





Peru: The BVL General index ended today's session with a positive result of +1.35%. The index maintains a positive yearly accumulated trend of -12.52% in local currency, while the dollar-adjusted performance amounted to -9.67%. Then, the S&P/BVL Peru SEL varied by +1.87% while the S&P/BVL LIMA 25 by +1.52%. The PEN spot reached S/.3.8730. Headline: BBVA improves Peruvian economy growth projections for 2022.

Chile: The IPSA index ended the day with a positive return of +1.54%. The most benefited sectors of the day were Industrials (+3.47%) and Materials (+2.49%). The best performing stocks were Compañía Sudamericana de Vapores SA (+4.66%) and Enel Americas SA (+2.85%). Headline: Retail sales confirm their deceleration during June, leaving behind high growth rates.

Colombia: The Colombian COLCAP index ended the day with a positive return +1.66%. The session's top gainers were Energy (+3.36%) and Financials (+1.60%). The best performing stocks were Promigas SA (+4.73%) and BanColombia SA (+3.58%) Headline: Exports from free trade zones grow 5.7% in the year.

Mexico: The IPC index closed the day in positive territory at +0.72%. The best performing sectors of the day were Finance (+1.93%) and Communication Services (+1.21%). The best performing stocks were Gruma SAB de CV (+4.60%) and Controladora Vuela Compañía de Aviación SAB de CV (+3.68%). Headline: The possibility of an economic recession in 2023 grows in Mexico.









United States:

The major U.S. indices ended the session with positive returns amid a backdrop where investors received a series of upbeat earnings reports while assessing the outlook for monetary policy tightening. Meanwhile, the Dow Jones index ended in positive territory, however, housing data from the Commerce Department showed that new home construction activity fell 2% in June to the lowest level since September 2021. The S&P500 index also ended with a positive performance, while on the corporate front Johnson & Johnson(-1. 46%) ended with losses despite beating estimates, but the company cut its full-year earnings and sales forecast due to the impact of a stronger dollar likewise Intel (-5. 25%) also succumbed, after lowering its cash flow forecast, despite reporting results that beat analysts' earnings and revenue estimates Finally, the NASDAQ index ended in positive territory, after the yield on the benchmark 10-year Treasury bond rose to 3% as investors continued to weigh the prospects of a more aggressive monetary policy Thus, DOW JONES +2.43%; S&P 500 +2.76%; NASDAQ +3.11% ended the day with positive results.

Europe:

The main European indices ended the session with positive returns. The pan-European STOXX 600 index ended with gains, in a context where investors have already discounted a 25 basis point increase in stock prices, however, fears of a possible half point increase are expected. The British market, reflected in the FTSE 100, rose this session, in a context where the Bank of England is considering a half a point increase in the reference rate in August, in its move to counter inflation. Likewise, the British government considered reducing its bond holdings by 50 billion pounds. Meanwhile, the DAX index closed in positive territory, in a context where Uniper, the international company that owns and manages a portfolio located throughout Europe and Russia, is said to be in a deal to be rescued and could lead the German government to inject billions of euros and take a stake in the giant energy company. The French market rose this session, in a scenario where Electricite de France shares increased by 15%, after the French government mentioned its proposal to nationalize the company for 9.7 billion euros, with the intention of financing future new investments in nuclear and renewable energy. Thus, FTSE 100 +1.01%; CAC 40 +1.79%; DAX +2.69%; STOXX 600 +1.38% finished at positive levels.

Asia:

The main Asian indices closed with mostly negative returns. The Chinese market closed with negative returns, in a context in which investors' expectations were pessimistic due to the increase of COVID cases in the country, reporting 178 more cases than on Monday. Also, due to the zero COVID policy, partial movement restrictions have been implemented affecting 22.8% of the economy's GDP; amid an already complicated context due to mortgage lenders' refusal to pay their installments. In contrast to mainland China, the HANG SENG index closed lower, extending losses on COVID restrictions in the country and also on a reduced growth outlook in the technology sector on Bloomberg reports about Apple. This would have affected the performance of Hong Kong technology companies such as Sunny Optical and ACC Technologies. The Japanese market closed slightly positive as the market remained moderately inactive ahead of the Bank of Japan's monetary policy announcement this week. The South Korean market ended the session in slightly negative territory as chip manufacturing related companies fell amid an appreciating won and rising bond yields. The Australian market fell as central bank minutes indicated that further rate hikes are on the horizon. Thus, NIKKEI +0.65%; HANG SENG -0.89%; CSI 300 -0.54%; SHANGHAI COMP. +0.04%; S&P/ASX 200 -0.56%; KOSPI







