

## LATAM

Lima, June 01, 2023

**Peru:** The BVL General index ended today's session with a positive result of +1.49%. The index maintains a positive cumulative annual trend of +0.77% in local currency and a positive cumulative trend of +3.77% in dollar-adjusted currency. Regarding the S&P/BVL Peru SEL, it varied by +2.11% while the S&P/BVL LIMA 25 by +0.67%. The spot PEN reached S/.3.6961. Headline: Agro-export star products lose profitability. At risk 50% of coffee and cocoa shipments.

**Chile:** The IPSA index ended the day with a positive return of +0.90%. The sectors that lost the most during the day were Communication Services (+1.97%) and Materials (+1.73%). The best performing stocks were Compañía Cervecerías Unidas (+5.04%), Banco de Chile (+2.44%) and Empresas CMPC SA (+2.09%). Headline: Chile's economic activity stagnates and markets foresee rate cuts.

**Colombia:** The COLCAP index ended the session with a positive return of +1.72%. The sectors that lost the least during the day were Finance (+2.74%) and Utilities (+1.11%). The best performing stocks were Banco Davivienda SA (+5.59%) and Grupo Aval Acciones y Valores (+4.08%). Headline: Colombia's crude oil production increased 4% yoy in April to 782,277 b/d.

**Mexico:** The IPC index closed the day in negative territory -0.02%. The least benefited sectors of the day were Non-Basic Consumer Goods (-1.02%) and Industrials (-0.78%). The worst performing stocks were Arca Continental SAB de CV (-4.13%) and Grupo Aeroportuario del Pacífico (-3.70%). Headline: Mexico extends GMexico's concession after seizure of railroads.

**Brazil:** The IBOVESPA index closed the day in positive territory, +2.06%. The sectors that lost the least during the day were Financials (+2.30%) and Energy (+2.75%). The best performing stocks were Locaweb Servicos de Internet SA (+11.88%) and CVC Brasil Operadora e Agencia (+7.40%). Headline: Brazil's economy rebounds with Lula and defies high rates.






### MILA: Intraday Evolution




### MILA: Sovereign Yield Curves




### MILA: Foreign Exchange Indices (3 months)

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## WORLD

### United States:

The US market closed with positive returns. The DOW JONES index closed higher, New ISM data showed manufacturing activity contracted for the fifth consecutive month and price pressures eased significantly, bolstering bets that the Federal Reserve will pause the tightening cycle this month. The S&P 500 index also ended with gains. Against a backdrop where traders celebrated the passage of the Fiscal Responsibility Act of 2023 by a 314-117 vote in the House of Representatives. The bill is currently on its way to the Senate and is expected to receive approval before the June 5 default deadline. Finally, the NASDAQ index ended with positive returns. Leading was a 5.1% gain in Nvidia Corp, although the chipmaker's increase in its forecast for higher AI-related revenue still failed to push the company into the elite club of companies valued at \$1 billion or more. Thus, DOW JONES +0.47%, S&P 500 +0.99% and NASDAQ +1.28% ended the day with positive results.

### Europe:

The main European indices ended the session with positive returns, in a context where several ECB policymakers expressed their preference for a more substantial 50 bps increase in policy rates, according to the minutes of the May meeting. The pan-European STOXX 600 index closed higher as the consumer price inflation rate fell to 6.1% below market expectations of 6.3% on the back of a 1.7% drop in energy prices. Also, the seasonally adjusted unemployment rate fell to 6.5%. The UK market, reflected in the FTSE 100, closed with positive results led by mining stocks such as Fresnillo and Anglo American after Chinese factory activity beat expectations. In addition, additional consumer credit borrowing in April was split between £0.7 billion of credit card borrowing and £0.9 billion of borrowing through other forms of consumer credit. Similarly, reflected in the DAX index, the German market closed in positive territory, with food retail sales up 0.5%, as food prices fell slightly. The French market closed with gains as investors reacted positively to inflation figures from the euro zone. In addition, manufacturing activity contracted slightly less than expected. Thus, FTSE 100 +0.59%; CAC 40 +0.55%; DAX +1.21%; STOXX 600 +0.78% ended at positive levels.

### Asia:

Major Asian indices closed with mostly positive returns. The Chinese market ended with positive returns as investors priced in a series of manufacturing PMI indices in Asia, led by a private survey that showed Chinese manufacturing activity unexpectedly grew in May, in contrast to official data released just a day earlier. In line, the Hang Seng index closed lower, driven by stocks in the real estate and financial sectors. Hopes for a Fed pause receded after the April JOLTS employment report will show more than 10 million job openings, the highest in three months. The South Korean market ended lower as South Korea's exports contracted 15.2% y-o-y in May 2023, following an upwardly revised 14.3% drop in the previous month, but better than market expectations of a 16.8% decline, a preliminary report showed. The Japanese market closed higher. Leading the gains were Fujitsu (6.72%), Softbank (4.57%) and Mitsubishi (3.54%). The Australian market ended higher after the Reserve Bank of Australia's Commodity Price Index declined 22.2 percent year-on-year in May 2023, led by lower prices for coking coal, thermal coal, iron ore and liquefied natural gas. Thus, NIKKEI +0.84%; HANG SENG -0.10%; CSI 300 +0.22%; S&P/ASX 200 +0.27%; KOSPI -0.31%, SHANGHAI COMPOSITE +0.00% ended with mostly positive returns.





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
### Market Intraday Evolution (var %)




### Principal Metals Index (3 months)


