



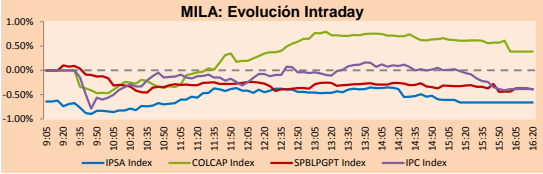

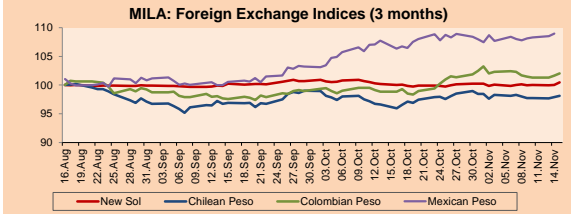
### MILA

Peru: The general index of the BVL of Peru ended today's session with a negative value of -0.39%. The index maintains a cumulative positive annual trend of +24.77% in local currency, while the adjusted return to foreign currency is +28.56%. Then, the S&P/BVL Peru SEL obtained a negative result of -0.87%, while the S&P/BVL LIMA 25 decreased -0.52%. The spot PEN reached S/3.2570.

Chile: The IPSA index ended the day with a negative result of -0.66%. The sectors of the index with the negative results were Materials (-2.35%) and Non-basic consumption products (-1.65%). On the other hand, the values with the most bearish results were Sociedad Química and Minera de Chile SA (-3.38%) and Inversiones Aguas Metropolitanas SA (-3.23%).

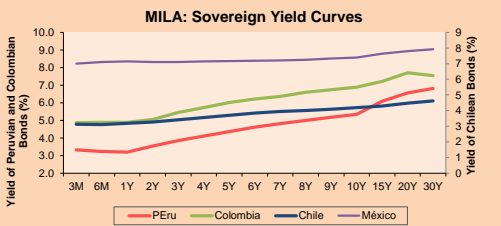
Colombia: The COLCAP index closed the session with positives of +0.38%. The sectors with upward yields were Industrial (+1.54%) and Materials (+1.23%). In addition, the stocks with the highest yields were Promigas SA (+3.27%) and Grupo de Inversiones Suramericana (+2.22%).

Mexico: Mexico's IPC index closed today's session with a negative yield of -0.38%. The sectors of the index that generated the most negative yields of Materials (-1.42%) and Public Services (-0.60%). Finally, the stocks with the lowest returns were Grupo México SAB de CV (-2.93%) and Alfa SAB de CV (-2.13%).

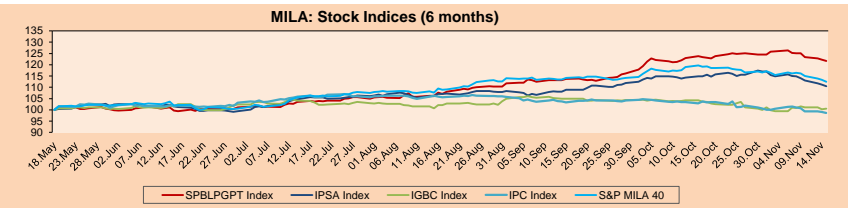

## Global Overview

### United States:

The US stock market finished the day with results, due to the sharp fall in the price of oil and concerns about the progress of the revision of taxes. In more detail, the West Texas intermediate crude oil fell -0.79%, trading at 55.19 dollars per barrel, after the US Petroleum Institute reported Tuesday night of an excess of accumulation in the US crude oil and gasoline inventories. These being released by the US Energy Information Administration showed on Wednesday that national crude supplies increased by 1.9 million barrels for the week ended November 10. Meanwhile, concerns about the progress of tax-cutting legislation in Washington dragged on Wednesday. In addition, the Senate Finance Committee released major changes to its fiscal legislation on Tuesday night, including the repeal of Obamacare's individual mandate. Finally in business data, the shares of Boeing Co. rose + 0.21%, after the aircraft manufacturer announced an agreement to sell Flydubai, based in Dubai, up to 225 aircraft plus 737 Max 8 at a price list price of 27 billion dollars.

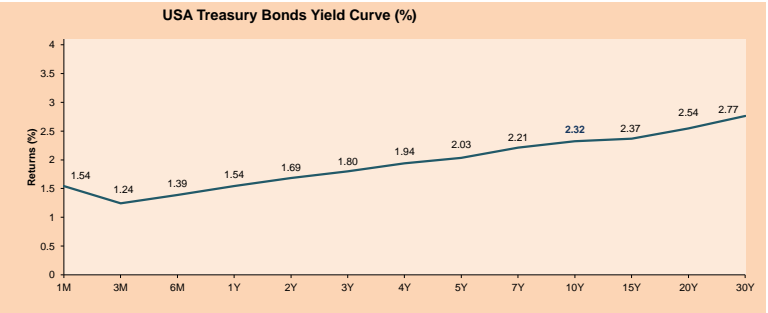
### Europe:

The European stock market ended the session a negative results, the fall in the price of oil by reducing the price of the shares of energy producers and a fall in the prices of metals which reduced the prices of the main mining companies. In greater detail, copper prices fell -0.52% that measure came after China's disappointing data on industrial production and housing sales raised concerns about the slowdown in growth, the world's second largest economy. In addition, the price of Brent oil fell more than -0.7%, extending the losses recorded on Tuesday after the US Petroleum Institute registered an unexpected increase in the weekly inventories of the US. Oil losses deepened in the afternoon after data from the US Energy Information Administration. UU it will show that national crude supplies rose last week, offsetting forecasts that predicted a decline. In macroeconomic data, the Office of National Statistics of Great Britain published figures of employment and wages on Wednesday reporting that the total number of jobs fell in the period July-September, the first decline since 2015. In addition the average annual growth of wages remained at 2.2%, which means that British wages fell by 0.5% when adjusted for inflation. Currently inflation is 3%, above the Bank of England's target is 2%.

