## LATAM

Lima, October 16, 2023

**Peru:** The LSE General Index ended today's session with a positive result of +0.74%. The index maintains a positive annual cumulative trend of +4.61% in local currency and a positive cumulative trend of +3.13% in dollar-adjusted currency. Regarding the S&P/BVL Peru SEL, it varied +0.78% while the S&P/BVL LIMA 25 varied +0.26%. The PEN spot reached S/.3.8432. Headline: Proinversion seeks to reactivate Chinecas and Chancay-Lambayeque valley projects.

**Chile:** The IPSA index ended the day with a positive return of +1.31%. The most benefited sectors of the day were Energy (+3.22%) and Materials (+2.77%). The best performing stocks were Compañía Sud Americana de Vapo (+6.59%) and Banco de Chile (+3.59%). Headline: The business world in view of the exit plebiscite: support for the new constitution grows and it is feasible to reverse the "no" vote.

**Colombia:** The COLCAP index ended the session with a positive return of +0.38%. The sectors that benefited the most during the day were Utilities (+1.30%) and Energy (+1.69%). The best performing stocks were Compañía Colombiana de Inversión (+2.56%) and Grupo de Inversiones Suramericana (+2.40%). Headline: Informal employment dropped 1.9 points between June and August 2023.

**Mexico:** The IPC index closed the day in positive territory at +0.90%. The sectors that benefited the most during the day were Materials (+2.14%) and Non-Basic Consumer Goods (+1.66%). The best performing stocks were Mexichem SAB de CV (+4.12%) and Cemex SAB de CV (+3.86%). Headline: Financial cost of debt will absorb revenue.

**Brazil:** The IBOVESPA index closed the day in negative territory at +0.67%. The sectors that lost the most during the day were Communication Services (+1.24%) and Health Care (+1.11%). The best performing stocks were Cia Brasileira de Distribuição (+8.67%) and Gol Linhas Aéreas Inteligentes (+6.55%). Headline: BNDES has already contracted 8.2 billion reais in bonds this year.





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
### MILA: Intraday Evolution




### MILA: Sovereign Yield Curves




### MILA: Foreign Exchange Indices (3 months)

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## WORLD

### United States:

The US market closed with positive performances. The DOW JONES finished in the green, J&J, Bank of America, Goldman Sachs, Tesla, Morgan Stanley and Netflix are among the companies that will report results this week. Investors also await comments from several Federal Reserve officials, including Chairman Powell, for more details on monetary policy and economic data, including retail sales and industrial production, for clues on the state of the U.S. economy. The S&P 500 index also ended with positive returns; among sectors, consumer discretionary, utilities and energy were the best performers. On the earnings front, Charles Schwab shares rose 4.5% after the company's earnings beat forecasts, while revenue missed expectations. Finally, the NASDAQ index ended the day higher. Top performers included Tempesta Therapeutics Inc (+85.16%), MMTC Inc (+64.43%), Secoo Holding Ltd ADR (+59.47%) and PCTEL (+47.21). Thus, DOW JONES +0.93%, S&P 500 +1.06%, NASDAQ +1.20% with the market having positive returns.

### Europe:

The main European indices ended the session with positive performances. The pan-European STOXX 600 index closed higher, in a context where a trade surplus of €6.7 billion was recorded in August 2023, compared to a deficit of €54.4 billion in the same month of the previous year. In addition, imports fell by 24.6% to €214.9 billion, while exports fell by 3.9% to €221.6 billion. The UK market, reflected in the FTSE 100 closed with a positive performance, benefiting from the positive session on Wall Street, as investors continued to digest the risk of further escalation in the Middle East and how it could affect European inflation. In addition, markets also digested a further rise in bond yields, reflecting the hope that geopolitical turmoil will have minimal impact on the economy and allow central banks to maintain their aggressive stance over the medium term. Similarly, the German market, reflected in the DAX index closed in positive territory, as investors have welcomed data showing that wholesale prices fell by 4.1% year-on-year in September, marking the sixth consecutive month of decline and the most significant drop since May 2020. The French market closed positive, where Atos gained 0.4%, following the resignation of its former CEO and after indicating that it plans to split the IT consulting group into two listed entities to sell the larger division to Czech tycoon Daniel Kretinsky. Thus, FTSE 100 +0.41%; CAC 40 +0.27%; DAX +0.34%; STOXX 600 +0.23% finished with positive levels.

### Asia:

The main Asian indexes closed with negative performances. The Chinese market ended lower, amid concerns that the conflict in the Middle East could widen, despite some stabilizing signs in the economic recovery and the authorities' latest measures to shore up investor confidence. On the other hand, the Hang Seng index closed negative, after Semiconductor stocks lost 2.2% following the news, while new energy fell 1.8% and property developers dropped 1.9%. Automotive stocks added 1%. The South Korean market ended negative amid weakened risk sentiment due to the uncertainty of a military conflict in the Middle East. The Japanese market closed in negative territory, dragged down by chip-related stocks, and risk appetite was affected by escalating tensions in the Middle East. The Australian market ended with losses, weighed down by banking and technology stocks, as investors awaited the minutes of the central bank's latest monetary policy meeting to assess the outlook for interest rates. Thus, NIKKEI -2.03%; HANG SENG -0.97%; CSI 300 -1.00%; S&P/ASX 200 -0.35%; KOSPI -0.81%, SHANGHAI COMPOSITE -0.46% ended with negative returns.

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

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
### Market Intraday Evolution (var %)




### Principal Metals Index (3 months)


