

# MILA

Peru: The BVL General Index ended today's session with a positive result of +1.05%. The index maintains an annual accumulated positive trend of +2.25% in local currency, while the adjusted return in dollars amounts to +1.50%. Then, the S&P / BVL Peru SEL varied by +0.80% while the S&P / BVL LIMA 25 by +1.20%. The PEN spot reached S / 3.6438. Headline: Peru announces bonds to citizens and extension of payment of taxes to companies due to return to quarantine.

Chile: The IPSA index ended the day with a negative return of -0.16%. The sectors most affected in the day energy (-2.51%) and Non-Basic Consumer Products (-1.31%). The worst performing stocks were Empresas Copec SA (-2.51%) and Plaza SA y Filiales (-2.12%). Headline: Vaccine factor and Wall Street recovery contained the losses of the Santiago Stock Exchange but the IPSA closes at a low on January 5.

Colombia: The COLCAP index had a negative result of -0.56%. The sectors with the worst returns on the day were Energy (-3.21%) and Staple Products (-0.82%). The securities with the most inefficient results were Ecopetrol SA (-3.81%) and Grupo de Inversión Suramericana SA (-2.44%). Headline: Colombia increases its 2021 budget by US \$ 5,163 million to combat the pandemic.

Mexico: The IPC index closed the session with a positive result of +0.04%. The sectors with the best returns of the day were Public Services (+ 2.22%) and Finance (+ 1.25%). The securities with outstanding earnings were Grupo CEMEX (+ 2.79%) and Grupo Financiero BANORTE-O (+ 2.57%). Headline: Volaris and Aeromexico Papers Collapse Due to US Restrictions.





# **Global Overview:**

# **United States:**

US markets ended today's session with positive returns as the earnings season recovers with solid corporate reports and hedge fund concerns subside. After the biggest daily percentage decline in three months, the indices managed to recover this session. On the quarterly reports, Ellen Hazen from FLPutnam Investment Management commented that mostly the "surprises have been positive, even more than usual and, in general, large companies are showing positive operating leverage in which they can increase profits a little more quicker than they can increase revenue". In individual stocks, Amazon + 0.16%, Microsoft + 2.59% and Aphabet + 1.88%, leading earnings alongside other heavyweights. On the other hand, GameStop Corp -44.29% and AMC Entertainment Holdings Inc -56.63% after the strong consecutive rises that surprised the stock markets. Trading websites such as Robinhood and Interactive Brokers blocked trades in various stocks that soared this week, easing fears about a domino effect in the broader market, according to Reuters. Thus, the S&P 500 + 0.98%, DIIA + 0.99% and NASDAQ + 0.5% ended higher.

# **Europe:**


European markets ended today's session with mostly positive returns, driven by sustained growth in US technology stocks, stocks in the airline sector and earnings reports, which drove a reversal of initial losses. Likewise, optimism remained regarding the promise of the US Federal Reserve to stick to a loose monetary policy, as concerns about the slow launch of COVID-19 vaccines and more restrictions in Europe clouded the mood. Meanwhile, the European Union has warned pharmaceutical companies such as AstraZeneca, that it would use all legal means or even block exports unless they agreed to deliver the requested vaccines by agreement. Regarding airline stocks, American Airlines Group enerated a positive effect on companies such as Lufthmans 4-6.28%, 11+6.22% and International Airlines Group 4-4.75%, despite registering a double-digit decrease in fourth quarter revenue. For today's close, the main indices Stoxx 600 + 0.10%, FTSE 100 -0.63%, CAC 40 + 0.93% and DAX + 0.33% culminated, mostly with bullish results.

# Asia:

PASIG.

The main Asian markets closed the day's session with negative results. The downward result of the day today came after the S&P 500 eliminated all its gains obtained this year. Then any fivhen, chairman and CEO of Citic capital, said that "a massive bubble effect is forming around the world" as mall investors get carried away by speculative trading, it also mentioned that such a bubble would not affect China due to "capital control" in the country. Meanwhile, Carrie Law, and cell of Hong Kong, declared the optimism about Joe Biden's administration, and is confident of "a fair hearing" regarding the controversial national security law. In Japan, retail sales decreased by 0.3% year-on-year in December, according to data from the country's Ministry of Economy. Trade and Industry. On the other hand, in the stock etch, the value of Catahay Pacific airine fell 9.1% after the announcement of the issuance of convertible bonds with a value of 869.36 million dollars. Additionally, Alibaba shares fell 3.23% as its affiliate Ant Group plans to become a financial holding company supervised by the Central Bank of China. Thus, the NIKKEI -1.53%, Shanghai Composite -1.91%, Shenzhen Composite -2.82%, Hang Seng -2.55%, S&P/ASX 200 -1.93% and KOSPI -1.71%.
