


Chile: The IPSA index ended the day with a negative return of -0.75%. The sectors of the index with the most discouraging results were Industrial (-2.24%) and Energy (-1.67%). In the same way, the values with the lowest results were Salfacorp SA (-2.73%) and Ripley Corporación SA (-2.39%).

Colombia: The COLCAP index closed the session with a positive result of + 0.53%. The sectors with the best yields were Energy (+1.17%) and Finance (+0.90%). Additionally, the stocks with the highest yields were those of Grupo de Inversiones Suramericana-PF (+3.34%, preferred share) and Grupo de Inversiones Suramericana (+2.66%, common stock).

Mexico: Mexico's IPC index closed today's session with a negative yield of -0.29%. The sectors of the index that generated the most negative results were Health (-2.27%) and Telecommunications Services (-1.70%). Finally, the stocks with the lowest yields were Industrias Peñoles SAB de CV (-2.39%) and Genomma Lab Internacional SAB de CV (-2.27%).

## **Global Overview:**

# **United States:**

The US stock market closed the session with mixed results among its main indices. The S&P 500 index ended the session at 2913.98 points, which represented a variation of +0.02 points from the previous closing. During the day the index oscillated between +0.21% and -0.20%, after a fall at the beginning of the session. Of the 501 companies whose shares make up the index, 298 had a positive performance, among which the one that had the best daily performance was budgeting from the companies of the performance was budgeting to the performance, among which the one that had the best daily performance was budgeting for the performance was budgeting to the performance was budgeting HP Inc (+ 0.7%), Lenovo Group Ltd (+ 2.7%). The DJIA closed the session with a yield of + 0.07% after closing at 26458.31 points, of the basket of 30 Blue Chip shares that make up the index, 18 rose and 12 declined in price as DowDupont Inc, which fell by -1.50%. In other news, Elon Musk said he could agree with regulators in the US who have sued him to abandon the leadership of Tesla but is prepared to dispute the fraud claim against him in front of the court.


### **Europe:**

The European market closed the session with negative returns among its main indices. The DAX ended the day with a decline of -1.52%, the CAC 40 of France fell by -0.85% and the FTSE 100 index maintained the same behavior (-0.47%). Among the main news, finance ministers and central bank governors of the world's 20 largest economies will meet to discuss whether trade tensions can have an adverse effect on world growth and investment, and reject protectionism for resolve WTO disputes. On the other hand, the FTSE MIB fell -3.72%, putting the index on track to its worst record since the end of January 2016, which highlights that the Italian government will publish on Thursday the budget targets for a deficit of 2.4% compared to GDP for 2019, marking a 0.8% increase in public spending. This undermines Italy's credit rating, worsening the outlook for debt and putting Rome and its government on a collision course with Brussels over the EU's fiscal rules. In addition, government bonds were sold massively, which caused the performance of the Italian 10-year bond to be placed at 3.245%, compared to Thursday that was at 2.910%.

## Asia:

The Asian market ended with positive returns among its main indices. Despite having a hard start this month, the Nikkei index managed to recover: Overcame 7 days of losses and then generated +5.57% during the rest of September, to close today +1.36% as leader of the day. In this way, the linest marked its highest level so far this year and during the day it managed to reach 24,286.10, the highest level since November 1991, although it finally closed at a lower level. One to companies with the best performance was Sony, which grew by 4.52% and reached its highest value in the last 11 years. The Japanese market would be benefiting from the increase in interest rates in the United States, which would cause investors to look for higher-yield products abroad. On the other hand, the yen continues to depreciate and reached a maximum value of the last 9 months, however, this benefits the firms that trade abroad and repatriate their profits to Japan. Among the main exporters benefited are Nintendo (+1.54%) and Subaru (+2.26%). The Hang Seng (+0.26%) of Hong Kong and the Shanghai Composite (+1.06%) of China repeated the dynamics of the Nikkei this month, however, the Hang Seng fell short and still could not surpass its values

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


