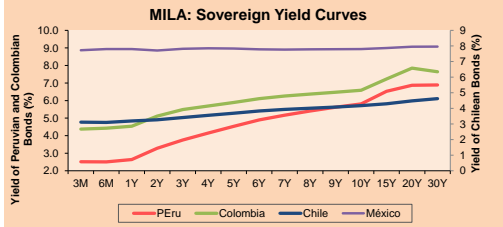

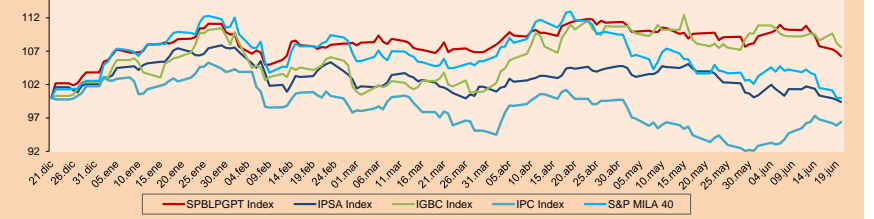
Peru: The General Index of the BVL of Peru ended today's session with a negative result of -0.59%. The index maintains a cumulative positive annual trend of +2.36% in local currency, while the adjusted return on foreign currency is +1.08%. Then, the S&P/BVL Peru SEL obtained a negative yield of -0.51%, while the S&P/BVL LIMA25 decreased -0.66%. The spot PEN reached S/3.2786.

Chile: The IPSA index ended the day with a negative result of -0.32%. The sectors of the index with the downward results were Industrial (-1.08%) and Materials (-0.93%). On the other hand, the securities with the most negative results were Lan Airlines SA (-2.05%) and Inversiones la Construcción SA (-1.34%).

Colombia: The COLCAP index had a negative yield of -0.34%. The sectors of the index with the least favorable results were Energy (-0.99%) and Materials (-0.51%). On the other hand, the stocks with the highest losses were Inversiones Argos SA (+ 4.94%) and Grupo Aval Acciones y Valores SA (-1.64%).

Mexico: Mexico's IPC index closed today's session with a positive result of +0.58%. The sectors of the index that generated the highest results were Public Services (+2.10%) and Finance (+2.08%). Finally, the shares with the higher yields were Asea SAB de CV (+3.46%) and Grupo Financiero Banorte SAB de CV (+2.73%).

MILA: Stock Indices (6 months)



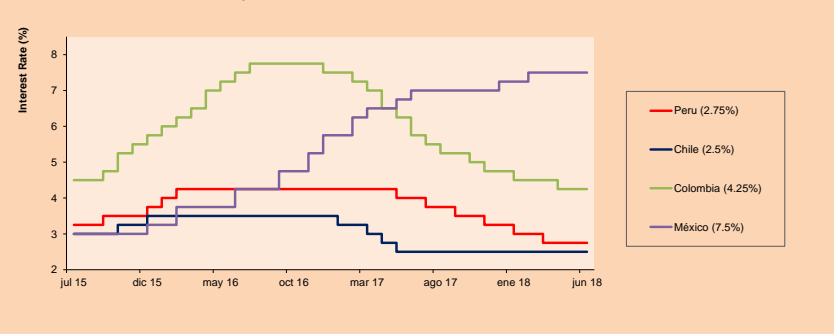

Global Overview:

United States:

The US market ended the session with mixed results, driven by the recovery of the technology sector after concerns among investors about the US-China trade tension eased temporarily. The S&P 500 broke a losing streak of 3 consecutive days while the Nasdaq hit its all-time high. It seems that a sense of calm is returning to the markets after Trump increased trade threats to China earlier in the week. Meanwhile, Fed Chairman Jerome Powell said today that the federal funds rate is close to 100 bps below the neutral rate, with a current upper limit of 2%, it means that he believes the neutral rate is 3%, which is in line with the long-term rate. In business news, General Electric has been replaced by Walgreens Boots Alliance in the Dow Jones Industrial Average, on the other hand, Walt Disney is close to winning US antitrust approval for its \$71 billion deal to acquire 21st Century Fox. In other news, the price of oil rose after US government data revealed the biggest weekly drop in American crude supplies since January.

