## LATAM

Lima, January 29, 2024

**Peru:** The LSE General index ended today's session with a positive result of +1.13%. The index maintains a positive annual cumulative trend of +4.57% in local currency and a positive cumulative trend of +1.68% in dollar-adjusted currency. With respect to the S&P/BVL Peru SEL, it varied +1.03% while the S&P/BVL LIMA 25 varied +0.70%. The spot PEN reached \$/.3.8103. Headline: S/. 1.15 billion of CTS outflows in only one month and there is a risk of a new withdrawal.

**Chile:** The IPSA index ended the day with a positive return of +0.10%. The most benefited sectors of the day were Finance (+1.29%) and Utilities (+0.66%). The best performing stocks were Plaza SA (+2.63%) and Banco de Chile (+1.76%). Headline: Andres Perez, Itaú: "A drop in rates of more than 100 points would result in more volatility in the dollar".

**Colombia:** The COLCAP index ended the session with a negative return of -0.20%. The least benefited sectors of the day were Consumer Staples (-3.41%) and Utilities (-0.90%). The worst performing stocks were Bolsa de Valores de Colombia (-4.42%) and Grupo Nutresa SA (-3.41%). Headline: This is how the minimum wage for 2024 was drawn up in Colombia.

**Mexico:** The IPC index closed the day in positive territory at +0.56%. The sectors that benefited the most during the day were Non-Basic Consumer Products (+1.75%) and Materials (+1.61%). The best performing stocks were Industrias Peñoles SAB de CV (+7.21%) and Grupo Comercial Chedraui SA (+3.57%). Headline: Mexico's exports register 'surge' in 2023.

**Brazil:** The IBOVESPA index closed the day in negative territory at -0.36%. The most affected sectors of the day were Non-Basic Consumer Products (-1.21%) and Materials (-0.94%). The worst performing stocks were Gol Linhas Aéreas Inteligentes (-33.61%) and Grupo Casas Bahia SA (-4.71%). Headline: Santander and Rio's management





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
### MILA: Intraday Evolution




### MILA: Sovereign Yield Curves




### MILA: Foreign Exchange Indices (3 months)

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## WORLD

### United States:

The US market closed with positive returns. The DOW JONES finished in the green, boosted by the Treasury's reduction of its quarterly borrowing estimate by \$55 billion to \$760 billion in the first quarter. The S&P 500 index also ended with positive performance, amid traders' expectations for an earnings-heavy week, the Federal Reserve's monetary policy decision on Wednesday and crucial labor data such as non-farm payrolls, the unemployment rate and JOLTS. This will be the biggest week for corporate earnings, as 19% of the S&P 500 will report results, including large-cap tech stocks such as Microsoft, Apple, Meta, Amazon and Alphabet. Finally, the NASDAQ index ended the day higher. On the corporate front, Meta rose 1.75% to an all-time high of \$401.02, Tesla gained 4.19% and Merck rose 0.39% to a 50+ year high of \$121.28. Thus, DOW JONES +0.59%, S&P 500 +0.76%, NASDAQ +1.12% ended with positive returns.

### Europe:

The main European indices ended Monday's session with mixed performances. The pan-European STOXX 600 closed in positive territory, but with little movement over the weekend, as greater volatility is expected due to the upcoming decisions from the Fed and the Bank of England. The UK market, reflected in the FTSE 100, closed with a slightly negative performance, as gains in the mining sector were outweighed by losses in the life insurance sector, and investors remain cautious ahead of the Fed's decision. On the other hand, the German market, reflected in the DAX index, closed in negative territory, with investors preparing for the release of German inflation and GDP growth data. Bayern fell 4.5% after a court ruling ordered the company to pay \$2.25 billion to a man who developed cancer due to exposure to one of its products. The main index of the Paris stock exchange ended the session positively, reaching a new high but with slight gains as the market awaits important news for the week. Thus, FTSE 100 -0.03%; CAC 40 +0.09%; DAX -0.12%; STOXX 600 +0.21% closed with mixed results.

### Asia:

The main Asian indices started this week with mixed performance. The Chinese market concluded with negative results, affected by a US legislator's proposal to ban Chinese biotechnology companies from doing business with the US government. Health and technology stocks led the decline, and concerns about broader sanctions on Chinese industries, including semiconductors and artificial intelligence, intensified. Losses included WuXi AppTec, Zhongji InnoLight, and TCL Zhonghua. Chinese regulators also suspended the lending of locked-up shares for short selling, aiming to stabilize stock markets. In Hong Kong, the market closed green, driven by measures to stabilize the Chinese market and expectations of a US Federal Reserve meeting. However, uncertainty persists due to the liquidation order of China Evergrande and Chinese economic data. The South Korean market had positive results, with the country's growth figures surpassing estimates, increasing market expectations. The Japanese Nikkei index ended positively, while investors await Japanese economic data and remain cautious ahead of the US Federal Reserve's monetary policy decision. The Australian market also ended with gains after the holiday, with the energy sector outperforming losses in mining and technology. Thus, NIKKEI +0.77%; HANG SENG +0.78%; CSI 300 -0.90%; S&P/ASX 200 +0.31%; KOSPI +0.89%, SHANGHAI COMPOSITE -0.92% closed with mixed performance.


