**Peru:** The LSE General index ended today's session with a negative result of -1.64%. The index maintains a positive cumulative annual trend of +3.88% in local currency and a positive cumulative trend of +4.14% in dollar-adjusted currency. The S&P/BVL Peru SEL varied by -1.56% while the S&P/BVL LIMA 25 varied by -1.11%. The PEN spot reached \$/3.7699. Headline: SMV authorizes the operation of Bloom Crowdfunding, the fourth platform in Peru.

**Chile:** The IPSA index ended the day with a negative return of -1.33%. The least benefited sectors of the day were Industrials (-2.74%) and Communication Services (-2.22%). The worst performing stocks were Sociedad Química y Minera de Chile (-3.66%) and Sociedad de Inversiones Oro (-3.39%). Headline: August economic activity takes the market by surprise and fuels recession risks.

**Colombia:** The COLCAP index ended the session with a negative return of -0.79%. The most negatively affected sectors of the day were Utilities (-2.35%) and Energy (-1.85%). The worst performing stocks were Grupo de Inversiones Suramericana (-5.78%) and Corporación Financiera Colombia (-4.58%). Headline: There will be a pause in gasoline price hikes in October.

**Mexico:** The IPC index closed the day in positive territory, +0.76%. The sectors that benefited the most during the day were Financials (+1.62%) and Consumer Staples (+0.79%). The best performing stocks were Fomento Económico Mexicano SAB (+2.74%) and Grupo Financiero Banorte SAB (+2.53%). Headline: Minimum wage 2024: How much will the increase be for next year? This we know.

**Brazil:** The IBOVESPA index closed the day in negative territory at -1.29%. The worst performing sectors of the day were Non-Basic Consumer Products (-2.46%) and Energy (-2.04%). The worst performing stocks were Vamos Locacao de Caminhões (-8.41%) and MRV Engenharia e Participações (-6.56%). Headline: Brazil's trade balance recorded a record surplus of US\$ 71.3 billion in the first nine months of the year.

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

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
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
### MILA: Intraday Evolution




### MILA: Sovereign Yield Curves




### MILA: Foreign Exchange Indices (3 months)

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
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
### Market Intraday Evolution (var %)




### Principal Metals Index (3 months)




