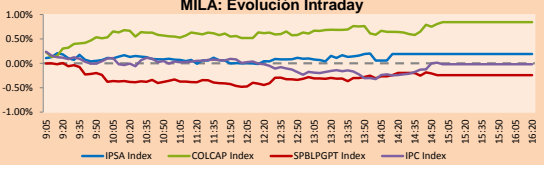

The General Index of the BVL of Peru ended today's session with a negative result of -0.26%. The index maintains a cumulative positive annual trend of +7.20% in local currency, while the yield adjusted to foreign currency is +7.24%. Then, the S&P/BVL Peru SEL obtained a positive return of +0.29%, while the S&P/ BVL LIMA 25 decreased -0.30%. The spot PEN reached S/3.2365.

Chile

The IPISA index ended the day with a positive return of +0.19%. The sectors of the index with the most positive results were Public Services (+0.56%) and Industrial Services (+0.53%). In the same way, the values with the most bullish results were Inversiones Aguas Metropolitan (+1.34%) and Empresas CMPC SA (+0.98%)

Colombia

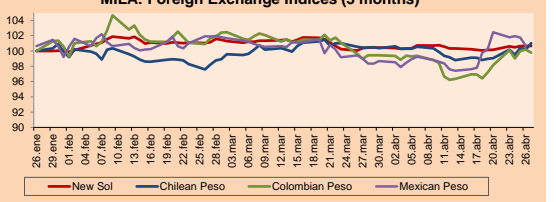

Mexico

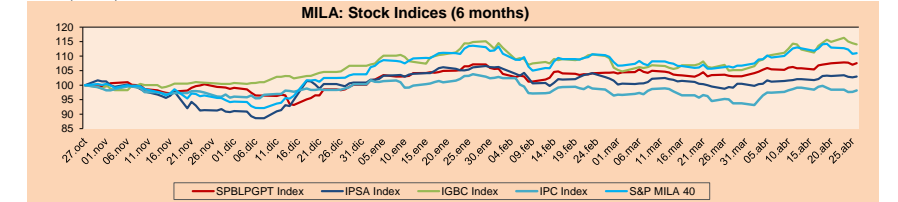

Global Overview

United States:

The US market closed the session with mixed results among its main indices. In economic news, US data showed that in the first quarter its GDP expanded at an annual rate of 2.3%, although this figure is lower than in the three previous quarters. It is still better than expected by Marketwatch economists who had predicted only an increase of 2% of GDP. For its part, the interest rate on 10-year US Treasury bonds fell below 3%, so it is expected that concerns about this rate will dissipate. In business news, Amazon shares fell to -0.10%, despite an initial rise in which reached a + 4.2% yield, this being an intraday record for the company, JP Morgan on Friday raised the Target price of these shares from \$ 1,650 to \$ 1,900. With respect to oil, the commodity futures had mixed results this Friday limited by expectations that the US market will abandon the nuclear agreements with Iran, while crude oil had little movement after the oil firm Baker Hughes said that the number of oil platforms will increase by 5 this week, reaching 825 in total.

Europe:

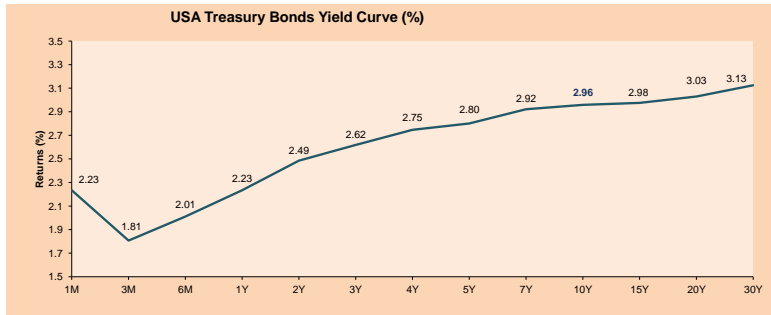
The European stock market ended the day with positive results among its main indices, due to the exuberant results obtained by Spanish banks and the recovery of technology stocks, positioning the fifth week of consecutive gains. However, the Royal Bank of Scotland Group lagged behind, reversing early gains to negotiate 2% less after concerns about the pending US Department of Justice overhauled its first-quarter earnings report. On the other hand, the industrial sector performed well, being driven by the shares of St Gobain, which rose 3%, after the French group of construction materials confirmed its financial outlook for 2018. In addition, the satellite firm SES won the most, more than 10%, after exceeding the expectations of the first quarter thanks to the strong growth in its network division. In summary, the earnings season has taken the focus of broader issues such as global trade and geopolitics, which shook the markets in March, while concerns about the increase in bond yields have also been left in a second. flat for the moment.