Europe:

The European stock market ended the day today with positive results among its main indices. The shares recovered today in what investors assimilate further deterioration in the commercial relationship between the United States and China. In addition, investors are watching the events of the next OPEC meeting in Vienna, after the Secretary General of the same, Mohammad Barkindo, delivered his opening speech for the group's international seminar and the oil ministers began to make comments in the margin. For its part, the benchmark Stoxx 600 of Europe grew by +0.28%, partially recovering the loss it obtained on Tuesday when it fell by -0.7%. On the other hand, UK stocks closed at +0.31% according to their FTSE 100 index. This was mainly benefited by tobacco companies after Libernor, a British investment bank, gave purchase ratings to the companies. British American Tobacco and Imperial Brands, making the price of their shares rise by +2.38% and +3.20% respectively. On the other hand, the price of Berkeley Group Holdings shares fell by -5.90% after they announced that they expect their earnings to be close to 30% lower for the 2019 fiscal year.

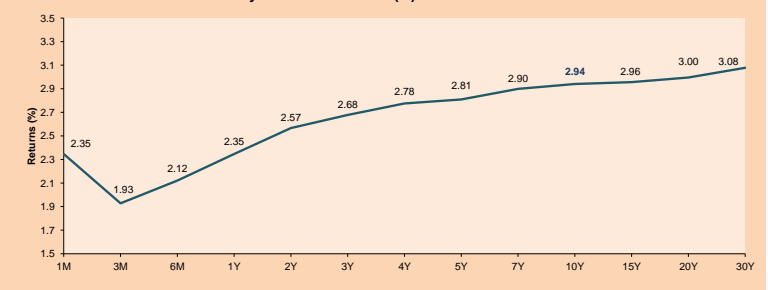
Asia:

The Asian stock market ended the day with positive results among its main indices. Like other markets, shares quoted in Tokyo fell sharply on Tuesday as the trade dispute between China and the United States intensified, and Japanese companies' dependent on Chinese demand hit hard. However, in China's trade it gained 0.6% and the Shenzhen Composite Index rose 1.4%, which triggered a short hedge in Japanese equities, as China's shares appeared to be taking the strains of world trade in its stride, although just temporarily. On the other hand, health stocks increased as fears of the commercial war increased, Healthcare was the biggest advance, as investors sought safety in the defensive sector amid growing concern about a global trade war. The sub-group of health stocks rose almost 1.9%, its biggest daily gain since March 8, led by earnings at Samsung Biologics, which rose 10% before its hearing on accounting issues later in the day. Daiichi Sankyo rose 5.2% after Citi raised the projections, saying the outlook for his cancer drugs has improved.

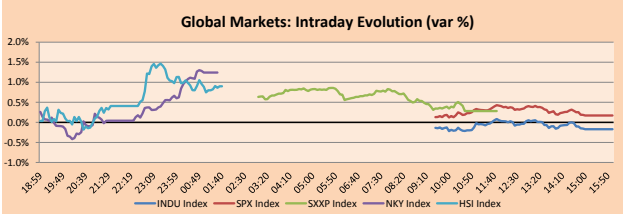

USA Treasury Bonds Yield Curve (%)



