Peru: The General Index of the BVL closed the session today with a negative result of -0.32%. The index maintains a positive accumulated trend of +0.44% in local currency and a negative accumulated trend of -0.53% in dollar-adjusted currency. Regarding the S&P/BVL Peru SEL, it varied by +0.39%, while the S&P/BVL LIMA 25 increased by +2.16%. The PEN spot reached S/.3.7406. **Headline:** Antofagasta Effect, entry into Buenaventura would attract more Chilean mining companies to Peru.

Chile: The IPSA index has maintained a negative return of -0.32% so far today. The least benefited sectors of the day were Energy (-2.06%) and Industrial (-1.77%). The best-performing stocks were Viña Concha and CENCOSUD SA at +1.76%, while the worst-performing companies were SOC QUIMICA Y MINERA CHILE-B at -3.10% and EMPRESAS COPEC SA at -1.92%. **Headline:** Deputy Gael Yeomans (CS): "There will be no winners if the pension reform is rejected, there will only be losers, and they will be the retirees."

Colombia: The COLCAP index maintained a negative performance during the session of -0.86%. The least benefited sectors of the day were Energy (-1.51%) and Materials (-1.45%). The best-performing stocks were GRUPO DE INV SURAMERICANA-PF at +1.19%, Grupo de GRUPO NUTRESA SA at +1.09%, and CORP FINANCIERA COLOMBIANA at +0.76%. **Headline:** Blow to commerce: sales decreased by 10% in August.

Mexico: The IPC index closed the day in negative territory at -0.73%. The most benefited sectors of the day were Materials (-0.03%) and Consumer Goods (+0.00%). The worst-performing stocks were CEMEX SAB-CPO at -1.26%, BECLE SAB DE CV at -1.20%, and GRUPO AEROPORTUARIO DEL CENT at -1.08%. **Headline:** Mexico cannot copy Chile: Pensions cannot be financed solely by the government, warn.

Brazil: The IBOVESPA index closed the day in negative territory at -0.20%. The least benefited sectors of the day were Health (-1.32%) and Materials (-0.61%). The worst-performing stocks were LWSA SA at -2.89%, FLEURY SA at -2.00%, and HYPERA SA at -1.90%. **Headline:** High costs, expensive tickets, indebtedness: airlines go through a perfect storm, and the government is planning a bailout.

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WORLD

United States:

The U.S. market closed with positive returns. This Friday, Wall Street started the day with gains, notably a 0.14% increase in the Dow Jones Industrial Average, its primary indicator, signaling a return of investor confidence towards stock purchases. After a year beginning with downward trends in the market, the indices showed positive signs, with the Dow Jones reaching 37,519 points and the S&P 500 recording a 0.14% increase, reaching 4,787 points. This shift reflects a potential reversal of the recent bearish trend in the stock market. The Nasdaq index, composed of major technology companies, experienced a 0.35% increase, reaching 15,107 units. Technology sector stocks opened the day with gains, following the positive trend observed yesterday. This boost came after Bank of America raised its price recommendation for Apple shares, indicating that the company could benefit this year from advancements in artificial intelligence technology. Thus, DOW JONES +0.54%, S&P 500 +0.66%, and NASDAQ +0.88% concluded with positive results.

Europe:

The main European indices concluded the session with mixed results. The pan-European STOXX 600 closed lower, influenced by statements from policymakers of major central banks. Earlier in the week, members of the ECB's Governing Council indicated that markets were overestimating the extent of the central bank's interest rate cuts for this year, while the Federal Reserve urged caution ahead of its easing cycle. The UK market, represented by the FTSE 100, closed with positive outcomes, experiencing a 0.04% increase at Friday's close, driven by widespread gains, particularly in the energy and mobile telecommunications sectors. The French market, reflected in the CAC 40, concluded with losses. In the business sector, leading luxury companies extended their decline, with Kering (-1.06%), Hermes (-0.68%), and LVMH (-0.59%) leading the downturn. This occurred against a backdrop of strict financial conditions and sluggish growth in China, continuing to exert pressure on the sector. Thus, FTSE 100 +0.04%; CAC 40 -0.40%; DAX -0.07%; STOXX 600 -0.26% ended with mixed results.

Asia:

The main Asian indices closed with mixed performances. The Chinese market ended with negative returns, with stocks in Hong Kong and mainland China falling due to economic and policy uncertainties. Foreign direct investment (FDI) in China decreased by 8% year-on-year, reaching CNY 1.13 trillion or \$157.1 billion in 2023, indicating that foreign investors have not fully returned to the country after the impact of Covid-19. The South Korean market ended positively, with the KOSPI rising by 1.34%, a key indicator of South Korea's economic health closely monitored by both domestic and international investors. Attention will focus on whether the index maintains its upward trend in the coming week. The Japanese market closed higher, with the Nikkei 225 rising by 1.4% to close at 35,963, and the Topix index gaining 0.72%, marking a rebound from a three-day decline in Japanese stocks due to decreasing inflationary pressures. Japanese stocks followed gains on Wall Street, led by strong corporate results that boosted US technology stocks. The Australian market closed in positive territory, with the S&P/ASX 200 rising by 1.02% to 7,421 on Friday, reversing a five-day decline and following gains on Wall Street driven by robust corporate results in US technology. Australian stocks benefited from the recovery in commodity prices, particularly in mining and energy stocks. Thus, NIKKEI +1.40%; HANG SENG -0.54%; CSI 300 -0.15%; S&P/ASX 200 +1.02%; KOSPI +1.34%; SHANGHAI COMPOSITE -0.47% ended with mixed returns.




