## LATAM

Lima, August 10, 2023

**Peru:** The BVL General index ended today's session with a negative result of -0.62%. The index maintains a positive annual cumulative trend of +10.91% in local currency and a positive cumulative trend of +15.22% in dollar-adjusted currency. Regarding the S&P/BVL Peru SEL, it varied by -1.01% while the S&P/BVL LIMA 25 by -0.39%. The spot PEN reached S/.3.6638. Headline: The economy will grow only 1.1%, according to Credicorp Capital.

**Chile:** The IPSA index ended the day with a negative return of -0.82%. The most damaged sectors of the day were Industrials (-2.27%) and Non Basic Consumer Products (-1.27%). The worst performing stocks were Sociedad Química y Minera de Chile (-2.83%) and Compañía Sud Americana de Vapo (-1.95%). Headline: Codelco and Anglo discuss copper mine agreement in Chile.

**Colombia:** The COLCAP index ended the session with a negative return of -1.14%. The sectors that lost the most during the day were Finance (-1.94%) and Energy (-0.67%). The worst performing stocks were BanColombia SA (-3.44%) and Compañía Colombiana de Inversión (-2.90%). Headline: Colombia's electoral authority orders investigation into Petro's campaign manager.

**Mexico:** The IPC index closed the day in negative territory at -0.61%. The sectors that lost the most during the day were Communication Services (-1.96%) and Health Care (-1.54%). The worst performing stocks were Grupo Financiero Inbursa SA (-2.60%) and Grupo Televisa SA (-2.36%). Headline: Fitch sees corporate rating downgrades in Mexico due to high rates.

**Brazil:** The IBOVESPA index closed the day in negative territory of -0.05%. The sectors that lost the most during the day were Real Estate (-0.78%) and Non-Basic Consumer Products (-0.77%). The worst performing stocks were GRUPO DE MODA SOMA SA (-7.68%) and 3R PETROLEUM OLEO E GAS SA (-4.96%). Headline: Brazil retail sales stall on latest sign of uneven demand.




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
### MILA: Intraday Evolution




### MILA: Sovereign Yield Curves




### MILA: Foreign Exchange Indices (3 months)

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## WORLD

### United States:

The US market closed with positive returns. The DOW JONES index closed higher, in a context where investors continue to evaluate the Federal Reserve's monetary policy outlook after the appearance of new signs of disinflation in the US economy. The S&P 500 index also ended with gains. With overall CPI coming in slightly below expectations in July, the core index posted its smallest consecutive increase in two years. The data coincided with market bets that the Federal Reserve will refrain from raising rates in September. Finally, the NASDAQ index ended with positive returns. Where Disney shares gained 4.8% despite the company posting mixed results and announcing an upcoming price hike for ad-free Disney+ subscriptions. Thus, DOW JONES +0.15%, S&P 500 +0.03% and NASDAQ +0.12% ended the day with positive results.

### Europe:

The main European indices ended the session with positive returns, despite evidence of an economic slowdown within the largest economies of the currency bloc, limiting the chances that the European Central Bank will extend its tightening cycle at its next meeting of September. The pan-European STOXX 600 index closed higher as financial markets hoped the ECB could raise rates further this year and keep them higher for longer after data showed core inflation in the euro area had not slowed down in July as expected. The English market, reflected in the FTSE 100, closed with positive results, since several blue-chip stocks separated from dividends. Additionally, Persimmon added 2.2% after confirming its earnings guidance, while Burberry jumped 2.8% to follow other European luxury giants after China lifted key travel restrictions. Similarly, reflected in the DAX index, the German market closed in positive territory, with cyclical consumer goods, financials and real estate being the best performing sectors. Likewise, luxury and travel stocks, namely Hermes (1.6%), LVMH (2.2%), Air France-KLM (1.3%) also rose after China announced that it lifted its travel restrictions. The era of the pandemic in group travel for more countries. The French market closed higher as investors welcomed new data showing US inflation data. Thus, FTSE 100 +0.41%; ACC 40 +1.52%; DAX +0.91%; STOXX 600 +0.79% ended at positive levels.

### Asia:

Major Asian indices closed with mostly positive returns. The Chinese market ended with positive returns. Investors also continued to assess the economic outlook in China, after recent data stoked fears of deflation. Financial stocks led advances, with strong gains by The Pacific Securities (10%), Tianfeng Securities (4.5%), Hongta Securities (10%), Everbright Securities (4%) and Cinda Securities (7.8%). In line, the Hang Seng index closed higher, following modest gains in the previous session. Beijing is reportedly very disappointed with the decision and has called on Washington to respect market principles and fair play rather than hinder the global economic recovery. The South Korean market ended negative. The Japanese market closed higher. Investors digested data showing that Japanese producer prices rose the least in more than two years and slowed for the seventh consecutive month in July. Notable gains were seen in index heavyweights SoftBank Group (0.4%), Mitsubishi UFJ (2.4%), Fast Retailing (1.8%), Daikin Industries (1.4%) and Toyota Motor (1.4%). Gains were led by the energy sector, led by Woodside Energy (1.9%), Santos (2.6%), Beach Energy (3.6%), Ampol (1.2%) and Kiron Energy (2.2%). Other index heavyweights such as CSL Ltd (0.8%), Telstra Group (0.7%) and Pilbara Minerals (1.5%) also advanced. 


### Market Intraday Evolution (var %)




### Principal Metals Index (3 months)





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


