

LATAM

Peru: The LSE General Index ended today's session with a positive result of +0.73%. The index maintains a positive accumulated annual trend of +2.05% in local currency and a positive accumulated trend of +0.36% in dollar-adjusted currency. Regarding the S&P/BVL Peru SEL, it varied +0.88% while the S&P/BVL LIMA 25 varied +0.69%. The spot PEN reached S/.3.7678. Headline: There are close to 2,300 public works paralyzed for more than S/. 26,000 million, which ones are they?

Chile: The IPSA index ended the day with a positive return of +0.74%. The most benefited sectors of the day were Real Estate (+2.58%) and Non-Basic Consumer Products (+1.79%). The best performing stocks were CAP SA (+3.50%) and Cencosud Shopping SA (3.27%). Headline: Undersecretaries Committee: zoom to the new instance that is proposed for the streamlining of awards.

Colombia: The COLCAP index ended the session with a negative return of -0.63%. The most negatively affected sectors of the day were Finance (-1.22%) and Utilities (-1.19%). The worst performing stocks were Grupo de Inversiones Suramerica (-5.80%) and Grupo Aval Acciones y Valores (-2.59%). Headline: Analysts 'rebalance' their bets on GDP, which would grow 1.3% in 2024.

Mexico: The IPC index closed the day in positive territory of +1.43%. The sectors that benefited the most during the day were Materials (+2.15%) and Health Care (+1.70%). The best performing stocks were Grupo Financiero Inbursa SA (+4.01%) and Grupo Aeroportuario del Pacífico (+3.05%). Headline: Agustín Carstens 'warns': Lowering rates prematurely could 'revive' inflation.

Brazil: The IBOVESPA index closed the day in positive territory at +1.31%. The top gainers of the day were Health Care (+2.38%) and Real Estate (+2.20%). The best performing stocks were IRB-Brasil Resseguros SA (+10.60%) and BRF - Brasil Foods SA (+7.11%). Headline: Optimism in the Chinese economy should boost investments in

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WORLD

United States:

The U.S. market closed with mixed performances. The DOW JONES ended in the red, putting an end to its three-day positive closing streak, with notable declines in Boeing at -1.6%, Home Depot at 1.66%, and 3M at -11.03%. The S&P 500 finished with positive returns, reaching a record closing where investors remained cautious while awaiting quarterly results from Netflix and Tesla. Finally, the NASDAQ index ended the day positively, in a session where investors sought artificial intelligence companies expecting high financial gains. Among the session's winners is United Airlines, which experienced a 5.3% increase following optimistic results, although the company anticipates losses for Q1 2024 due to the grounding of 737 Max flights. Verizon rose by 6.7%, reaching a 52-week high of \$42.23, after its earnings surpassed forecasts, and P&G gained 4.1% after both earnings and revenue exceeded estimates. Additionally, Alibaba surged by 7.8% after recent regulatory filings revealed that co-founders Jack Ma and Joe Tsai purchased over \$200 million worth of the company's shares. Thus, DOW JONES -0.25%, S&P 500 +0.29%, NASDAQ +0.43%, with the market showing mixed returns.

Europe:

The main European indices closed with entirely negative performances. The pan-European STOXX 600 ended lower as investors refrained from making significant bets ahead of this week's European Central Bank monetary policy meeting. However, gains in the mining sector helped mitigate the losses. In the UK market, the FTSE index closed the session with a slight decline of 0.03%, with no notable corporate news. Similarly, the German market closed with losses, and in a day without major macroeconomic data, markets are awaiting the upcoming ECB meeting. In the French market, losses continued for the second consecutive time. This decrease surprised some experts as investors did not react positively to the Chinese government's plan to prevent a potential stock market collapse in the country. Given that several CAC-40 companies depend on the purchasing power of Chinese consumers, this situation raised concerns. Among the 40 CAC-40 values, 28 ended in losses and 12 in gains. Thus, FTSE 100 -0.03%; CAC 40 -0.34%; DAX -0.34%; STOXX 600 -0.28% closed with negative performances.

Asia:

The main Asian indices closed with mostly positive performances. The Chinese market closed higher, after the Chinese Cabinet renewed its pledge to stabilize capital markets by intensifying fund injections, which lifted investors' spirits. On the other hand, the Hang Seng index closed with gains, due to a Bloomberg News report that Chinese authorities intend to raise about 2 trillion yuan to help mainland China's ailing equity markets by buying onshore shares through Hong Kong markets. The South Korean market ended with positive results after the Composite Consumer Sentiment Index (CCSI) was released rising to 101.6 points in January 2024, due to moderating inflation, recovering exports and hopes that rate hikes will be put on hold. The Australian market ended with gains, in a context where investors on Tuesday assessed Australia's business confidence data, while awaiting with interest the manufacturing and services activity figures at the end of the week. Thus, NIKKEI -0.08%; HANG SENG +2.63%; CSI 300 +0.40%; S&P/ASX 200 +0.51%; KOSPI +0.58%, SHANGHAI COMPOSITE +0.53% ended with mostly positive performances.




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Market Intraday Evolution (var %)





Principal Metals Index (3 months)





Foreign Exchange Indices (3 months)








