Peru: The LSE General index ended today's session with a negative result of -0.14%. The index maintains a positive annual cumulative trend of +8.93% in local currency and a positive cumulative trend of +6.70% in dollar-adjusted currency. Regarding the S&P/BVL Peru SEL, it varied +3.51% while the S&P/BVL LIMA 25 varied +0.53%. The spot PEN reached S/.3.7915. Javier Artica. Headline: Peruvian economy: the sectors that would grow without "rebound" effect in 2024.

Chile: The IPSA index ended the day with a negative return of -0.52%. The sectors that lost the most during the day were Industrials (-2.30%) and Communications (-1.40%). The worst performing stocks were CAP SA (-4.63%) and Sociedad Química y Minera de C (-4.30%). Headline: Catalina Vergara. The value of the Basic Food Basket rose in January and returned to \$69 thousand.

Colombia: The COLCAP index ended the session with a positive return of 2.07%. The sectors that benefited the most during the day were Financials (+3.94%) and Utilities (+1.01%). The best performing stocks were Empresa Bancolombia SA (+5.23%) and Bancolombia SA (+5.13%). Headline: Government to invest \$75 billion to boost connectivity in the Amazon.

Mexico: The IPC index closed the day in negative territory -0.46%. The sectors that lost the most during the day were Personal Care (-2.10%) and Real Estate (-1.48%). The worst performing stocks were Coca-Cola Femsa SAB de CV (-3.83%) and Grupo Bimbo SAB de CV (-3.46%). Headline: CCE 'lights the candles' to nearshoring: Mexico can grow at 4% due to relocation, affirms.

Brazil: The IBOVESPA index closed the day in positive territory of +0.68%. The most benefited sectors of the day were Consumer Discretionary (+2.10%) and Industrials (+2.08%). The best performing stocks were Atacadao SA (+11.16%) and Pet Center Comercio e Particip (8.02%). Headline: Petrobras loses appeal in Carf and fails to cancel





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MILA: Intraday Evolution




MILA: Curvas de Deuda Soverana




MILA: Foreign Exchange Indices (3 months)

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WORLD

United States:

The US market closed with mixed returns. The DOW JONES closed with losses, since the latest figures showed that durable goods orders in January contracted more than expected at 6.1%, marking the most pronounced decline since April 2020. The S&P 500 index ended with positive returns, as traders exercised caution and closely monitored comments from Fed officials in search of perspectives on future monetary policy as we approach key economic data later in the week, such as PCE inflation and the second GDP growth estimate. Finally, the NASDAQ index ended the day in the green, since despite NVIDIA experiencing a decrease of 0.4%, other large-cap stocks ended mixed. Amazon lost 0.68%, while Apple, Meta, and Alphabet gained 0.81%, 1.1%, and 0.97%, respectively. Despite offering weak guidance, Macy's and Lowe's recorded gains of 3.31% and 1.86%, respectively, while Zoom Video and Hims & Hers Health reported earnings that exceeded expectations, leading to increases of 8% and 31.02%, respectively. In this way, DOW JONES -0.25%, S&P 500 +0.17%, NASDAQ +0.37%, with the market having mixed returns.

Europe:

The main European indices closed with mostly negative returns. The pan-European STOXX 600 index closed the session with positive returns. Investors remained focused on corporate updates while awaiting key economic data. The Stoxx 600 continued its upward trend, surpassing the 496-point mark, supported by a 1.7% increase in mining stocks, although media stocks fell by 1.1%. In the UK market, the FTSE index closed the session negatively as investors evaluated varied corporate performance reports amid macroeconomic uncertainty for the upcoming year. Industrial mining companies recorded significant gains, benefiting from some relief in base and ferrous metal prices following the declines in the previous session, attributed to pessimism about the demand from Chinese manufacturers and builders. Anglo American saw a 2.1% increase, while Rio Tinto, Endeavour, and Antofagasta advanced approximately 1%. Similarly, the German market closed positively for the fifth consecutive day. Investors are closely watching upcoming economic data, including preliminary inflation figures for Germany and the Eurozone, to assess the possibility of the ECB lowering interest rates, with most investors anticipating a rate cut in June. The GfK Consumer Climate Indicator showed a slight improvement in consumer confidence in Germany for March, but concerns persist over rising prices as weaker economic forecasts for the country. In the French market, the session closed with gains, led by Bouygues with an 8% increase, surpassing projections for 2023. Alstom, STMicroelectronics, and Unibail-Rodamco-Westfield also recorded gains. However, Euronics Scientific fell by 6.89% due to a decline in net profits. Thus, FTSE 100 -0.02%; CAC 40 +0.23%; DAX +0.76%; STOXX 600 +0.18% closed with mixed recorded gains.

Asia:

The main Asian indices closed with mostly positive performances. The Chinese market closed positive, thanks to a rally in artificial intelligence companies on the back of a strong outlook for the sector, boosted by the artificial intelligence boom in the United States. In addition, investors are also watching the National People's Congress, which starts on March 5, for signs of greater political support from Beijing. Hong Kong's Hang Seng index ended in the green, after a sharp drop in morning trading, amid a shift in sentiment following a rally in Chinese stocks as bets increased that Beijing will launch more supportive measures during the annual plenary sessions in early March. The South Korean market ended negative, where caution prevailed today ahead of next Thursday's release of the US Personal Consumption Expenditure (PCE) price index, which may determine the Fed's next monetary policy moves. The Japanese market also closed higher, with Japanese stocks hovering near record highs as investors reacted to the latest inflation report, which noted that Japan's headline and core inflation rates slowed to 2.2% and 2% in January from 2.6% and 2.3% in December, respectively, the lowest reading since March 2022. The Australian market ended with gains as positive corporate news boosted market sentiment. Investors are also keeping an eye on key inflation figures in the U.S. and Australia, which could influence upcoming policy decisions by their respective central banks. Thus, NIKKEI +0.01%; HANG SENG +0.94%; CSI 300 +1.20%; S&P/ASX 200 +0.13%; KOSPI -0.83%; SHANGHAI COMPOSITE +1.29% ended with mostly positive returns.


