Peru: The LSE General Index ended today's session with a positive result of +1.01%. The index maintains a positive cumulative annual trend of +11.40% in local currency and a positive cumulative trend of +11.26% in dollar-adjusted currency. The S&P/BVL Peru SEL varied +0.34% while the S&P/BVL LIMA 25 varied +0.82%. The spot PEN reached S/3.7101. Headline: Bicameralism: Moody's could change Peru's outlook to stable.

Chile: The IPSA index ended the day with a positive return of +0.15%. The most benefited sectors of the day were Consumer Staples (+1.02%) and Energy (+0.96%). The best performing stocks were Embotelladora Andina SA (+3.24%) and Compañía Sud Americana de Vapo (+2.22%). Headline: The tax change in Peru that could affect the operations of Chilean companies.

Colombia: The COLCAP index ended the session with a positive return of +0.49%. The most benefited sectors of the day were Materials (+1.20%) and Utilities (+0.79%). The best performing stocks were Mineros SA (+4.91%) and Inversiones Argos SA (+2.57%). Headline: Supreme Court convened extraordinary session to elect new attorney general.

Mexico: The IPC index closed the day in negative territory, -0.42%. The sectors that lost the most during the day were Industrials (-1.54%) and Communication services (-1.51%). The worst performing stocks were Grupo Carso SAB de CV (-2.70%) and Controladora Vuela Cia de Avia (-2.28%).

Headline: Inflation 'gives a break' to Mexicans' pockets: It decelerates to 4.40% in February.

Brazil: The IBOVESPA index closed the day in negative territory at -0.43%. The worst performing sectors of the day were Information Technology (-3.27%) and Non-Basic Consumer Products (-1.05%). The worst performing stocks were Cia. Siderúrgica Nacional SA (-4.80%) and Duratex SA (-4.12%). Headline: BYD promises billions in



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WORLD



United States:

The US market closed with positive returns. The DOW JONES index closed with green results. Semiconductor stocks had an outstanding performance, among these, Nvidia rose 4.5%, reaching its all-time high of \$924, on the other hand Intel was the best performer of the index, advancing 3.7%. The S&P 500 index also finished with gains, reaching a new high, up 1%. Nine of the 11 major sectors rose, with communications services .SPLRCL and information technology stocks .SPLRCT vying for the top spot as the biggest gainers. Technology, meanwhile, finished up 1.89%, followed by communication services with a 1.84% gain. Finally, the NASDAQ index ended with positive returns, driven by technology stocks, growth stocks and comments from Jerome Powell, chairman of the Fed, who informed a U.S. Senate committee that the country's central bank is close to being confident that inflation is slowing towards the 2% target, which would open up the possibility of interest rate cuts. His remarks therefore stoked investors' expectations about the possibility of a first rate cut in June, reviving stock market indices that had shown weakness in the days leading up to his congressional testimony. Thus, DOW JONES +0.34%, S&P 500 +1.03% and NASDAQ +1.51% ended the day with positive results.



Europe:

The main European indices ended the session with positive returns. The pan-European STOXX 600 index closed higher after the European Central Bank's decision to keep interest rates high but with expectations to lower them soon, as inflation data had been favorable. The UK market, reflected in the FTSE 100, closed with positive results marking its third consecutive day of gains. Rentokil was the top gainer of the day, rising by 17.7%, while Virgin Money UK surged by more than 35% following the announcement of a potential acquisition by Nationwide Building Society. Anglo American and Ocado also recorded significant gains. Similarly, the German market, reflecte d in the DAX index, closed with gains after the European Central Bank's decision to maintain interest rates and reduce inflation forecasts. Hugo Boss fell by 11%, Continental reported higher costs, and Merck anticipates modest earnings growth. Lufthansa reported an operating profit of € 2.7 billion for 2023. The French market closed the session in the green, rate-sensitive stocks like Unibail-Rodamco-We rose by 2.45%, while financials like Credit Agricole and BNP Paribas gained 2.17% and 2.11%, respectively. Thus, FTSE 100 +0.17%; CAC 40 +0.77%; DAX +0.71%; STOXX 600 +0.99% ended on positive levels.



Asia:

The major Asian indices closed with mostly negative returns. The Chinese market ended with negative returns, extending losses from the previous session as stronger-than-expected Chinese trade figures dampened hopes for further policy easing. Data showed that Chinese exports jumped 7.1% YoY in January-February, far exceeding forecasts for a 1.9% gain amid resilient foreign demand. Meanwhile, in the Hong Kong market, the Hang Seng index finished with losses, mostly giving up gains from the previous session due to a drop in US futures after Fed Chair Powell reiterated to lawmakers that the central bank was in no rush to start its easing cycle as a fight against inflation continued. Meanwhile, concerns over geopolitical tension mounted following a move from the US that called on its allies to tighten further curbs on China's access to chip tech. The South Korean market ended with positive results, ending a two-day losing streak, with battery makers leading the market higher. Additionally, Fed Chair Jerome Powell's congressional testimony kept expectations for rate cuts this year intact, bolstering investor sentiment. The Japanese market closed lower, while the broader Topix index lost 0.44% to 2,719 on Thursday, with Japanese shares retreating from all-time highs as a wave of profit-taking swept through the market. Growing speculation that the Bank of Japan could raise interest rates this month also pressured the equity market. The Australian market ended higher, as investors digested data showing Australia's trade surplus increased in January, although the data came in below forecasts. Earlier this week, data also showed that Australia's economy expanded less than expected in the fourth quarter, supporting bets that the Reserve Bank of Australia could start cutting rates this year. Thus, NIKKEI -1.23%; HANG SENG -1.27%; CSI 300 -0.60%; S&P/ASX 200 +0.39%; KOSPI +0.23%, SHANGHAI COMPOSITE -0.41% ended with mostly negative returns




