of a percentage point as inflation and economic growth slow for the country. The monetary policy committee reduced its repurchase rate from 6.25% to 6%, as predicted by economists surveyed by The Wall Street Journal. The Central Bank also reduced the rate at which it borrows money from commercial banks (the reverse repurchase rate) by 0.25 percentage points to 5.75%. As consumer price inflation slowed to 1.5% in June, below the expected 2% of the Central Bank target. In addition, economists expect the central bank to reduce the rate by another 0.25 percentage in the next year. On the other hand, Chinese bonds increase demand, as foreign institutions bought about 37.8 billion yuan of debt. Purchases increased for the fifth consecutive month. This improves the outlook for the yuan for the next few months. In addition, Hong Kong stocks peaked at two-year high thanks to the official drive to reduce financial leverage. The Hang Seng index advanced +0.2% to close at 27,607.38. While the Shanghai Composite Index fell -0.2% to end at 3,300.

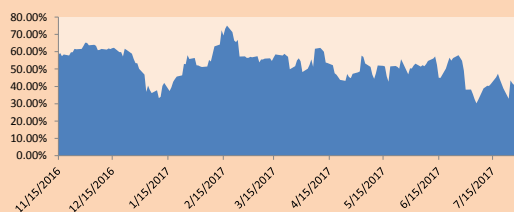

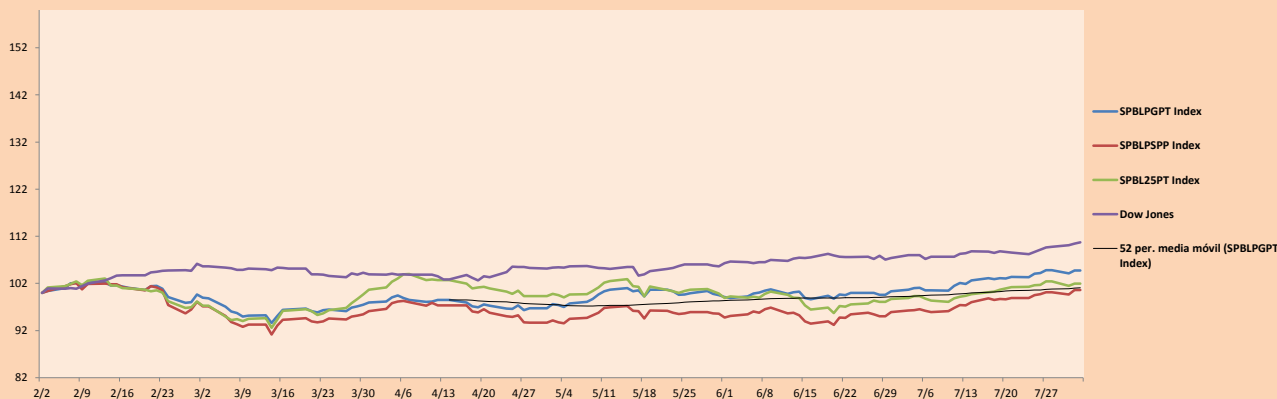

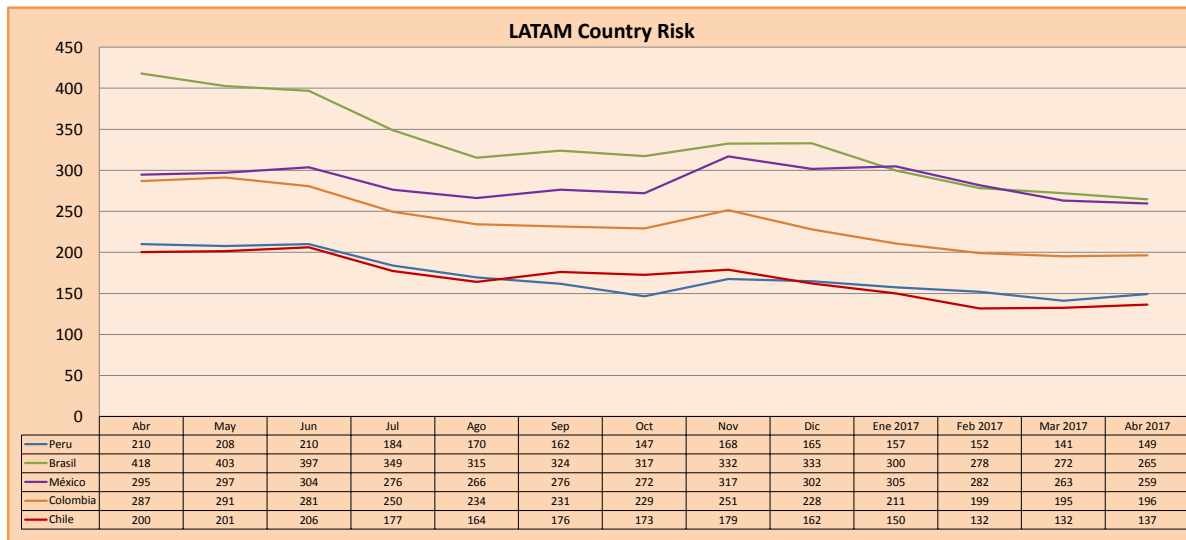