Asia:

The Asian stock market ended today's session with positive results among its main indices. On Japanese equities, its Nikkei 225 benchmark index rose +0.66%, its highest closing since the beginning of February. These were boosted by the shares of Advantest and Kyocera, both from the technology sector, due to the good earnings forecasts of both companies. On the other hand, the Bank of Japan announced that it has abandoned its attempts to predict when it would reach the inflation target of 2%, a move that could be taken with the idea of keeping market expectations at bay over more monetary stimuli. In macroeconomic news, Taiwan's economic growth slowed slightly from its highest point in three years of 3.28% in the last quarter of 2017, when it obtained 3.04%. However, the country's economy remains robust thanks to strong foreign demand for technological components. In other news, the leaders of North and South Korea signed a declaration of cooperation to reach the complete denuclearization of the Korean peninsula after the first inter-Korean summit in more than 11 years. They also agreed to formally end the Korean War for the current year through a peace treaty.

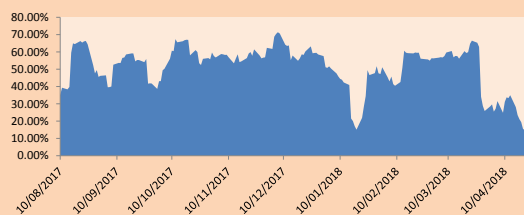

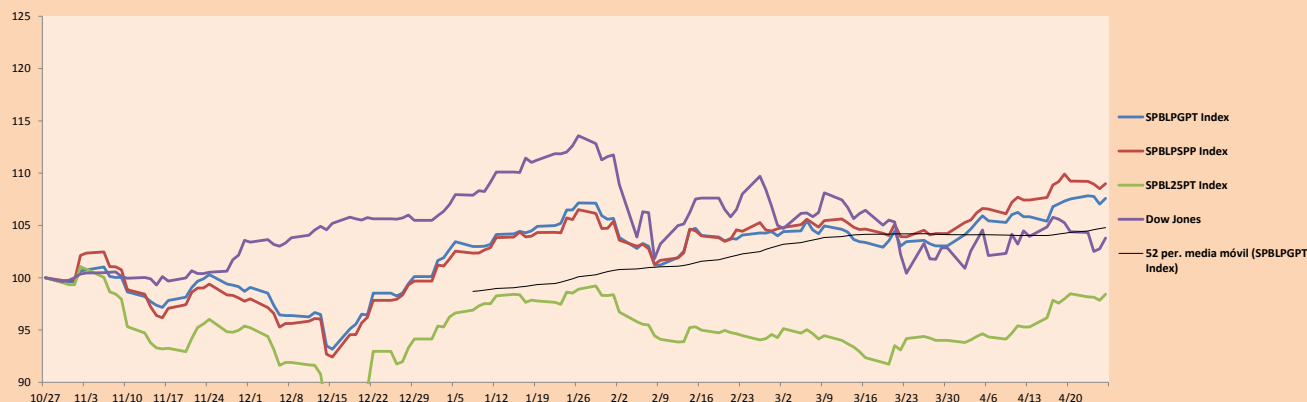

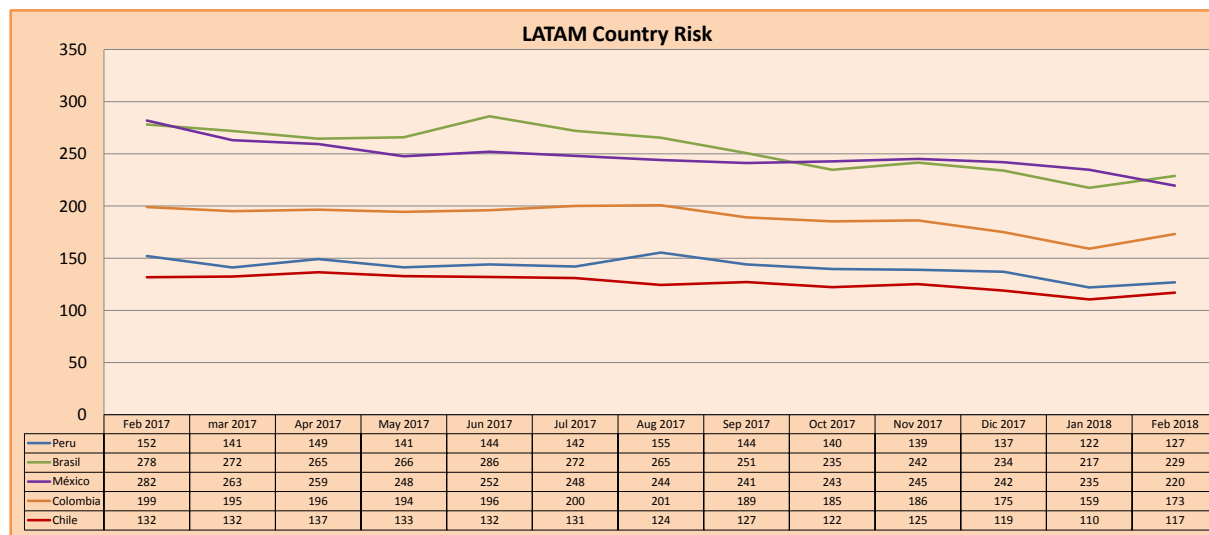
