LATAM

Brasil: El índice IBOVESPA cerró el día en terreno negativo de -0.92%. Los sectores más perjudicados de la jornada fueron Tecnología (-2.86%) y Salud (-2.52%). Las acciones con peor desempeño fueron MAGAZINE LUIZA SA (-6.98%) y HAPVIDA PARTICIPACOES E INVE (-6.98%).

Peru: The General Index of the Lima Stock Exchange (BVL) ended today's session with a positive result of +0.76%. The index maintains a year-to-date positive trend of +0.76% in local currency and an accumulated positive trend of +0.76% in dollar-adjusted currency. Regarding the S&P/BVL Peru SEL, it varied by +0.39%, while the S&P/BVL LIMA 25 was -0.19%. The spot PEN reached \$/3.7290.

Headline: Chavimochic III G2G will not complete all of its works.

Chile: The IPSA index concluded the day with a negative return of -0.58%. The least benefited sectors of the day were Basic Consumer Goods (-3.17%) and Non-Basic Consumer Products (-3.00%). The stocks with the best performance were CIA SUD AMERICANA DE VAPORES (-5.24%) and LATAM AIRLINES GROUP SA (-3.94%).

Headline: Global Competitiveness Report: Chile stands out above average in key indices.

Colombia: The COLCAP index ended the session with a negative return of -0.60%. The least benefited sectors of the day were Public Services (-1.76%) and Materials (-0.77%). The stocks with the worst performance were CANACOL ENERGY LTD (-7.21%) and Company GRUPO NUTRESA SA (-2.18%).

Mexico: The IPC index closed the day in negative territory at -0.01%. The least benefited sectors of the day were Health (-0.09%) and Industrial (-0.67%). The stocks with the lowest performance were GRUPO CARSO SAB DE CV-SER A1 (-5.55%) and GENOMMA LAB INTERNACIONAL-B (-0.09%).



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
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
MILA: Intraday Evolution

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WORLD

United States:

The US market closed with positive returns. The DOW JONES index closed in the green, supported by gains in technology heavyweights, as markets continued to assess the latest economic data and the Fed's speech for information on the central bank's policy path. The S&P 500 index also ended with positive gains, amid hawkish signals from the Federal Reserve that lifted Treasury yields and reduced expectations for a March rate cut, and the Atlanta Fed's Bostic said he does not anticipate lower rates until the third quarter. Finally, the NASDAQ index ended with positive returns. On the corporate front, Apple shares rose more than 3.26% after Bank of America upgraded them to a buy rating, projecting upside of more than 20% over the next 12 months. In addition, U.S.-listed shares of TSMC soared 10.08% following the chip producer's release of strong corporate results. Thus, DOW JONES +0.54%, S&P 500 +0.88% and NASDAQ +1.35% ended the day with positive results.

Europe:

The main European indices ended the session with positive returns. The pan-European STOXX 600 index closed higher, in a context where the minutes of the last ECB meeting indicate that the Governing Council members were confident that inflation in the Eurozone economy is moderating towards its target. The UK market, reflected in the FTSE 100, closed with positive results. On the corporate front, while the index rose, Watches of Switzerland experienced a significant decline of more than 25%, as the luxury watch retailer adjusted its annual revenue forecast due to economic difficulties affecting consumer spending. Conversely, Flutter, a leading online gambling company, rose nearly 10% following a notable 15% increase in fourth-quarter revenue. Similarly, reflected in the DAX index, the German market closed in positive territory after three consecutive sessions of losses as the minutes of the European Central Bank's December meeting revealed officials' confidence that inflation would return to target. The French market, reflected in the Cac 40, closed with gains. On the corporate front, luxury giants LVMH (+2.67%), Kering (+2.28%) and Hermès (+1.92%) contributed to the index's rally, boosted by positive results from Swiss rival Richemont. Thus, FTSE 100 +0.17%; CAC 40 +1.13%; DAX +0.83%; STOXX 600 +0.59% ended at positive levels.

Asia:

The main Asian indices closed with mixed performances. The Chinese market ended with positive returns. Most stock markets in Asia remained stable on Thursday due to positive data in the United States, which reduced expectations of interest rate cuts by the Federal Reserve. At the same time, Chinese stocks experienced additional losses after discouraging reports on Gross Domestic Product (GDP). The South Korean market closed today with slight gains as investors sought investment opportunities, causing a slight increase of 0.17% in the stock market. The Kospi index concluded the session at 2,440.04, with significant contributions from prominent companies such as Samsung Electronics and SK hynix, which experienced increases of 0.99% and 3.97%, respectively. The Australian market ended lower. This comes after the recent report of the Consumer Price Index (CPI) for November, which revealed an annual inflation rate of 4.3%, surprisingly below the forecast of 4.5%. This dynamic could have a significant impact on future decisions regarding interest rates by the Reserve Bank of Australia. Thus, NIKKEI -0.03%; HANG SENG +0.75%; CSI 300 +1.41%; S&P/ASX 200 -0.63%; KOSPI +0.17%, SHANGHAI COMPOSITE +0.43% ended with mixed returns.



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
Market Intraday Evolution (var %)




Principal Metals Index (3 months)




Foreign Exchange Indices (3 months)




