



#### MILA:

Peru: The BVL General Index ended today's session with a negative result of -0.14%. The index maintains a positive annual cumulative trend of +12.49% in local currency, while the dollar-adjusted return amounts to +18.98%. Then, the S&P/BVL Peru SEL varied by +3.11% while the S&P/BVL LIMA 25 by -0.11%. The spot PEN reached S/.3.7810. Headline: Wheat prices could rise up to 60% if conflict between Russia and Ukraine is prolonged.

Chile: The IPSA index ended the day with a positive result of +1.54%. The top gainers of the day were information technology (+5.35%) and materials (+4.19%). The best performers were Sociedad Química y Minera (+6.08%) and Sonda SA (+5.35%). Headline: IPSA closes third session higher and shrugs off new fall in external stock markets.

Colombia: The COLCAP index ended the session with a slightly positive return of +0.76%. The best performing sectors are consumer staples (+10.00%) and energy (+5.92%). The best performing stocks are Grupo Nutresa SA (+10.00%) and Ecopetrol SA (+6.49%). Headline: This is how leaders reacted to the January unemployment rate.

Mexico: The IPC index closed the day in positive territory +1.61%. The best performing sectors of the day were financials (+3.27%) and materials (+1.88%). The best performing stocks were Grupo Financiero Banote SAB (+4.80%) and Promotora y Operadora de Infraestructura SAB (+4.16%). Headline: Employment in Mexico. Employment falls in January, the biggest drop since April 2020.

#### **Global Overview:**

#### **United States**


The U.S. market closed with mixed performances after the new sanctions imposed on Russia and the meetings between the countries in conflict ended without progress, which means that a second round of negotiations is expected. The DOW JONES index ended lower, as the PMI decreased to Sci. 3p inits in February from 65.2 in January, which was the lowest reading since August 2020, indicating a possible slowdown. Likewise, wholesale inventories rose 0.8%, indicating a possible slowdown. Likewise, the S&PS00 ended in negative territory where the Real Estate (-1.77%) and Financials (-1.45%) ascorts were the hardest hit as world leaders agreed to take measures to sloalet Moscow from the SWHT global financial system. Also, the pace of inventory accumulation should enter accelerating in the fourth quarter and the increase in the trade deficit would weigh on the economic path in the first few months. However, the fall in 2-year bond yields would suggest that the Fed is constrained by tightening financial conditions. On the other hand, the NASDAQ index was the only index to finish with gains as investors bet that tough sanctions will push the world into clean energy and electric vehicle stocks characterizing them as safe haven assets. Thus, DOW JONES -0.49%, S&P500 -0.24%; NASDAQ +0.41% ended the day with mixed results.

#### Europe:

Europe:
Major European indices ended the session with negative returns as more sanctions have been imposed on Russia for its invasion of Ukraine, and the U.S., Europe and Canada have agreed to remove major Russian banks from the SWIFT interbank messaging system. The pan-European STOXX 600 index ended with losses after Moscow put its nuclear deterrent on high alert in the face of Western retaliation, which included blocking major Russian banks from SWIFT. The British market, reflected in the FTSE 100, ended lower after British energy glant BB announced the withdrawal of its nearly 20% stake in Russian governot cnrotrolled oil glant Rosneft, as it joined Western efforts to isolate Russia. Meanwhile, the DAX index closed in negative territory as, in the context of the war in Ukraine, Deutsche Börse suspends trading in Russian securities, effective immediately. A spokesman promised further suspensions of Russian securities in the event that sanctions are tightened or extended. The French market fell this session as sanctions have multiplied against Russia this weekend, while Ukraine continues to defend its ground against troops sent by Moscow. Thus, FTSE 100-042%; CAC 40-1.39%; DAX-0.73%; STOXX 600-0.09% ended at negative levels.

Major Asian indices closed with mostly positive performances. The Chinese market closed higher, with gains in energy companies +1.49% and commodities, and the China Bureau of Statistics announced that the country set a record for the increase in total energy consumption in a decade, in 2021. The South Korean market closed in positive territory, in a context where an invasion of Ukraine would generate the country of South Korea to take anti-nuclear measures, which could benefit companies such as Dossan Heavy Industries and Korea Hydro. 8 Nuclear Power. In addition, a further tightening of export controls against Russia was announced, banning strategic objects for export. The Hang Seng index ended lower, as the number of dead bodies in hospitals reached its maximum capacity to a record increase in the number of deaths from Covid-19, Japan's NIKKEI closed positive after investors' expectations of a positive outcome to planned talks between Russia and Ukraine eased concerns over the economic impact of tough sanctions on Moscow. Finally, the Australian market railled this session thanks to the mining sector +3.2%, due to the large increase in the price of iron ore, as further armed conflict between Russia and Ukraine could curb the global supply of this main ingredient for steel. Thus, NIKKEI +0.19%; HANG SENG -0.24%, CSI 300 +0.18%; S&P/ASX 200 +0.73%; KOSPI +0.84%; SHANGAI COMPOSITE +0.32% ended with positive performances. Major Asian indices closed with mostly positive performances. The Chinese market closed higher, with gains in energy companies +1.49% and commodities, and the China