### Asia:

The Asian stock market ended today's session with negative results among its main indices. This was due to the fact that investors continued to evaluate how commodity prices fell significantly in October, while there were increases in the equity market. According to some strategists, the overnight weakness seen in the United States and in Europe has made the beginning of the week in the Asian region to be soggy. Among the news that stood out the most, in Australia, third-quarter wages grew less than expected (+0.5%), even though there was a large increase in the minimum wage earlier this year. It also highlighted the difficulty that the Australian central bank faces to return inflation to its target band over time, which suggests that it is likely that it will continue waiting for the start of interest rate hikes. On the other hand, in Japan, the Nikkei 225 stock index fell by 0.9%, reaching almost a minimum intraday in November. The explanation for this was the fall in oil prices (due to a pessimistic reading of the inventory of the United States) and the strengthening of the yen against the US dollar (removing international competitiveness from exporters).

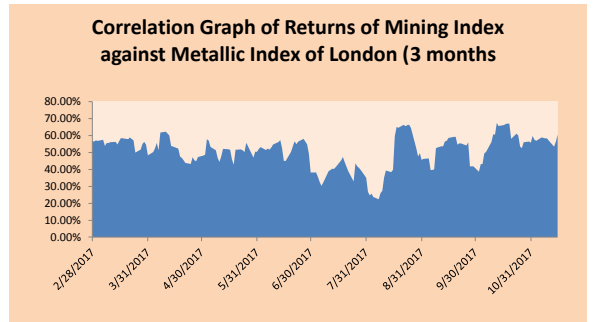

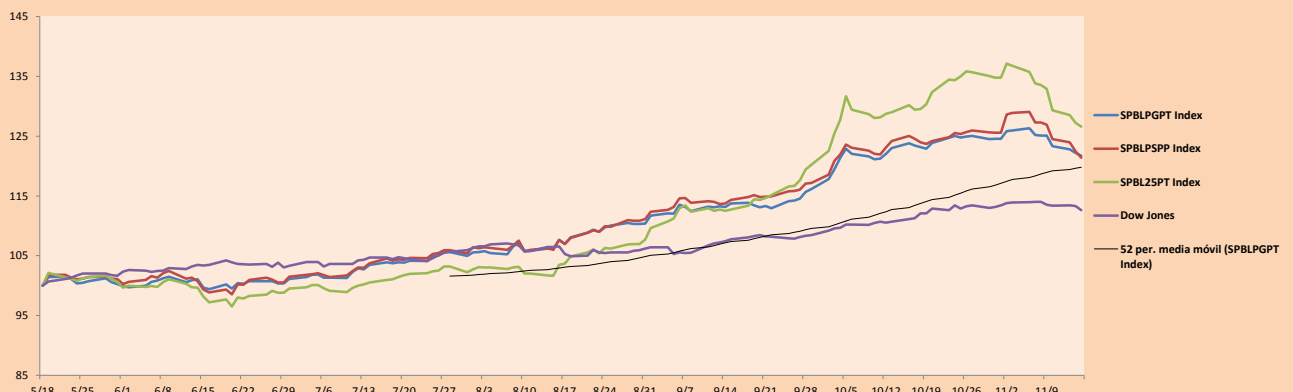

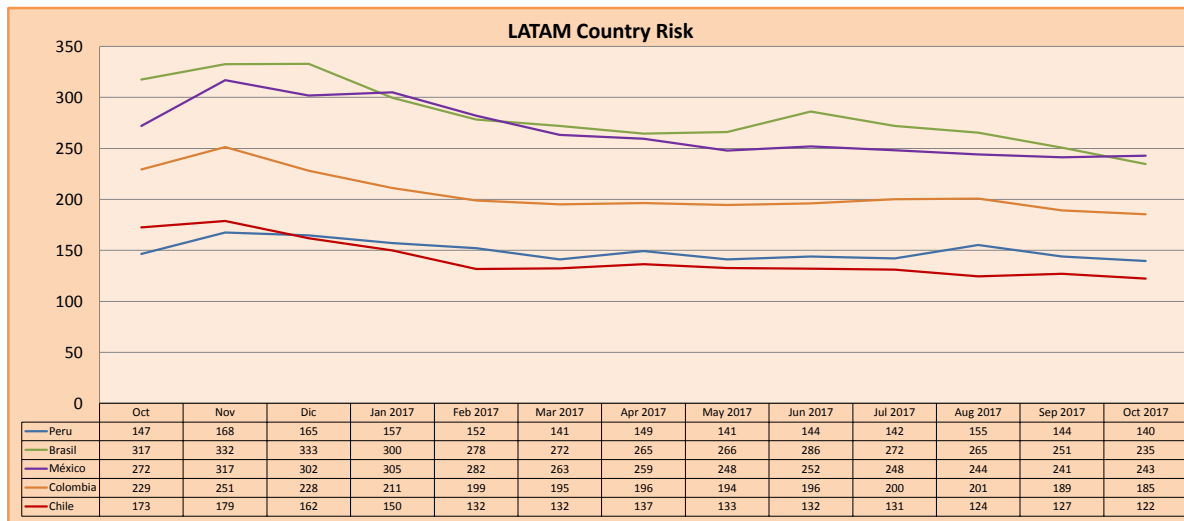
