Peru: The BVL General index ended today's session with a negative result of -0.83%. The index maintains a positive cumulative annual trend of +5.02% in local currency and a positive cumulative trend of +4.32% in dollar adjusted currency. With respect to the S&P/BVL Peru SEL it varied by -1.07% while the S&P/BVL LIMA 25 by -0.43%. The spot PEN reached S/.3.8394. Headline: Risk in Peru closed at 2.07 percentage points last Wednesday.


Chile: The IPSA index ended the day with a positive return of +0.10%. The top gainers of the day were Real Estate (+1.83%) and Consumer Staples (+1.22%). The best performing stocks were Plaza SA (+5.79%) and SMU SA (+2.42%). Headline: Customs Chamber lashes out against tax reform: "It will have a high negative impact on foreign trade".

Colombia: The COLCAP index ended the session with a negative return of -0.66%. The worst performing sectors of the day were Energy (-1.84%) and Materials (-1.45%). The worst performers were Mineros SA (-6.87%) and Cementos Argos SA (-4.79%). Headline: Pension savings in private funds closed at \$345 billion in 2022.

Mexico: The IPC index closed the day in negative territory -2.08%. The worst performing sectors of the day were Finance (-2.65%) and Communication services (-2.43%). The worst performers were Banco del Bajio SA (-5.54%) and Operadora De Sites Mexicanos SA de CV (-3.94%). Headline: Inflation forecast increased to 5.18% in 2023: according to Banxico survey.

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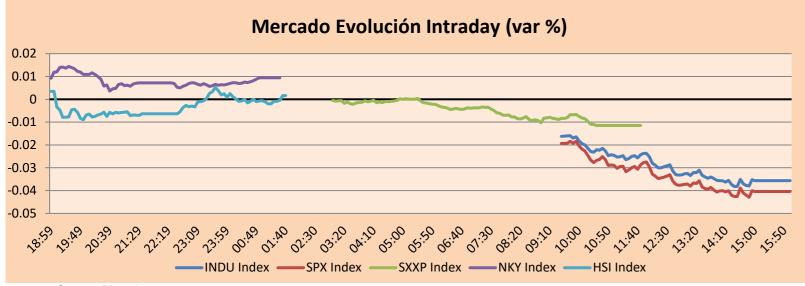



Global Overview:

United States:

The US market closed with mixed performances. The DOW JONES index closed with negative results. UnitedHealth Group shares fell after the U.S. government proposed Medicare Advantage reimbursement rates below analysts' estimates, and the stock weighed on the Dow. A drop in Merck shares, after the drugmaker predicted 2023 earnings below Wall Street estimates, also weighed on the blue-chip index. The S&P 500 index also ended with gains after the Federal Reserve decided on a modest 25 basis point hike on Wednesday. Fed Chairman Jerome Powell said the central bank had made progress in the battle against inflation, despite warning that continued increases in the target range were appropriate to achieve a monetary policy stance tight enough to bring inflation back to 2%. Finally, the NASDAQ index ended the day higher, following a post-Fed rally driven by gains in major technology stocks. Meta rose 23.3% after posting better-than-expected fourth-quarter earnings and announcing a \$40 billion share repurchase. Meta's gains, along with three other tech giants, Apple (+3.7%), Amazon (+7.4%) and Alphabet (+7.3%). Thus, DOW JONES -0.11%, S&P 500 +1.47% and NASDAQ +3.25% ended the day with mixed results.


Europe:

Major European indices ended the session with positive returns, reaching their highest level in almost a year. This as hawkish messages from the ECB failed to derail investors' hopes that the global rate hike cycle was nearing its end. The pan-European STOXX 600 index closed higher, with real estate stocks rising 6.8% as rate sensitivities led the session's gains alongside technology stocks. The UK market, reflected in the FTSE 100, closed positive, driven by real estate and consumer discretionary stocks. Despite the Bank of England's decision to raise interest rates to 4%, this was taken moderately by investors. On the corporate side, JD Sports Fashion jumped over 10% leading the index. Similarly, reflected in the DAX index, the German market closed in positive territory with the most relevant individual stocks such as Deutsche Bank retreating more than 6% as investors focused on an uncertain outlook and investor bank weakness. The French market closed with gains recovering from the last session to reach its highest level in a year. This as markets gave preference to the Fed's slower rate hike, which helped sensitive sectors in Paris to post strong gains. Thus, Dassault Systemes rose 12.4%, Kering by 5% and Hermes by 2.3%. Thus, FTSE 100 +0.76%; CAC 40 +1.26%; DAX +2.16%; STOXX 600 +1.35% finished at positive levels.

Asia:

Major Asian indices closed with mostly positive returns, following Wall Street's gains, as the US Federal Reserve reduced the size of the rate hike and made progress in countering inflation. The Chinese market ended with negative returns as a private survey showed that manufacturing activity remains in contraction, at odds with official data released on Tuesday. In line with this, the Hang Seng index closed lower, in a context where the interest rate rose 25 basis points. However, Hong Kong's top leader, John Lee, stated that his goal is to remove all measures against the coronavirus this year and help the city return to normal life. The South Korean market ended on a positive note, despite consumer inflation rising to 5.2% year-on-year, above expectations. In addition, policy makers said they expect domestic economic growth to weaken due to the global economic slowdown and rising interest rates. The Japanese market closed higher, driven mainly by technology stocks such as SoftBank Group (1%), Tokyo Electron (2.9%), Keyence (2%), Advantest (3.7%) and Renesas Electronics (2.6%). The Australian market ended higher in a context where investors' expectations are based on the Reserve Bank maintaining its tightening policy. Thus, NIKKEI +0.20%; HANG SENG -0.52%; CSI 300 -0.35%; S&P/ASX 200 +0.13%; KOSPI +0.78%, SHANGHAI COMPOSITE +0.02% ended with mostly positive performances.




