



Peru: The General Index of the BVL ended today's session with a positive result of + 2.47%. The index maintains an annual cumulative positive trend of -13.52% in local currency, while the adjusted yield in dollars amounts to -18.07%. Then, the S&P / BVL Peru SEL varied by + 4.52% while the S&P / BVL LIMA 25 by + 2.55%. The PEN spot reached S / 3.5007. Headline: BVL closes in positive territory for promises to fight the coronavirus globally.

Chile: The IPSA index ended the day with a positive return + 0.86%. The sectors most affected in the day were Information Technology (+ 2.67%) and Finance (+ 1.60%). The actions with the best performance were AES Gener SA (+ 5.39%) and Ripley Corporación SA (+ 3.57%). Holder: The dollar skyrockets to historical highs in Chile and brushes 850 pesos per unit.

Colombia: The COLCAP index had a positive result of + 1.16%. The sectors most affected in the day were Public Services (+ 2.29%) and Finance (+ 1.65%). The values with the best results were Cementos Argos SA (+ 6.64%) and BanColombia SA (+ 4.48%). Holder: Tax collection in Colombia rebounds 11.2% in February and reaches US \$ 2.655M.

Mexico: The MEXBOL index closed the session with a positive result of + 2.16%. The sectors with the best performance of the day were Materials (+ 3.30%) and Non-basic Consumer Products (+ 3.24%). The actions with the best performance were Grupo Carso SAB de CV (+ 10.56%) and El Puerto de Liverpool SAB (-9.87%). Headline: The US, Canada and European countries meet for concern about energy policy in Mexico.

Global Overview:

United States:

US markets ended today's session in positive territory, recovering after suffering the biggest drop since the financial crisis of 2008. Investors evaluated the possibilities of fiscal stimulus to avoid slow growth by COVID-19. Initially, President D. Trump proposed a payroll tax cut to counteract the economic impacts of the Chinese virus. However, according to administration officials, the White House had no plans at the moment to put into effect specific measures to address the economic slowdown by the virus. Later in the session, President Trump announced a payroll tax rate of 0% throughout 2020. This fiscal stimulus caused uncertainty among market agents and volatility. Regarding corporate shares, the companies that raised the markets were Amazon, Google, Facebook, Netflix and Apple, closing with profits above 4%. In addition, JPMorgan Chase + 7.77%. On the other hand, analysts continue to discuss whether a recession is near or not. In this way, the S&P 500 + 4.94%, DJIA + 4.89% and NASDAQ + 4.95% ended the session upwards.


Europe:

European markets ended the day down due to the two main factors that move most the economy nowadays, COVID-19 and the oil price war. Due to the proliferation of the virus in Italy, the government will close the country so that it can be controlled since the country is now the second with most dead's after China in less than three weeks. On the other hand, Germany does not grant tax benefits until the crisis hits the economy to a greater extent. This policy is consistent with Germany's refusal to borrow, but also with its plan to combat the financial crisis of 2008. Among the companies that will fall the most is Enel (-5.66%), Deutsche Boerse AG (-4.38%), Telefonica (-3.97%) and Bayer AG (-3.39%). Respect the price war and in order to combat the financial fall of the previous day, Russia advanced the sale of foreign currencies in order to reduce market volatility, also will stop its weekly bond auctions to avoid excessive pressure on the markets of debt. Finally, the most representative indices, Euro Stoxx (-1.66%), FTSE (-0.09%), DAX (-1.41%) and Russia (-8.11%).


Asia:

The Asian markets ended the day on the rise in the middle of a turbulent session, but show a support for the sharp fall that the market presents the previous day. Investors expect a stimulus from the authorities so that they boost the economy and reduce the negative impact that COVID-19 has been having and the price war between Russia and Saudi Arabia. Likewise, China's inflation slows down as the coronavirus blocks the economy. On the other hand, global bond markets aggressively backed down from their fall during the past week pending governments by introducing fiscal measures to cope with the economic slowdown. Among other corporate news, the stocks that rose the most were Nomura Holdings Inc (+ 7.16%), CITIC Ltd (+ 4.93%), Hubel Chutian Smart (+ 10.13%). One of the measures implemented by the Chinese government has been to reduce the cost of borrowing for restricted companies. The most representative indices, Nikkei (+0.85%), Hang Seng (+ 1.41%), CSI 300 (+ 2.14%) and S&P/ASX 200 (+ 3.11%). Finally, the markets remain expectant of what happens in the price war since, as was seen in the session on Monday, it could have very damaging effects on the financial system.
