Peru: The LSE General index ended today's session with a positive result of +0.23%. The index maintains a positive annual cumulative trend of +10.88% in local currency and a positive cumulative trend of +14.51% in dollar-adjusted currency. With respect to the S&P/BVL Peru SEL, it varied by +1.13% while the S&P/BVL LIMA 25 by +0.54%. The spot PEN reached S/.3.6858. Headline: Government plans two gas pipelines to make petrochemicals viable in the south.

Chile: The IPSA index ended the day with a positive return of +0.15%. The most benefited sectors of the day were Materials (+1.73%) and Non-Basic Consumer Products (+0.96%). The best performing stocks were Banco de Crédito e Inversiones by +2.86%, Empresas CMPC SA by +2.14% and Viña Concha y Toro SA by +1.98%. Headline: Christian Blanche, president of the Tax Commission of the CPC: "The tax system we had was not bad, it is known and simpler".

Colombia: The COLCAP index ended the session with a negative return of -0.31%. The most negatively affected sectors of the day were Energy (-1.50%) and Consumer Staples (-1.21%). The worst performing stocks were Ecopetrol SA at -1.50%, Canacol Energy Ltd at -1.46% and Grupo Nutresa SA at -1.21%. Headline: Producer prices in July fell 0.74% in their monthly variation.

Mexico: The IPC index closed the day in positive territory +1.13%. The day's top gainers were Financials (+2.34%) and Non-Basic Consumer Products (+1.27%). The best performing stocks were Controladora AXTEL SAB DE CV with +3.83%, Qualitas Controladora SAB de CV with +3.79% and Megacable Holdings SAB de CV with +3.66%. Headline: Gross Fixed Investment "rebounds" 4.5% in May, its best figure in almost 3 years.

Brazil: The IBOVESPVA index closed the day in negative territory at -0.89%. The sectors that lost the most during the day were Energy (-2.43%) and Financials (-2.23%). The worst performing stocks were Atacadao SA with -6.76%, Banco Bradesco SA with -6.65% and Embraer SA with -4.99%. Headline: Google wins partial victory in U.S. court battle.



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WORLD



United States:

The US market ended with negative returns. The DOW JONES index closed with negative returns, amid falling bond yields, as a mixed jobs report did little to alter bets on the Federal Reserve's policy outlook. The S&P 500 index also ended with a negative performance as the U.S. economy added 187,000 jobs in June, below market expectations of a 200,000 increase, but the unemployment rate unexpectedly fell to 3.5% and hourly earnings beat estimates with annual growth of 4.4%. On the other hand, Treasury bond yields were down following the jobs data. The return on 10-year notes gave up 6.8 basis points to 4.1%, while the return on 30-year notes was down 2.9 basis points to 4.2%. Finally, the NASDAQ index closed lower, driven by earnings, Amazon (9.5%), Booking (8.3%) and Dropbox (6.1%) rose thanks to upbeat quarterly results. Thus, DOW JONES -0.43%, S&P 500 -0.53% and NASDAQ -0.36% ended negative.



Europe:

The main European indices ended the session with positive returns. The pan-European STOXX 600 index closed higher, despite the HCOB eurozone construction PMI falling to 43.5 in July from 44.2 in the previous month, marking a reduction in construction activity. Also, commercial work contracted to a 7-month low, while civil engineering projects declined at a solid pace, little changed from June. The English market, reflected in the FTSE 100, closed higher, despite the fact that the BOE raised its bank rate by 25 bp, although two members of the MPC opted for a sharp increase of 50 bp and another preferred to maintain it, which suggests that the combination of high inflation with low mortgage demand and the risk of economic contraction is generating divided opinions. Similarly, the DAX index closed in positive territory, after traders interpreted the corporate earnings and payroll report as signs that the US job market is cooling off. The French market closed higher, following the release of the US jobs report. Although wage growth exceeded market expectations and the unemployment rate declined, the rise in non-farm payrolls fell short of forecast levels. Market participants also closely follow corporate earnings reports. Among individual stocks, Credit Agricole (+6.6%) advanced the most due to strong performance in insurance and consumer finance, resulting in upbeat quarterly earnings. Thus, FTSE 100 +0.47%; ACC 40 +0.75%; DAX +0.37%; STOXX 600 +0.29% ended at positive levels.



Asia:

Major Asian indices closed with positive returns. The Chinese market ended with positive returns, with the recent US credit downgrade and rising Treasury yields pressuring equities. Meanwhile, growing optimism that Chinese authorities may offer more pro-growth policy measures to support the economy pushed stocks higher in Hong Kong and mainland China. In line, the Hang Seng index closed in the green, snapping a three-day losing streak, after China's central bank pledged on Thursday to allocate more financial resources to support the private economy, while promising to flexibly use various policy tools to ensure ample liquidity in the system. The South Korean market ended with negative results. The Japanese market closed higher. Notable gains were seen in index heavyweights such as Nippon Yusen (3.1%), Toyota Motor (1.3%), Mitsubishi UFJ (1.8%), SoftBank Group (0.7%) and Nippon Steel (1%). The Australian market ended higher, investors continued to assess the economic and monetary policy outlook after the Reserve Bank of Australia unexpectedly held interest rates steady during Tuesday's policy meeting. Thus, NIKKEI ++0.10%; HANG SENG +0.61%; CSI 300 +0.39%; S&P/ASX 200 +0.19%; KOSPI -0.10%, SHANGHAI COMPOSITE +0.23% ended with positive returns.




