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LATAM

Peru: The LSE General index is in today's session with a positive result of +1.05%. The index maintains a positive cumulative annual trend of +31.73% in local currency and a positive cumulative trend of +31.77% in dollar-adjusted currency. With respect to the S&P/BVL Peru SEL, it varied by +1.29% while the S&P/BVL LIMA 25 by +0.95%. The spot PEN reached S/.3.7431. Headline: Tuesta on credit rating downgrade: "Irresponsibility brings consequences".

Chile: The IPSA index ended the day with a positive return of +1.31%. The most benefited sectors of the day were Real Estate (+2.29%) and Industrials (+2.07%). The best performing stocks were Plaza SA with +4.61%, SMU SA with +2.88% and Sociedad Química y Minera de Chile C +2.18%. Headline: SII audit of Chileans' accounts abroad boosts interest in the distribution of capital in the tax form.

Colombia: The COLCAP index ended the session with a positive return of +1.24%. The most benefited sectors of the day were Finance (+2.37%) and Materials (+0.70%). The best performing stocks were Grupo de Inversiones Suramericana with +4.07%, BanColombia SA with +2.98% and Inversiones Argos SA with +2.97%. Headline: Mintrabajo to conduct labor inspection of General Motors after closing of Colmotores plant.

Mexico: The IPC index closed the day in positive territory +1.31%. The sectors that benefited the most during the day were Health (+3.16%) and Communication Services (+3.16%). The best performing stocks were Grupo Televisa SA with +6.21%, Gentera SAB de CV at +5.25% and Banco del Bajío SA with +4.66%. Headline: Mexico's trade surplus exceeds analysts' expectations

Brazil: The IBOVESPA index closed the day in positive territory at +1.51%. The sectors that benefited the most during the day were Real Estate (+4.35%) and Health Care (+3.88%). The best performing stocks were Azul SA with +5.97%, MRV Engenharia e Participações with +5.54% and Hypermarcas SA with +5.16%. Headline: Union pressures Eletrobras at shareholders' meeting to try to increase its decision-making power.


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
MILA: Curvas de Deuda Soverana

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WORLD

United States:

El mercado estadounidense cerró con rendimientos positivos. El índice DOW JONES cerró la sesión con rendimientos positivos. ExxonMobil perdió un 2,8% después de no cumplir con las expectativas de ganancias, mientras que Chevron subió ligeramente porque sus ganancias estuvieron por debajo de las estimaciones. De manera similar, el índice S&P 500 cerró con un rendimiento positivo. Las acciones estadounidenses terminaron al alza el viernes, impulsadas por sólidos informes de ganancias de Alphabet y Microsoft, lo que hizo que el Nasdaq, de gran tecnología, subiera un 2%. El S&P 500 subió un 1%, mientras que el Dow Jones ganó 153 puntos mientras los inversores restaban importancia a las preocupaciones sobre los precios elevados, especialmente después de que los últimos datos mostraron que el indicador de inflación preferido de la Reserva Federal seguía indicando presiones persistentes sobre los precios. Finalmente, el índice NASDAQ cerró al alza. Microsoft saltó un 1,8% después de superar las previsiones tanto de ganancias como de ingresos. Alphabet subió un 10,2%, alcanzando un máximo histórico de 171,95 dólares, tras sus optimistas resultados, y el anuncio de la compañía de su primer dividendo se sumó al sentimiento positivo. Por el contrario, Intel se desplomó un 9,2% después de ofrecer unas perspectivas de ingresos decepcionantes. Así, DOW JONES +0,40%, S&P 500 +1,02% y NASDAQ +2,03% terminaron con resultados positivos.

Europe:

The major European indices ended the session with positive returns. The pan-European STOXX 600 index closed higher as investors absorbed an ECB survey revealing that inflation expectations dropped to the lowest level in more than two years, while US PCE data suggested that inflationary pressures remained strong. The UK market, reflected in the FTSE 100, closed with positive results, buoyed by positive earnings from US tech giants and the Darktrace rally in the UK. The mid-cap firm surged by over 16% in a \$5.32 billion acquisition deal by Thoma Bravo. The German market closed in positive territory as gains in the tech sector followed the release of positive quarterly results from US tech giants Microsoft and Alphabet. Additionally, Thyssenkrupp soared by 7% after the German firm announced its intention to sell a 20% stake in its steel business to an energy company controlled by Czech billionaire Daniel Kretinsky. The French market, reflected in the CAC 40, closed with gains, ending a two-day losing streak as solid quarterly results offset further signs of persistent inflation in the US. TotalEnergies rose by 2.23% after reporting a smaller-than-expected drop in first-quarter profits, as resilient oil demand offset the impact of lower natural gas prices in Europe. Thus, the FTSE 100 +0.75%; CAC 40 +0.89%; DAX +1.36%; STOXX 600 +1.11% all ended with positive returns.

Asia:

Major Asian indices closed with mixed performances. The Chinese market ended with positive returns, extending a winning streak to a third day as sentiment improves and foreign investors gradually return to Chinese markets. Analysts at global investment houses have upgraded their views on Chinese stocks citing an improving macroeconomic outlook. On the other hand, in the Hong Kong market, the Hang Seng index ended with gains after technology stocks led the rally, up nearly 5% following strong results from Microsoft and Alphabet Inc. Also, the index rose 8.8% on the week, its biggest gain in a year and a half, boosted by investment bank HSBC's decision to change its position on Chinese stocks from underweight to neutral. The South Korean market ended with negative results. Financial stocks gains were led by KB Financial (+0.7%), despite posting a 30.5% Yo-Yo drop in net profit in Q1 2024 due to compensation paid out for investor losses incurred on troubled Hong Kong-linked derivatives. The Japanese market closed higher as the Bank of Japan held interest rates steady in a widely expected move. Meanwhile, the BOJ dropped that it would buy the same amount of bonds as before, revised up its inflation forecast and said the economy will likely continue to grow at a healthy pace. Investors also reacted to data showing Tokyo's core inflation rate slowed to a 2-year low of 1.6% in April, largely due to distortions from the start of education subsidies. The Australian market ended lower amid a sharp drop in BHP Group shares. BHP Group plunged 4.5% after unveiling a \$39 billion bid for rival Anglo American in a deal that would create the world's largest copper miner. Australian shares also caught the fall in global stock markets, as U.S. economic data pointed to weak growth in the first quarter, although strong results from major technology companies subsequently boosted the rally in global markets. Thus, NIKKEI +0.21%; HANG SENG -2.18%; CSI 300 -0.81%; S&P/ASX 200 -0.33%; KOSPI +1.05%; SHANGHAI COMPOSITE -0.49% ended with mixed performances.
