




### <u>MILA</u>

Peru: The BVL General index ended today's session with a positive result of +1.07%. The index maintains a negative annual cumulative trend of -8.62% in local currency, while the dollar-adjusted performance amounted to -6.65%. Then, the S&P/BVL Peru SEL varied by +0.97% while the S&P/BVL LIMA 25 by +1.15%. The spot PEN reached S/.3.9148. Headline: Dollar price: What is the closing exchange rate today, July 22nd?

Chile: The IPSA index ended the day with a positive return of +0.31%. The best performing stocks were Enel Chile SA (+2.63%) and Inversiones Aguas Metropol (+2.56%). Headline: Luxury tourism, the keys that explain its boom in Chile.

Colombia: The Colombian COLCAP index ended the day with a negative return of -2.46%. The worst performing stocks were Grupo Nutresa SA (-8.00%) and Grupo Bolivar SA (-7.54%) Headline: How many companies have declared insolvency in 2022.

Mexico: The IPC index closed the day in negative territory of -0.32%. The worst performing stocks were Controladora Vuela (-13.04%) and Grupo Financiero Banorte (-5.06%). Headline: Inflation in Mexico, another historic hike by Banxico to try to contain it?






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



## **Global Overview:**

### **United States:**

The major U.S. indices ended the session with negative returns amid investors weighing a series of disappointing corporate earnings reports and weak economic data. Meanwhile, the Dow Jones index ended in negative territory, after U.S. business activity contracted in July for the first time in nearly two years, pressured by a sharp slowdown in the services sector, intensifying concerns about the economic outlook. The S&P500 index also ended with a negative performance, marked by the S&P Global services PMI falling to 47 in July from 52.7 in June, missing market expectations of 52.6 and signaling the largest drop in output since May 2020. Finally, the NASDAQ index ended in negative territory, likewise, on the corporate front, Twitter reported weaker-than-expected earnings and revenue and user growth for the second quarter. The social media giant's bleak outlook followed disappointing results from Snap, which plunged nearly 40%, sending other social media companies, such as Meta and Pinterest, succumbing. Verizon falling about 7% after missing Wall Street estimates and delivering weak guidance. Thus, DOW JONES -0.43%; S&P 500 -0.93%; NASDAQ -1.87% ended the day with negative results.


### **Europe:**

Major European indices ended the session with positive returns. The pan-European STOXX 600 index closed Friday its best week in two months, as concerns about energy supply shortages eased, bringing calm to investors. The U.K. market, reflected in the FTSE 100, rose this session, with oil stocks such as BP and Shell up 1.4% and 0.8%, while mining stocks gained 1.0%. In addition, the British services and manufacturing sectors continued to expand in July. Meanwhile, the DAX index closed in positive territory, as the state agreed to provide 17 billion euros for struggling utilities such as Uniper SE in order to avoid a collapse in its energy network as a result of Russia's measures to reduce gas deliveries. The French market rose this session after one of the energy sector's largest companies TotalEnergies mentioned a reduction on petroleum fuel prices at French service stations of 20 cents per liter for two months and 10 cents per liter until the end of the year. Thus, FTSE 100 +0.08%; CAC 40 +0.25%; DAX +0.05%; STOXX 600 +0.31% ended at positive levels.

### Asia:

Major Asian indices closed with mostly mixed performances. The Chinese market closed with positive returns, in a scenario where banking and insurance regulators urged banks to make adequate provisions for soured assets and to classify risk prudently. In contrast to mainland China, the HANG SENG index closed at near zero, in a context where the short-term drag factors of the possible acceleration of the downward revision of earnings estimates and the spillover effect of any US market correction were estimated. The Japanese market closed in positive territory, where chip developer Tokyo Electron rose by 1.34% and was the biggest driver of the Nikkei. Likewise, there were 122 stocks that ended positive and 93 corporations that ended negative. Finally, the logistics sector jumped by 4.75% after 3 companies raised their annual earnings forecasts. The South Korean market ended the session in negative territory, where stocks fell in sync with the fall of Snapchat's owner. Similarly, the won weakened, while the benchmark bond yield fell. The Australian market fell as energy stocks took losses due to a drop in oil prices; this in conjunction with an interest rate hike by the European Central Bank. Thus, NIKKEI +0.40%; HANG SENG +0.17%; CSI 300 +0.05%; SHANGHAI COMP. -0.06%; S&P/ASX 200 -0.04%; KOSPI -0.66% ended with mixed performances.



