Peru: The BVL General index ended today's session with a positive result of +0.50%. The index maintains a positive cumulative annual trend of +8.49% in local currency and a positive cumulative trend of 6.01% in dollar-adjusted currency. With respect to the S&P/BVL Peru SEL it varied by +1.26% while the S&P/BVL LIMA 25 by +0.44%. The spot PEN reached S/.3.8953. Headline: Household appliance prices to rise 15%: the trends that will mark 2023.


Chile: The IPSA index ended the day with a negative return of -1.04%. The worst performing sectors of the day were Energy (-2.87%) and Real Estate (-2.22%). The worst performers were Empresas CMPC SA (-3.92%) and Parque Arauco SA (-3.68%). Headline: Market bets that the IPC will rise 0.5% in January and estimates a first decline in the TPM in April.

Colombia: The COLCAP index ended the session with a negative return of -1.60%. The most affected sectors of the day were Energy (-2.52%) and Utilities (-1.72%). The worst performing stocks were Banco de Bogota SA (-6.18%) and Mineros SA (-5.78%). Headline: Economic crisis also hits home apps: the effects.

Mexico: The IPC index closed the day in positive territory +0.97%. The top gainers of the day were Financials (+2.21%) and Materials (+1.14%). The best performing stocks were Grupo Financiero Inbursa SA (+4.41%) and Grupo Elektra SAB de CV (+3.74%). Headline: Inflation accelerates to 7.94% in the first fortnight of January.





Global Overview:

United States:

The US market closed with mixed performances, after investors took into account a series of economic and earnings data with fears of a recession persisting. The DOW JONES closed higher, where the latest US PMI data showed that business activity in the manufacturing and services sectors remained below par, amplifying the impact of tightening financial conditions on growth and reinforcing bets that the Federal Reserve will slow its pace of tightening. The S&P 500 index ended with negative returns. On the corporate side, industrial conglomerate 3M plunged more than 6.2% after announcing a drop in profits, while General Electric gained 1.1% after the industrial giant posted quarterly results that beat expectations. Johnson & Johnson, meanwhile, was slightly in the red after announcing a 25% drop in profits and a decline in sales in the fourth quarter, due to a drop in demand for the Covid-19 vaccine. Finally, the NASDAQ index ended the day higher, as Alphabet Inc shares fell after the Department of Justice filed a lawsuit against Google for abuse of dominance in the digital advertising business. Within the aerospace and defense industry, Lockheed Martin Corp issued a disappointing profit forecast, and Raytheon Technologies Corp beat estimates thanks to solid travel demand. Thus, DOW JONES +0.31%, S&P 500 -0.07% and NASDAQ -0.27% ended the day with mixed results.


Europe:

Major European indices ended the session with mostly negative performances. The pan-European STOXX 600 index closed lower, as the PMI index rose 50.7, above market expectations of 49.8. The UK market, reflected in the FTSE 100, was hurt by the healthcare and energy sectors. Economic activity also fell at a faster pace due to rising interest rates, strikes and weak consumer demand due to higher living costs. Similarly, the German market, reflected in the DAX index closed in negative territory as concerns grew over the European Central Bank's aggressive anti-inflation stance following the release of PMI data. In addition, Rolf Bürkl, consumer expert at Gfk, indicated that by 2023, private consumption will not be able to contribute positively to economic development. The French market closed negative, as the country's services sector and new business inflows fell again as demand was hit by difficult economic conditions amid persistently high inflation and higher borrowing costs. Among individual stocks, Engie (+2.1%) and Publicis Groupe (+1.5%) were the best performers, while Carrefour (-1.2%) was among the worst. Thus, FTSE 100 -0.35%; CAC 40 +0.26%; DAX -0.07%; STOXX 600 -0.24% ended at negative levels.

Asia:

Major Asian indices closed with positive returns. The Chinese and Hong Kong markets remained closed due to the Chinese New Year holiday. The South Korean market also remained closed due to the Lunar New Year holiday. The Japanese market closed on a positive note, recovering all its losses since the Bank of Japan's surprise tightening of monetary policy last month. This was thanks to technology momentum aided by a night of gains on Wall Street, where the top gaining stocks were Tokyo Electron up 2.04%, Advantest up 3.11%, SoftBank Group up 3.39%, Daikin Industries gained 2.07% and GS Yuasa Corp rose 3.77%, after the battery maker announced a collaboration with Honda Motor in the high-capacity, high-performance lithium-ion battery business. Honda also gained 1.16% in the session. Meanwhile, the Australian market ended with gains on the back of momentum in mining (+1.82%) and technology (+1.32%). Mining stocks rose to a record high on the back of strong commodity prices and technology stocks followed their Wall Street counterparts' overnight gains. However, gains were limited due to losses in the financial sector which retreated -0.3%. Thus, NIKKEI +1.23%; HANG SENG -0.78%; CSI 300 -0.02%; S&P/ASX 200 -0.03%; KOSPI -0.85%, SHANGHAI COMPOSITE -0.10% ended with mostly negative performances.






