## LATAM

Lima, June 23, 2023

**Peru:** The LSE General index ended today's session with a negative result of -0.85%. The index maintains a positive annual cumulative trend of +4.23% in local currency and a positive cumulative trend of +9.14% in dollar-adjusted currency. Regarding the S&P/BVL Peru SEL, it varied -0.93% while the S&P/BVL LIMA 25 varied -0.41%. The spot PEN reached \$/3.6351. Headline: Sunat implements program to reduce tax litigation between private parties and the administration.

**Chile:** The IPSA index ended the day with a negative return of -1.45%. The sectors that lost the most during the day were Energy (-3.25%) and Materials (-1.97%). The worst performing stocks were Engie Energía Chile SA at -3.40%, Empresas COPEC SA at -3.25% and Empresas CMPC SA at -2.55%. Headline: How the CPC went from proposing the tax hike as "the smallest sea" to definitively closing the door on the issue.

**Colombia:** The COLCAP index ended the session with a negative return of -0.71%. The worst performing sectors of the day were Utilities (-1.69%) and Financials (-0.56%). The worst performing stocks were Grupo de Inversiones Suramericana (-6.49%), Empresa de Energía de Bogotá (-2.81%) and Banco de Bogotá (-2.50%). Headline: French President interested in financing Colombian agrarian reform.

**Mexico:** The IPC index closed the day in negative territory at -0.41%. The worst performing sectors of the day were Real Estate (-2.36%) and Non-Basic Consumer Products (-1.58%). The worst performing stocks were Controladora Alsea SAB de CV with -2.36%, Corp Inmobiliaria Vesta SAB at -2.36% and Grupo Aeroportuario del Pacífico with -2.14%. Headline: Does Banxico see the end of high inflation? Updates forecasts downward.

**Brazil:** The IBOVESPA index closed the day in positive territory with +0.04%. The top gainers of the day were Real Estate (+3.66%) and Utilities (+3.31%). The best performing stocks were IRB-Brasil Resseguros SA with +7.29%, Sendas Distribuidora S/A with +7.04% and SLC Agrícola SA with +6.51%. Headline: Tax reform coordinator defends differentiated treatment only for part of the services.



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
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
### MILA: Intraday Evolution




### MILA: Sovereign Yield Curves




### MILA: Foreign Exchange Indices (3 months)

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## WORLD

### United States:

The US market ended with negative returns, in a context where the focus will be on the results of bank stress tests and data on personal income and spending, as well as the PCE price indexes. The DOW JONES index closed negatively, as it was affected by growing concerns about the effects of tight monetary policy on economies. In addition, Fed Chairman Powell reiterated that interest rates will continue to rise this year, stating that two more rate hikes would be "a pretty good assumption." The S&P 500 index also topped out with a negative performance, as new US PMI indices showed that the services sector remained solid last month, but manufacturing suffered the largest year-to-date pullback and new orders growth slowed, while the pace of job creation slowed to the slowest since January. Traders also currently assign a near 74% probability that the Fed will raise rates by 25 basis points next month. Finally, the NASDAQ index closed lower as technology and consumer discretionary stocks were the worst performers, down nearly 1.4% each. Thus, DOW JONES -0.65%, S&P 500 -0.77% and NASDAQ -0.01% ended with negative results.

### Europe:

Major European indices ended the session with negative returns. The pan-European STOXX 600 index closed negative, as the latest PMI survey revealed that business growth in the Eurozone almost stalled in June, due to a slowdown in the growth of services activity and a more pronounced contraction in manufacturing. The UK market, reflected in the FTSE 100, closed lower as the latest PMI survey indicated a sharp slowdown in the growth of UK business activity in June, driven by a moderation in services sector growth, a deeper contraction in manufacturing and persistent inflationary pressures. Similarly, the DAX index closed in negative territory as investor concerns about recession increased following the release of poor economic data. The latest PMI data showed a sharp slowdown in the German private sector economy and a contraction in French business activity, which was the first in five months. The French market closed in negative territory, due to the prevailing pessimism regarding global economic growth prospects, which has been fueled by aggressive monetary tightening measures implemented by major central banks. The banking sector led the losses, with BNP Paribas (-2.1%), Credit Agricole (-1.7%) and Societe Generale (-1%) falling the most. Thus, FTSE 100 -0.54%; CAC 40 -0.55%; DAX -0.99%; STOXX 600 -0.34% ended at negative levels.

### Asia:

The main Asian indices closed with negative returns. The Chinese market ended with neutral performances due to the fact that they are on holidays. In line, the Hang Seng index closed in the red as concerns over rising US interest rates increased. Losses were widespread, with real estate, technology and financial sectors among the biggest laggards. Sino Pharmaceutical plunged 7.5%, followed by China Resources (-5.1%), Hansoh Pharmaceutical (-5%), JD Health Intl. (-3.7%), Xiaomi Corp (-2.8%) and Li Auto (-2.6%). The South Korean market ended with negative results. The Japanese market closed lower. Investors digested data showing Japan's core inflation slowed to 3.2% in May, but remained above the central bank's 2% target for the 14th consecutive month. Notable losses included Mitsubishi Corp (-4.4%), Mitsui & Co (-4.7%) and Fast Retailing (-2.4%). The Australian market ended lower for the third consecutive session, Investors also digested data that showed Australian manufacturing activity contracted for the fourth consecutive month in June, while services activity slowed. Energy stocks led decliners in the face of a sharp drop in oil prices overnight, with sector leaders Woodside Energy and Santos losing 4.7% and 4.6%, respectively. Thus, NIKKEI -1.45%; HANG SENG -1.71%; CSI 300 0.00%; S&P/ASX 200 -1.34%; KOSPI -0.91%, SHANGHAI COMPOSITE 0.00% ended with negative returns.




