



### **Global Overview:**

#### **United States:**

The US markets will end the day with mixed results. The main indices ended with the following results, S&P500 ended down -0.00%, NASDAQ finished up + 0.07% and DOW JONES finished down -0.19%. The Fed cuts rates by a quarter point on Wednesday, which is intended to serve as insurance against the negative impacts on the economy related to world conflicts (Commercial Warfare, etc.). On the other hand, the president of Donald Trump criticized this measure of the Fed as "They fail again. Without guts, without meaning, without vision!" Also, this cut reduced the target rate range to 1.75% to 2%. With respect to the commercial war, face-to-face conversations will be resumer which aims to lay the foundations for negotiation towards a solution or are aimed at creating new and higher tariffs for producers in the other country. Amazon, Jeff Bezos, promised to modify his company to develop an e-commerce by buying repair wans so as not to pollute the environment. The companie's with the best results of the day were Microsoft Corp (+1.84%), Merck & Co Inc (+1.14%) belonging to the Dow Jones Industrial index.


#### Europe:

European markets ended the day with a rising result. Its main index, Euro Stoxx 50, had a growth in the day of + 0.61%. Despite this growth in the eurozone, not everything was positive since, the British minister, Stephen Barclay, warned that the Spanish economy would suffer an impact of a "hard" Brexit. In addition, he showed his concern for small and medium-sized Spanish companies. "If there is no agreement with the EU, the Spanish economy would accuse the impact a Sparish worned in his speech at the Informative Breakfasts of Europa Press. Finally, Barclay expressed the desire of the British Government for a friendly exit from the EU before October 31, "The European Commission says it is fully prepared for this event, but not all medium and small businesses in Europe are it, doubt that Spanish SMEs are prepared on non-agreement," he said. The United Kingdom also asks the European Union to be" flexible "in the negotiations, but Finland wants a written proposal by the of September, Finally, the OECD (Organization for Economic Cooperation and Development) spread its predictions of the global economy predicting that the international economy State will suffer a notable setaback this year, "the global economy faces serious winds against it and the slow growth is consolidating in a worrying way" Said Laurence Boone, chief economist of the entity.

#### Asia:

Asian markets closed today's session with mixed results, amid new cuts expected by the Fed after yesterday's meeting. The Fed reduced its interest rate by 25 basis points to a range of 1.75% to 2%. However, the central bank seemed childed on the next course to take for the year. This cut produced measures in the region. The monetary a unthority of Hong Kong adjusted its base rate down by 25 basis points to 2.25%. Instead, the Bank of Japan (Bol) kept the monetary policy stable; that is, it kept its short-term interest rate objective a 0.1% and a promise to guide the 10-year government bond yields around 0%. After that decision, the Japanese yen traded at 108.06 against the dollar. On the other hand, after the report on employment data, the Australian dollar traded around 50.677, when in the previous session it had flips above 5 0.684. In this way, the Shanghai Composite and Shenzhen indices of China rose + 0.46% and + 1.03%, but Hong Kong's Hang Seng ended down -1.07%. The Nikkei rose + 0.38% and the S&P / AX 200 by + 0.54%, among others.


