Peru: The BVL General index ended today's session with a positive result of +1.42%. The index maintains a positive cumulative annual trend of +8.50% in local currency and a positive cumulative trend of +11.21% in dollar-adjusted currency. The S&P/BVL Peru SEL varied +1.3% while the S&P/BVL LIMA 25 varied +0.88%. The spot PEN reached S/.3.7136. Headline: Engie inauguates battery bank in Chilca for close to US\$20m.

Chile: The IPSA index ended the day with a negative return of +1.46%. The most benefited sectors of the day were Financials (+2.37%) and Industrials (+1.87%). The best performing stocks were Enel Chile SA (+3.55%) and Banco de Chile (+3.22%). Headline: Chile: hard economic adjustments are almost finished, according to Finance Minister.

Colombia: The COLCAP index ended the session with a positive return of +0.45%. The sectors that lost the least during the day were Energy (+1.81%) and Financials (+0.80%). The best performing stocks were Corporación Financiera Colombia (+4.93%) and Grupo de Inversiones Suramerica (+3.65%). Headline: Cocaine would surpass oil as Colombia's main export.

Mexico: The IPC index closed the day in positive territory at +0.45%. The sectors that benefited the most during the day were Finance (+1.85%) and Health Care (+0.64%). The best performing stocks were Controladora AXTEL SAB DE CV (+20.74%) and Industrias Peñoles SAB de CV (+3.51%). Headline: Mexico's populist leader abandons austerity to investors' displeasure

Brazil: The IBOVESPA index closed the day in positive territory +1.03%. The top gainers of the day were Materials (+3.40%) and Energy (+2.61%). The best performing stocks were Bradespar SA (+5.17%) and Vale SA (+4.10%). Headline: Brazil to refinance up to 16,000 currency swaps on September 15.




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
MILA: Intraday Evolution




MILA: Foreign Exchange Indices (3 months)




MILA: Sovereign Yield Curves

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WORLD

United States:

The U.S. market closed with positive returns. The DOW JONES index closed higher, where inflation data. The August producer price index rose an annualized 1.6%, beating expectations of 1.2%, and was up 0.7% from versus expectations for a 0.4% gain. The S&P 500 index also ended with gains. Against a backdrop where the U.S. central bank is widely expected to hold borrowing costs in a range of 5.25% to 5.50% at its next meeting later this month. Finally, the NASDAQ index ended with positive returns. Where Arm shares soared more than 15% after the chip design company began trading on the Nasdaq with an initial public offering of \$51 per share. In addition, Walt Disney gained 1.2% following news that the company has held initial talks to sell ABC to Nextstar Media Group Inc. Thus, DOW JONES +0.96%, S&P 500 +0.84% and NASDAQ +0.81% ended the day with positive results.

Europe:

The main European indices ended the session with positive performances. The pan-European STOXX 600 index closed higher, in a context where the ECB raised interest rates for the tenth consecutive time and signaled that it is likely to finish tightening its policy, as inflation has started to come down, but is expected to remain too high for too long. The UK market, reflected in the FTSE 100, closed with positive results, Anglo American soared 8% after JP Morgan raised its target prices for the mining giant, while Rio Tinto added 4.8% after the bank upgraded its recommendation. The bank cited rising Chinese steel production as the cause of the bullish signals in iron ore miners. Similarly, reflected in the DAX index, the German market, closed in positive territory, as the basic resources sector soared more than 4% after the Chinese central bank announced that it would cut the reserve requirement ratio of most banks by 25 basis points as of September 15. The French market closed with gains. By stock, Alstom was the top performer, up a remarkable 4.9%. It was followed by Bouygues, up 2.5%. Luxury brands LVMH and Hermès also saw their share prices rise by 2.4% each. Thus, FTSE 100 +1.95%; CAC 40 +1.19%; DAX +0.97%; STOXX 600 +1.52% finished at positive levels.

Asia:

Major Asian indices closed with mostly positive returns. The Chinese market ended with mixed returns as the People's Bank of China has announced a 25 bps reduction in the reserve requirement ratio (RRR) for all banks, excluding those already complying with a 5% reserve ratio, effective September 15, reflecting policymakers' commitment to maintain ample liquidity and support the post-pandemic economic recovery. However, Moody's decision to change its outlook on the property sector from stable to negative capped gains. In line, the Hang Seng Index closed higher as Beijing has introduced a series of supportive measures to stimulate global credit demand and stabilize the troubled property sector, but investors have been advocating for additional policy support as recent data indicated an economic slowdown. In addition, investors also hoped that China's peak summer vacation season last month could mean an acceleration in retail sales, industrial production and fixed investment. The South Korean market ended on a positive note, following the release of US inflation data that reassured investors, as they assume that there will be no further interest rate hikes at next week's Federal Reserve meeting. The Japanese market closed higher despite core machinery orders, which exclude those for ships and power utilities, falling 1.1% m-o-m, beating market expectations for a 0.9% decline. The Australian market ended higher as the activity rate rose to 67% and the underemployment rate rose to 6.6%. On the monetary policy front, the Reserve Bank held interest rates steady for the third consecutive month at its September meeting, in line with expectations. Thus, NIKKEI +1.41%; HANG SENG +0.21%; CSI 300 -0.08%; S&P ASX 200 +0.46%; KOSPI +1.51%, SHANGHAI COMPOSITE +0.11% ended with mostly positive returns.


Market Intraday Evolution (var %)




Principal Metals Index (3 months)




Foreign Exchange Indices (3 months)