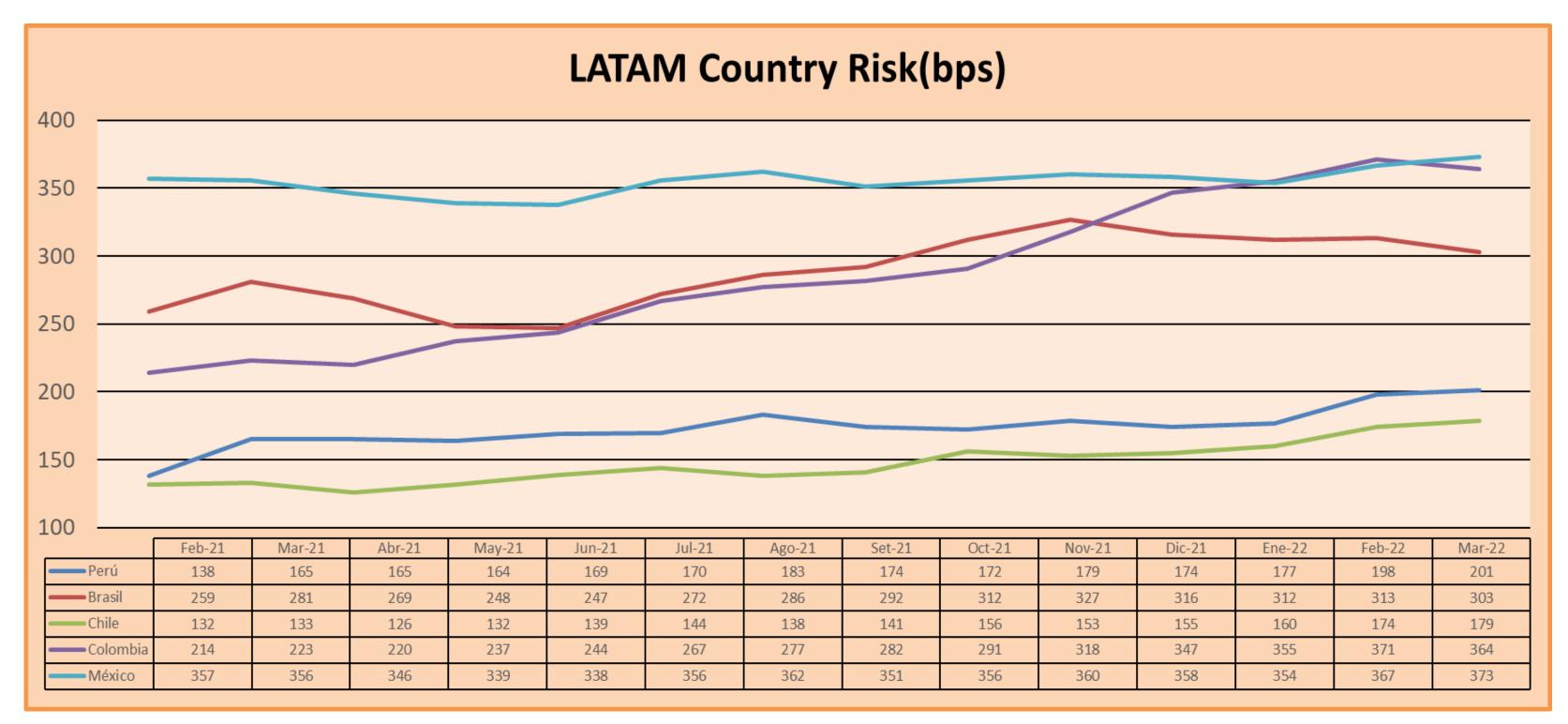
