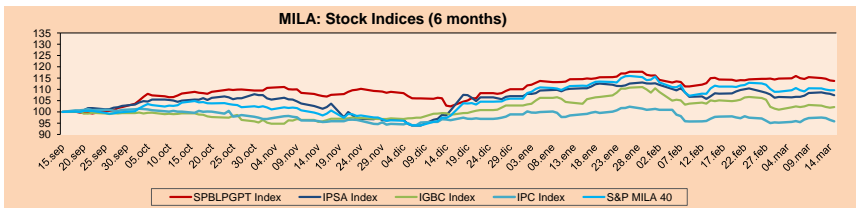
### MILA

Peru: The General Index of the BVL of Peru ended today's session with a negative result of -0.22%. The index maintains a cumulative positive annual trend of +3.33% in local currency, while the yield adjusted to foreign currency is +2.55%. Then, the S&P/BVL Peru SEL obtained a negative yield of -0.22%, while the S&P/BVL LIMA 25 decreased -0.47. The spot PEN reached S/3.2622.

Chile: The IPSA index ended the day with a negative yield of -0.56%. The sectors of the index with the most negative results were Industrial (-1.69%) and Materials (-1.14%). On the other hand, the securities with the most bearish results were Lan Airlines SA (-2.53%) and Sociedad Química y Minera de Chile SA (-2.21%).

Colombia: The COLCAP index closed the session with positive results of +0.24%. The sectors with upward yields were Energy (+1.11%) and Materials (+0.66%). In addition, the stocks with the highest yields were Cementos Argos SA (+3.48%) and Promigas SA (+2.58%).

Mexico: Mexico's IPC index closed today's session with a negative yield of -0.70%. The sectors of the index that generated the most negative results were Finance (-1.54%) and Non-basic consumer products (-1.44%). Finally, the stocks with the lowest returns were Grupo Elektra SAB de CV (-3.62%) and Promotora and Infrastructure Operator SAB de CV (-3.21%).

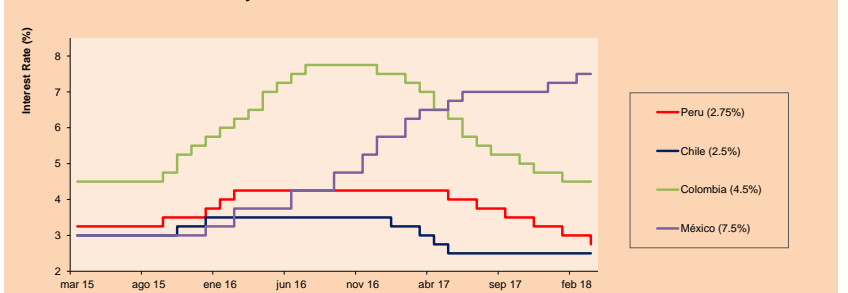

## Global Overview

### United States:

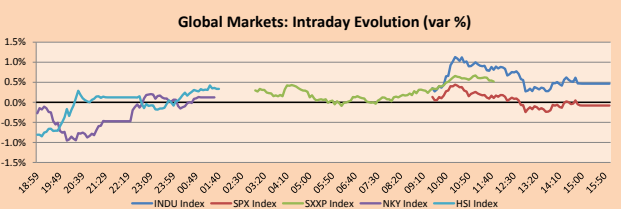
The US stock market closed the day with mixed results among its main indices. The "Dow Jones Industrial" index trimmed profits, closing with its lowest figure in three consecutive sessions. Likewise, the "S & P 500" index and the "Nasdaq" technology index closed in negative territory, falling by -0.2% each. Today, the president of the United States, Donald Trump, wrongly said in a tweet that Canada has a trade surplus with the United States, when in fact it is the other way around. On the other hand, initial claims for unemployment in the US decreased by 4,000, reaching 226,000 in the first days of March, which shows that they have remained at a minimum of 50 years. On the other hand, the import price index increased by +0.4% in February, reflecting that the costs paid by Americans for foreign goods and services are higher. Analysts report that economic publications show that not only the US economy is expanding, but also Europe and China, but we are closer to the end of this cycle of economic boom. In addition, they add that the good news that would boost the markets this year was already given and internalized. Regarding the companies, Walmart Inc. fell close to -0.8% on the day after reports showed that there is a lawsuit against the company alleging that it would have manipulated its numbers to catch up with Amazon.com Inc.

