## LATAM

Lima, April 18, 2024

**Peru:** The LSE General index is in today's session with a positive result of 0.83%. The index maintains a positive annual cumulative trend of +6.65% in local currency and a positive cumulative trend of +5.94% in dollar-adjusted currency. With respect to the S&P/BVL Peru SEL, it varied by 1.39% while the S&P/BVL LIMA 25 by +1.17%. The spot PEN reached S/. 3.7137. Headline: MEF raises restrictions to CTS withdrawals, will they work?

**Chile:** The IPSA index ended the day with a negative return of -0.07%. The sectors that lost the most during the day were Materials (-1.84%) and Real Estate (-1.57%). The worst performing stocks were Compañía Sud Americana de Vapo (-2.37%), Cencosud Shopping SA with +1.20%, Empresas CMPC SA (-2.07%) and Sociedad Química y Minera de C (-1.88%). Headline: Central Bank evaluated a 100 bp drop in key rate, but opted for 75 bp considering "tactical" factors.

**Colombia:** The COLCAP index ended the session with a negative return of -2.15%. The worst performing sectors of the day were Materials (-2.70%) and Financials (-2.66%). The worst performing stocks were Grupo de Inversiones Suramerica with -6.05%, Cementos Argos SA with -4.76% and Grupo de Inversiones Suramerica with -4.72%. Headline: Businessmen from downtown Medellín join Antioquia's infrastructure 'cow'.

**Mexico:** The IPC index closed the day in positive territory +0.58%. The sectors that benefited the most during the day were Health Care (+3.55%) and Industrials (+1.10%). The best performing stocks were Gruma SAB de CV with +6.80%, Genomma Lab Internacional SAB with +3.55% and Arca Continental SAB de CV with +2.77%. Headline: Bankers warn Mexico's first female president: 'Without fiscal consolidation, investment grade would be lost'.

**Brazil:** The IBOVESPA index closed the day in positive territory with +0.02%. The day's top gainers were Information Technology (+1.77%) and Industrials (+0.64%). The best performing stocks were Sendas Distribuidora S/A with +2.65%, Totvs SA with +2.47% and Localiza Rent a Car SA with +1.82%. Headline: Brazil consolidates its position as the world's largest sugar producer after historic harvest.



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
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
### MILA: Curvas de Deuda Soverana




### MILA: Foreign Exchange Indices (3 months)

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## WORLD

### United States:

The US market closed with mixed performances. In a context where quarterly corporate data is out. Traders continue to watch strong economic data, as well as variables such as initial jobless claims and the Philadelphia Fed manufacturing index. The DOW JONES index closed in the green. These results are explained by gains in the financial sector, among the stocks that boosted the index the most were UnitedHealth (+2.96%) and Travelers (+1.88%). The S&P 500 index also ended with losses for the fifth consecutive time. These results came as investors scrutinized rising Treasury yields with falling interest rate cut expectations. Even the president of the Atlanta Fed, commented that rate cuts are unlikely to begin until the end of the year. On the corporate front, Tesla continues to decline (-5.5%), and after quarterly results Las Vegas Sands, it declined by 8.6%. Finally, the NASDAQ index ended with negative returns. This fall was mainly due to the semiconductor sector, which was the worst hit by almost all companies, with the exception of Nvidia which recorded a growth of 0.7% together with Taiwan Semiconductor Manufacturing which ended in gains thanks to the demand for AI. Thus, DOW JONES +0.06%, S&P 500 -0.22% and NASDAQ -0.52% ended the day with mixed results.

### Europe:

The main European indices ended the session with positive returns. The pan-European STOXX 600 index closed higher. ECB policymaker François Villeroy de Galhau said it will be necessary to start the central bank's cutting cycle soon to avoid falling behind the inflation curve, echoing the President Lagarde's earlier comments that looser monetary policy will be appropriate if inflation continues to converge toward target. The English market, reflected in the FTSE 100, closed with positive results, where the main gainers were HSBC Holdings and Unilever recorded gains of around 1-1.3%, while AstraZeneca rose 0.6%. Easyjet performed well, boosted by a successful winter season, and Concord Chorus made headlines with its \$1.4 billion acquisition of Hipgnosis Songs Fund. Likewise, the German market, reflected in the DAX index, closed with gains. Industrial stocks led the gains, benefiting from ABB's strong results in Zurich, with Siemens adding 1.6%. Additionally, Adidas jumped 2.7%, extending yesterday's tally of 8% following the release of its strong sales. The French market closed the session in green. Edmond de Rothschild shares rose 4.87%, boosted by its impressive 18.8% growth in first-quarter earnings, beating market estimates. Other notable gainers include Schneider Electric, up 2.79%, boosted by Swiss competitor ABB's rise to record levels, followed by Veolia, up 2.47%, and Societe Generale which gained 2.79%. 28%. Thus, FTSE 100 +0.37%; CAC 40 +0.52%; DAX +0.38%; STOXX 600 +0.24% ended at positive levels.

### Asia:

The main Asian indices closed with positive returns. The Chinese market ended with positive returns, with mainland stocks advancing for the second consecutive session and following a general advance in the Asia Pacific region. The Shanghai Composite Index also reached its highest levels since October during the intraday session. On the other hand, in the Hong Kong market, the Hang Seng index finished with gains, the market rebounded from its lowest level in over 5 weeks reached earlier in the week, amid growing hopes that Beijing might launch more stimuli to reverse the fragile recovery in the mainland in the first quarter of 2024, as evidenced by solid GDP figures and weak March activity data, including a high unemployment rate. The South Korean market ended with positive results on Thursday, recovering from an almost 11-week low in the previous session and ending a four-day losing streak, with all sectors participating in the rebound. Manufacturing stocks recorded the biggest increase. The Japanese market closed higher, reversing losses from earlier in the session and following a broad rebound in the Asia Pacific region. These moves came even after US stocks extended losses overnight, amid fears that the Federal Reserve could postpone rate cuts even further or even decide not to ease policy at all this year. The Australian market ended higher, erasing losses from the previous session, helped by gains in mining stocks due to firmer metal prices. Additionally, investors digested data showing that the unemployment rate edged up slightly to 3.8% in March from 3.7% in February, supporting a moderate view on domestic monetary policy. Thus, NIKKEI +0.31%; HANG SENG +0.82%; CSI 300 +0.12%; S&P/ASX 200 +0.48%; KOSPI +1.96%, SHANGHAI COMPOSITE +0.09% ended with positive returns.



### LATAM Country Risk (bps)




