Peru: The LSE General index ended today's session with a positive result of +0.72%. The index maintains a positive accumulated annual trend of +11.43% in local currency and a positive accumulated trend of +11.97% in dollar-adjusted currency. The S&P/BVL Peru SEL varied +0.73% while the S&P/BVL LIMA 25 varied +0.76%. The PEN spot reached S/.3.6875. Headline: Fishing could rebound 30% after two years in negative, know which factors would influence the rise.

Chile: The IPSA index ended the day with a positive return of 1.24%. The most benefited sectors of the day were Industrials (+3.78%) and Non Basic Consumer Products (+2.09%). The best performing stocks were Sociedad Química y Minera de C (-5.93%) and Sociedad de Inversiones Oro BI (+4.28%). Headline: Fiscal Council's harsh warning: sees "stress" and lack of slack in public finances in the future.

Colombia: The COLCAP index ended the session with a negative return of -0.05%. The sectors that lost the most during the day were Materials (-0.39%) and Finance (-0.29%). The worst performing stocks were Sociedades Bolívar SA (-5.21%) and Cementos Argos SA (-1.91%). Headline: The Colombian dollar recovered and managed to stay above \$3,900.

Mexico: The IPC index closed the day in positive territory +0.26%. The sectors that benefited the most during the day were Health Care (+1.28%) and Materials (+1.12%). The worst-performing stocks were Gentera SAB de CV (+2.63%) and Grupo Cars (+2.63%).

Brazil: The IBOVESPA index closed the day in negative territory at -0.75%. The most affected sectors of the day were Materials (-2.42%) and Communication Services (-1.52%). The worst performing stocks were IRB-Brasil Resseguros SA (-3.11%) and CSN Mineracao SA (-2.86%). Headline: The Ibovespa closes with a 0.75% drop, pressured by Vale and Petrobras shares.




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
MILA: Intraday Evolution




MILA: Curvas de Deuda Soverana




MILA: Foreign Exchange Indices (3 months)

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WORLD

United States:

The US market closed with mixed performances. The DOW JONES ended in the green, the rally from the previous week that pushed the major averages to record highs cooled off, and a cautious mood prevailed ahead of the US CPI report expected tomorrow. The S&P 500 index also ended with negative performance, as the upcoming CPI and PPI reports due this week are among the last major economic reports expected before the Federal Reserve's March monetary policy meeting. These reports will be closely watched for their implications on the prospect of interest rate cuts. Lastly, the NASDAQ index finished the day down, with tech stocks leading the declines, as Super Micro Computer fell 5.2% and chipmaker Nvidia dropped 2%. Meta also struggled, tumbling 4.4%. Coinbase initially gained 4.7% but finished 0.9% lower, after bitcoin reached a new all-time high above \$72,000. On a positive note, Moderna gained 8.7% following reports that its study of a vaccine for a type of skin cancer is beginning. Thus, the DOW JONES +0.12%, S&P 500 -0.11%, NASDAQ -0.41% ended with mixed performances.

Europe:

The main European indices ended Monday's session mostly in negative territory. The pan-European STOXX 600 closed lower, retreating from its recent all-time highs, as investors took a brief pause ahead of the release of US CPI data scheduled for Tuesday, which could provide insights into potential interest rate adjustments by the Federal Reserve. The UK market, represented by the FTSE 100, closed with a positive performance, with Admiral Group standing out as the top gainer after Berenberg raised its price target, while Imperial Brands launched the second phase of its share buyback. Conversely, St James's Place experienced a 3.6% decline. The German market, reflected in the DAX index, closed in negative territory as investors awaited US inflation data that could influence future Federal Reserve decisions. LEG Immobilien shares rose nearly 3% after announcing solid annual results and improved dividend plans. The primary París stock index ended the session lower, with Teleperformance, Alstom, and Publicis Groupe experiencing declines of 4.42%, 3.33%, and 2.63%, respectively. Thus, FTSE 100 +0.12%; CAC 40 -0.10%; DAX -0.38%; STOXX 600 -0.35% closed mostly negative.

Asia:

Major Asian indices started the week with mixed performances. The Chinese market concluded with positive results, following the release of China's consumer prices over the weekend, which reflected a 0.7% y-o-y increase in February, lifting the country out of deflation for the first time since September 2023. This event generated an optimistic environment, which boosted market sentiment. In Hong Kong, the market closed in the green, amid reports that Chinese regulators had met with financial institutions to ask large banks to provide financial support to the property developer. A rebound in China's consumer inflation to 0.7% last month also boosted the mood of traders, who shrugged off the 17th consecutive month of falling factory gate prices. The South Korean market performed negatively, retreating from the more than 21-month high reached in the previous session, as investors sought to take profits. In economic news, South Korea's unemployment data for February will be released this week. Japan's Nikkei index ended negative, where Japanese stocks moved away from their all-time highs and followed in the wake of Friday's drop in technology stocks on Wall Street, as a wave of profit-taking pervaded the markets. The Australian market also ended with losses, retreating sharply from its all-time highs as investors picked up some of the profits, with almost all sectors participating in the decline. Thus, NIKKEI -2.1%; HANG SENG +1.43%; CSI 300 +1.25%; S&P/ASX 200 -1.82%; KOSPI -0.77%; SHANGHAI COMPOSITE +0.74% closed with mixed performances.






