Peru: The LSE General index ended today's session with a negative result of -0.11%. The index maintains a positive annual cumulative trend of +4.13% in local currency and a positive cumulative trend of +2.44% in dollar-adjusted currency. Regarding the S&P/BVL Peru SEL, it varied -0.12% while the S&P/BVL LIMA 25 varied +0.11%. The spot PEN reached S/.3.8688. Headline: GDP per capita would not return to pre-pandemic levels until 2025.

Chile: The IPSA index ended the day with a negative return of -1.60%. The sectors that benefited the least during the day were Industrials (-4.65%) and Consumer Staples (-1.93%). The worst performing stocks were Sociedad Química y Minera de Chile (-6.42%) and Inversiones Aguas Metropolitana (+4.33%). Headline: Expected investment in large projects in the industrial sector continues to fall.

Colombia: The COLCAP index ended the session with a positive return of +1.37%. The sectors that benefited the most during the day were Energy (+1.42%) and Financials (+1.90%). The best performing stocks were Mineros SA (+5.77%) and BanColombia SA (+4.88%). Headline: Changes to avoid a pension reform crisis.

Mexico: The IPC index closed the day in negative territory, -0.79%. The least benefited sectors of the day were Real Estate (-3.33%) and Communication Services (-2.58%). The worst performing stocks were Bolsa Mexicana de Valores SAB (-10.14%) and Controladora Vuela Cia de Avia (-6.45%). Headline: IP Changes to avoid a crisis due to the pension reform

Brazil: The IBOVESPA index closed the day in negative territory at -1.60%. The least benefited sectors of the day were Real Estate (-4.95%) and Non-Basic Consumer Products (-3.35%). The worst performing stocks were MRV Engenharia e Participações (-10.08%) and Gol Linhas Aéreas Inteligentes (-7.18%). Headline: Stellantis, owner of Fiat and Peugeot, will start manufacturing hybrid cars in Pernambuco in 2024.





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
MILA: Intraday Evolution




MILA: Sovereign Yield Curves




MILA: Foreign Exchange Indices (3 months)

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WORLD

United States:

The US market closed with negative returns. The DOW JONES index closed with negative results, as escalating turmoil in the Middle East dampened risk appetite, while the earnings season continued. On the earnings front, Morgan Stanley lost 6.8% as its profit declined. United Airlines shares plunged 9.7% after the company said the disruption of flights to Israel and higher fuel costs would hurt fourth-quarter earnings. The S&P 500 index also ended with a negative performance, Procter & Gamble rose 2.5% after reporting quarterly earnings and revenue that beat analysts' expectations, although volumes fell for the sixth consecutive quarter. Finally, the NASDAQ index ended the day lower, Nvidia extended the previous day's 4.7% loss and Advanced Micro Devices fell 2.8% a day after restrictions were announced on the sale of artificial intelligence chips to China. Tesla and Netflix will release their quarterly results after the close. Thus, DOW JONES -0.9%, S&P 500 -1.34% and NASDAQ -1.62% ended the day with negative results.

Europe:

The main European indices ended the session with negative returns. The pan-European STOXX 600 index closed in the negative. The Eurozone inflation rate was confirmed at 4.3% year-on-year in September 2023, down from 5.2% in August and the lowest since October 2021. The UK market, reflected in the FTSE 100, ended in negative territory, snapping a two-day winning streak triggered by concerns raised by a higher-than-expected inflation reading, which raised the possibility that the Bank of England may opt for another interest rate hike. The mining sector gave up more than 2% on falling metal prices after data showed that the property market continues to have a negative impact on China's overall economic situation. Similarly, the German market, reflected in the DAX index closed in negative territory. On the corporate front, chipmaker ASML drove the pan-European index lower with a decline of 3.5% after receiving fewer orders than expected in the third quarter and warning of flat results in 2024. On the other hand, Adidas rose more than 3% after better-than-expected earnings. The French market closed in the red. ArcelorMittal, Saint Gobain and Schneider Electric were the worst performers on the Paris blue-chip index, falling 3.8%, 3.6% and 2.9%, respectively. Wordline, on the other hand, was the most bullish stock (3.1%), following news that CVC Capital Partners is preparing a public offering for the Italian payments company Nexi. In addition, the services PMI recorded the largest contraction since November 2020. Thus, FTSE 100 -1.14%; CAC 40 -0.91%; DAX -1.03%; STOXX 600 -1.05% ended at negative levels.

Asia:

Major Asian indices closed with mixed performances. The Chinese market ended with negative returns, closed lower as the extension of the U.S. chip export ban increased investor concerns about geopolitical risks, even as third-quarter economic growth came in above expectations. In line, the Hang Seng index closed with losses, as broader sentiment darkened after an explosion at a Gaza hospital dampened hopes of containing the Middle East conflict. The South Korean market ended higher, reversing early losses after strong economic data from China, with automakers leading the gain. The Japanese market closed higher as investors weighed better-than-expected Chinese economic data against the possibility of a more hawkish Federal Reserve. The Australian market ended higher as mining and energy stocks led Australian shares to close higher on Wednesday on higher oil prices. Thus, NIKKEI +0.01%; HANG SENG -0.23%; CSI 300 -0.79%; S&P/ASX 200 +0.30%; KOSPI +0.10%; SHANGHAI COMPOSITE -0.80% ended with mixed returns.




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
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
Principal Metals Index (3 months)




Foreign Exchange Indices (3 months)