### Europe:

The European stock market ended the day with positive results in its main indexes of blue 35. In the British news, the index ended with a slight gain on Thursday, helped the advances in the giant supermarket Tesco PLC then that the influential analysts in JP Morgan Cazenove update in the shares in the supermarket giant, improving its rating, this generated that the shares rose 1.7%. On the other hand, Unilever chose Rotterdam as the main venue for London, but insists that Brexit was not a factor in its decision. The decision remains a revision of its double corporate structure, which began after the adoption of a focus on the acquisition of £ 115bn from the US food giant Kraft Heinz a year ago. In addition, the Netherlands offers better protection against hostile takeovers than the United Kingdom. Unilever said its 7,300 employees in the United Kingdom and 3,100 in the Netherlands will not be affected by the changes and that it will maintain its construction in Blackfriars in London. It will move a small number of people from London to Rotterdam.

### Asia:

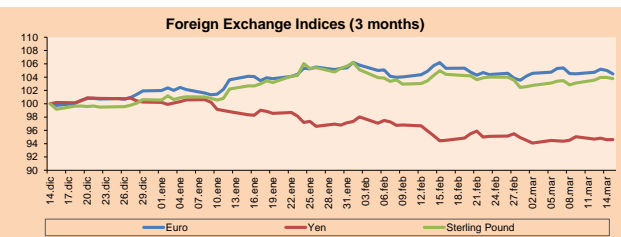
The Asian stock market finished the day with mixed results among its main indices, with bearish yields being more notable. This is due to the influence of the US market on the rest of the world, because protectionist trade policies have weakened its industrial sector, thus dragging the Asian market. This effect was to be reflected in the shares traded on the stock exchanges of Japan and Hong Kong, as they initially fell more than 1%; however, when investors noticed the oversold, they intervened and pushed the Nikkei and the Hang Seng into positive territory again. The recovery of Hong Kong was helped, in part, by the flows to the South of China, while the Nikkei was favored by the decline of the Yen. Among other news, Vasu Menon, a senior investor with the OCB Bank, said that fear persists that President Trump will keep his promise to impose significant tariffs on China, which could harm all of Asia. While China could retaliate, causing a trade war, the head of equities of BNP Paribas Investment Partners said that if tariffs are limited to aluminum and steel, China could remain non-aggressive.

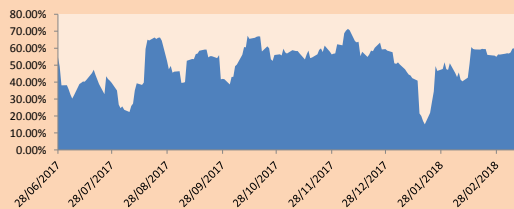

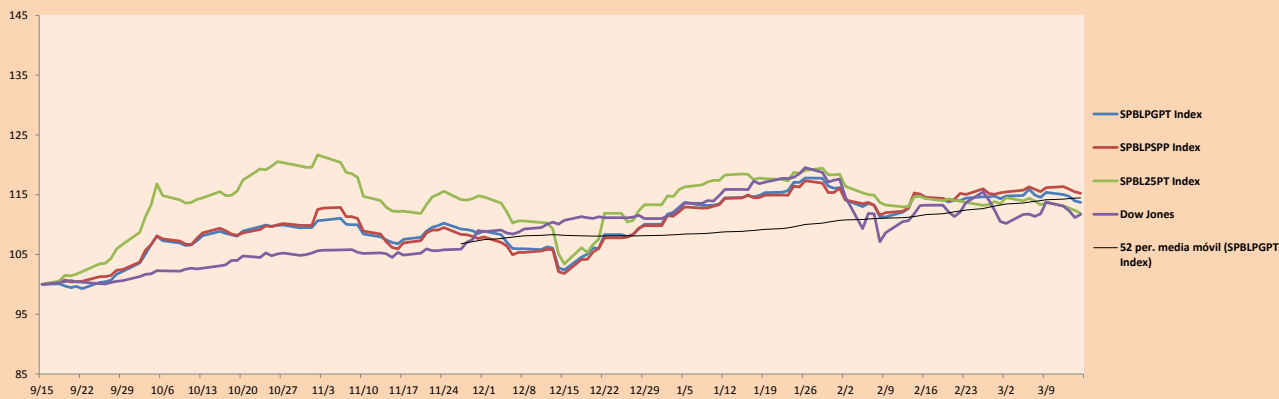