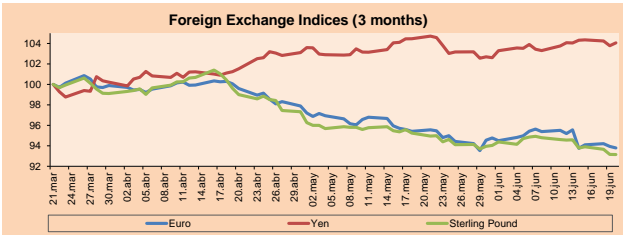

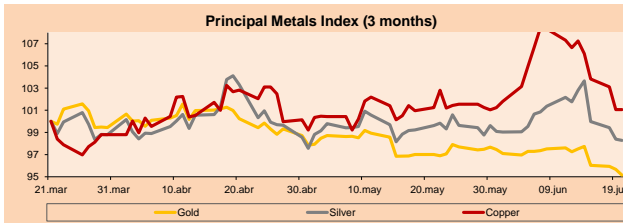

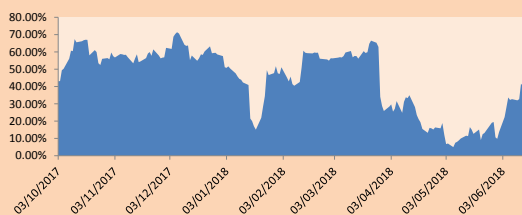

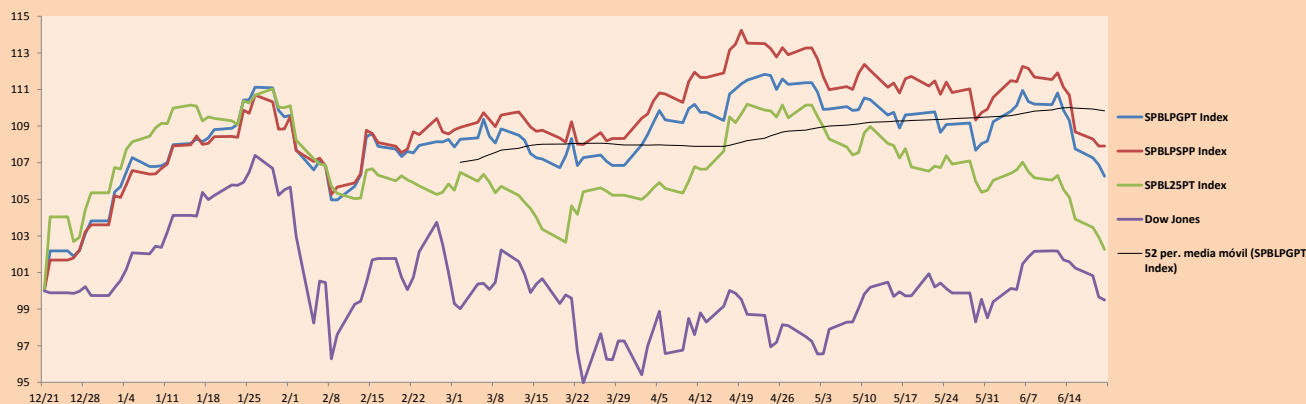

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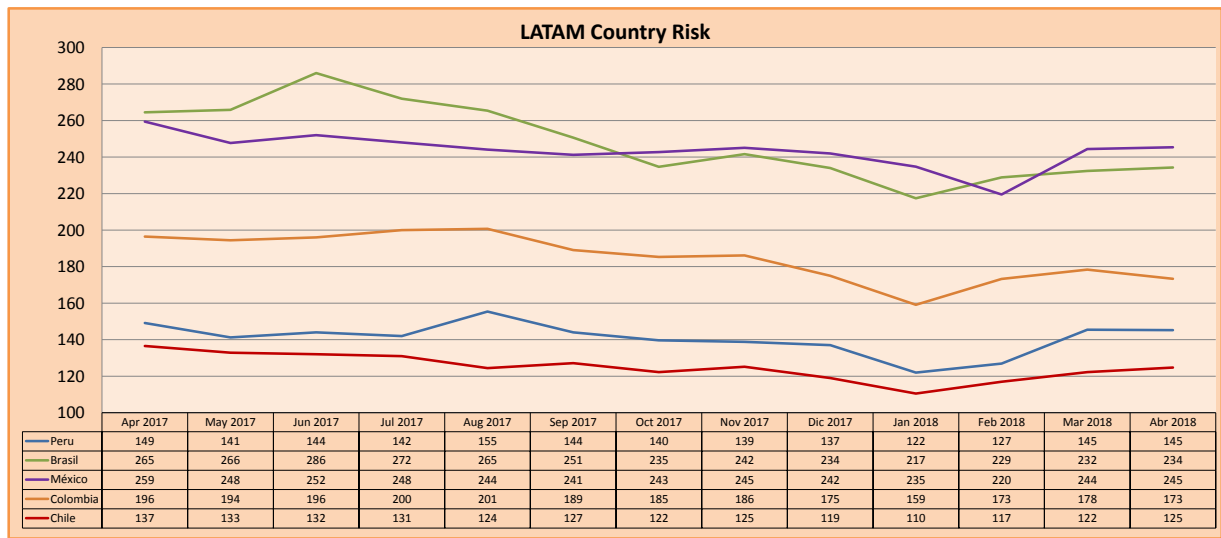