# Correlation Graph of Returns of Mining Index against Metallic Index of London (3 months)







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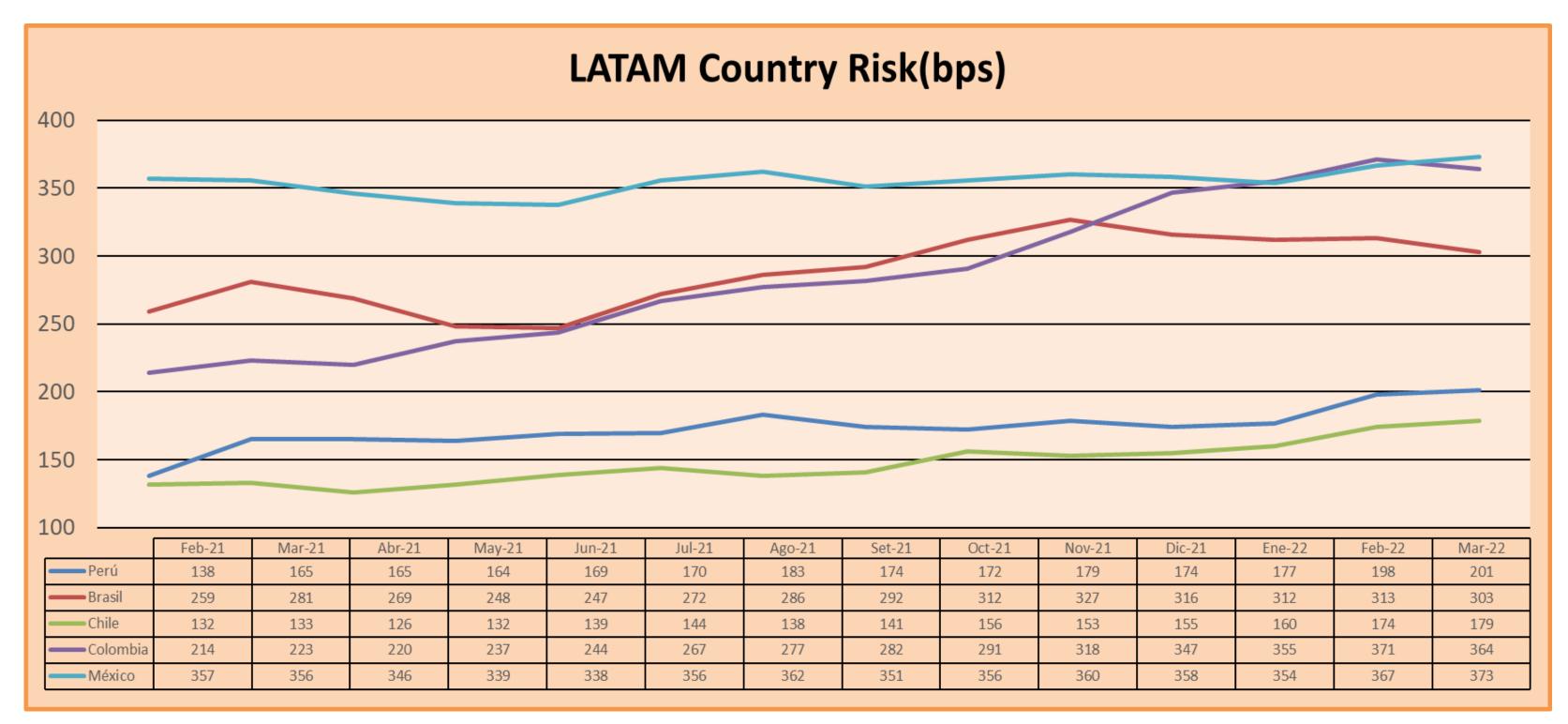
