Peru: The LSE General index ended today's session with a positive result of +0.19%. The index maintains a positive annual cumulative trend of +7.53% in local currency and a positive cumulative trend of +10.88% in dollar-adjusted currency. Regarding the S&P/BVL Peru SEL, it varied -0.11% while the S&P/BVL LIMA 25 varied +0.19%. The spot PEN reached S/.3.6913. Headline: BCR: Net International Reserves rose to US\$ 73.026m.

Chile: The IPSA index ended the day with a positive return of +0.32%. The sectors that lost the most during the day were Communication Services (-1.90%) and Industrials (-1.68%). The worst performing stocks were Sociedad Química y Minera de CV by -2.54%, Sociedad de Inversiones Oro Blanco by -2.20% and SMU SA by -1.96%. Headline: Marcel draws new road map with parties to advance in fiscal pact and ratifies taxes for 2024.

Colombia: The COLCAP index ended the session with a positive return of +0.05%. The sectors that benefited the most during the day were Utilities (+1.66%) and Materials (+1.55%). The best performing stocks were Inversiones Argos SA by +3.33%, Empresa de Energía de Bogotá SA by +2.21% and Compañía Colombiana de Inversiones by +2.00%. Headline: Decalogue of proposals on health system financing.

Mexico: The IPC index closed the day in positive territory at +0.15%. The sectors that benefited the most during the day were Industrials (+1.21%) and Real Estate (+0.70%). The best performing stocks were Grupo Carso SAB de CV with +3.02%, Arca Continental SAB de CV with +1.91% and Grupo Aeroportuario del Sureste with +1.49%. Headline: Gives less "wool": Government contribution to Mexico's GDP generation falls in 2023.

Brazil: The IBOVESPA index closed the day in positive territory with -1.02%. The worst performing sectors of the day were Non-Basic Consumer Products (-2.55%) and Information Technology (-1.93%). The worst performing stocks were Cia Brasileira de Distribuição with -7.23%, Cia CVC Brasil Operadora e Agencia with -6.58% and MRV Engenharia e Participações with -5.58%. Headline: Brazil expects to allow, within a month, exports in Chinese currency to Argentina.




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
MILA: Intraday Evolution




MILA: Sovereign Yield Curves




MILA: Foreign Exchange Indices (3 months)

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WORLD

United States:

The U.S. market ended with positive returns. The DOW JONES index closed with positive results, as they weighed Fed Chairman Powell's comments at the Jackson Hole Summit, where he addressed the more resilient than expected string of economic data throughout the summer, while stating that the Fed is prepared to raise rates further to bring inflation back to its 2% target. The S&P 500 index also culminated with a positive performance, where Marvell Tech beat on earnings, but gave a cautious forward-looking outlook, likewise, Nordstrom beat earnings and revenue expectations, but experienced an 8.3% sales decline from last year. Finally, Ulta Beauty beat expectations, raising its earnings outlook. Finally, the NASDAQ index closed higher, boosted by Netflix as they rose 0.7% after Loop Capital raised its rating on the streaming giant to buy from hold. On the other hand, most traders continue to expect that the Fed will not raise them in September. Thus, DOW JONES +0.73%, S&P 500 +0.67% and NASDAQ +0.94% finished positive.

Europe:

The main European indices ended the session with mixed performances. The pan-European STOXX 600 index closed with losses. Where weak economic data from Europe has intensified expectations that the ECB could eminently pause its rate hikes. The UK market, reflected in the FTSE 100, closed higher, where new data from GfK showed that UK consumer confidence improved more than expected in August, with the financial situation indicator moving closer to positive territory and pointing to some optimism for consumers. Similarly, the DAX index closed in positive territory, against a backdrop where German business morale continued to deteriorate in August for the fourth consecutive month, reaching the lowest level since last October. The French market closed higher, where investors are awaiting upcoming statements from ECB President Christine Lagarde on the ECB's future interest rate path, especially in light of Europe's weak economic performance. Thus, FTSE 100 +0.07%; CAC 40 +0.21%; DAX +0.07%; STOXX 600 -0.04% ended at mixed levels.

Asia:

Major Asian indices closed with mixed performances. The Chinese market ended with negative returns, hitting its lowest levels in at least eight months and following losses on Wall Street overnight, as investors turned cautious ahead of Federal Reserve Chairman Jerome Powell's speech in Jackson Hole. In line, the Hang Seng index ended in the red as Hong Kong's exports and imports continued their downward trend in July amid weak domestic and external demand. The technology sector sank more than 2 per cent after the Nasdaq plunged on Thursday, as Nvidia's rally was short-lived, while other sectors also fell. The South Korean market ended negative. The Japanese market closed lower. Investors digested data showing that Tokyo's core inflation rate slowed to 2.8% in August from 3% in July. Technology stocks led the sell-off, with Advantest (-10%), Laoerte (-6.9%), Disco Corp (-6%) and Socionext (-5.3%) losing heavily. The Australian market ended with losses, erasing the gains of the last three sessions, with almost all sectors participating in the decline. Technology stocks lead the decliners, followed by other index heavyweights. Thus, NIKKEI -2.05%; HANG SENG -0.51%; CSI 300 +0.20%; S&P/ASX 200 -0.93%; KOSPI -0.73%, SHANGHAI COMPOSITE -0.59% ended with mostly negative performances.


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
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Market Intraday Evolution (var %)


