




Chile: The IPSA index ended the day with a negative return of -0.28%. The most damaged sectors of the day were Materials (-2.97%) and Real Estate (-1.57%). The worst performing stocks were Socieded Quimica y minera (-4.60%) and Cencosud (-3.19%). Headline: One week before the plebiscite: investment flows to Chilean funds lose strength and assets fall to US\$ 40 billion.

Colombia: The COLCAP index ended the session with a positive return of -1.07%. The sectors that benefited the most during the day were Utilities (+2.59%) and Energy (+2.54%). The best performing stocks were Interconexiòn Electrica (+4.08%) and Ecopetrol (+2.83%). Headline: The National Budget will have an addition of \$14.14 trillion

Mexico: The IPC index closed the day in positive territory + 1.74%. The day's top gainers were Financials (+1.98%) and Non-Basic Consumer Products (+1.93%). # **Global Overview:**

#### **United States:**

The U.S. market closes with positive yields as crucial inflation data is expected to give an outlook on the duration and severity of the Fed's tightening policy. The DOW JONES index closed in positive territory as inflation data, to be released tomorrow, is expected to show that inflation retreated, for the second consecutive session, to 8.1% in August. The S&P500 index ended with a positive performance, continuing Friday's sentiment. The gains are a rebound from the sharp sell-off that began in August due to concerns about the impact of rising U.S. interest rates and a possible economic islowdown in Europe and China. Finally, the NASDAQ index closed with positive performance, where the weak dollar and Utrain's military success encouraged investors. Ukraine recovered villages and towns around Kharkiv, the country's second largest city. Thus, DOW JONES +1.40%: S&P 500 +1.83%: NASDAQ -2.14% ended the day with to solive results.


#### **Europe:**

Major European indices ended the session with positive returns, hitting a 2-week high, on hopes that energy prices will soften and banks rose to 4-week highs on expectations of more interest rate hikes in Europe. The pan-European STOXX 600 index ended with gains, investors focused on attempts to pass billion-euro packages to prevent utilities from going under due to a lack of liquidity and to protect households from rising energy bills. The UK market, reflected in the FTSE 100, rose this session with banking and mining stocks rising. With an optimistic scenario after the news that Ukrainian forces advanced in the territory seized from Russian troops, their worst defeat since the first weeks of the war. Meanwhile, the DAX index closed in positive territory as a rally in automaker stocks helped the market gain 0.9% after falling more than 2% on Monday on growing concerns that the economy is headed for a recession. The French market rose this session. The market quickly absorbed the 75 bp interest rate hike announced last Thursday. Thus, FTSE 100+1.66%; CAC 40+1.95%; DAX+2.40%; STOXX 600+1.76% finished at positive levels.

#### Asia:

The main Asian indices closed with positive performances. The Chinese market closed in positive territory, in a context where Asian currencies suffered a significant drop, while investors were encouraged in the region with the hope of a cooling of inflation in the U.S. The Hang Seen jindex followed the upward trend led by Country Garden Holdings +1(16.82%) and Country Garden Services Hoold +10.05%), in contrast, the worst performer wax Sinyi Solar Holdings -(10.39%). The South Korean market ended with positive returns, with SM BEXEL CO leading the rise with 76.47%, followed by HLB Global Co with 29.96%. On the corporate side, chip giant Samsung warns the semiconductor chip industry about a slowdown in demand in recent weeks. The Japanese market closed higher this session at a more than two-week high. Travel-related stocks led the gains, ANA Holdings +(2.45%), Japan Airlines +(1.95%) and Keisel Electric Railway +(3.55%). With respect to heavyweights, apparel owner Uniqlo Fast Retailing was up 2.29% and technology investor SoftBank Group jumped 2.49%. The Australian market ended higher driven by mining and banking stock up 2.21% and 1.1%, respectively. Heavyweights BHP Group, Rio Tinto and Fortexcure Metals increased their gains by between 1.8% and 3.5%. Investors are also awaiting a critical reading on U.S. Inflation, which will be released on Tuesday. Thus, NIKKEI +1.16%; HANG SENG +2.69%; CSI 300 +1.39%; S&P/ASX 200 +1.02%; KOSPI +0.33%, SHANGAI COMPOSITE +0.82% ended with positive neformances.


