

## LATAM

Peru: The LSE General index ended today's session with a positive result of +1.92%. The index maintains a positive cumulative annual trend of +41.95% in local currency and a positive cumulative trend of +40.59% in dollar-adjusted currency. With respect to the S&P/BVL Peru SEL, it varied +1.16% while the S&P/BVL LIMA 25 varied +1.46%. The spot PEN reached S/.3.7336.

Headline: BVL closed higher as markets await economic data and FED signals.

Chile: The IPSA index ended the day with a positive return of +0.77%. The sectors that benefited the most during the day were Industrials (+1.92%) and Consumer Staples (+1.10%). The best performing stocks were Cencosud SA (+2.47%) and Sociedad Química y Minera de C (+1.97%). Headline: Younger workers' wages move slower than their parents'.

Colombia: The COLCAP index ended the session with a positive return of +0.87%. The sectors that benefited the most during the day were Finance (+1.79%) and Energy (+0.81%). The best performing stocks were BanColombia SA (+2.52%) and BanColombia SA (+2.20%). Headline: Colombian dollar started the week with losses awaiting new signals from the FED.

Mexico: The IPC index closed the day in slightly positive territory at -0.33%. The sectors that lost the most during the day were Financials (-1.87%) and Consumer Staples (-0.53%). The worst performing stocks were Grupo Carso SAB de CV (-4.40%) and Alfa SAB de CV (-3.83%). Headline: Experts forecast higher fiscal deficit for 2024 and 2025.

Brazil: The IBOVESPA index closed the day in negative territory at -0.31%. The worst performing sectors of the day were Communication Services (-2.33%) and Real Estate (-1.52%). The worst performing stocks were IRB-Brasil Resseguros SA (-6.81%) and Centrais Elétricas Brasileiras (-3.53%). Headline: Lula says that the recovery of RS is the possibility to make the economy grow even more.

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## WORLD

### United States:

The US market closed with mixed returns. The DOW JONES ended with negative returns as investors seek additional clues about the timing of Fed interest rate cuts, with several Fed officials scheduled to speak and FOMC minutes to be released this week. The S&P 500 index also ended in the green, up almost 0.1%, staying near historic highs and on track to mark its 24th record close this year. Lastly, the NASDAQ index finished with positive results, driven by a tech rally. In corporate news, Nvidia shares advanced 2.5%, lifting the sector. Other chipmakers, including Applied Materials (+3.7%), KLA Corporation (+3.3%), and Micron Technology (+2.9%), also saw gains. In contrast, Target shares fell 2.2% after the retailer announced it would lower prices on approximately 5,000 frequently purchased items to attract cost-conscious consumers. Thus, DOW JONES -0.49%, S&P 500 +0.09%, NASDAQ +0.65% ended with mixed returns.

### Europe:

The main European indices closed with positive returns. The pan-European STOXX 600 index closed with slight gains, as traders digested new corporate results and comments from Federal Reserve officials. Atlanta Fed President Bostic suggested that future US interest rates could reach levels comparable to those of the 1990s and predicted only one rate cut in 2024. Vice President Barr also supported keeping rates stable, citing disappointing first quarter CPI data. In the English market, the FTSE index closed the session positively. Holding near last week's all-time high as gains in heavyweight mines offset losses in rate-sensitive stocks. Fresnillo shares closed up 4% to lead the mining sector, benefiting from another positive session for the silver and gold benchmarks. Similarly, the German market closed negative. SAP, Airbus and Deutsche Telekom each saw an increase of almost 1%, while Siemens rose around 0.5% and Allianz showed a slight rebound. In the French market, the session closed with losses. Among individual stocks, Teleperformance stood out with a gain of 3%, followed by Société Générale (2.2%), Safran (1.9%), Air Liquide (1.7%) and Airbus (1.2%). However, Carrefour shares fell 1%, followed by Engie and Unibail-Rodamco-Westfield SE both down 0.9% and Renault losing 0.8%. Thus, FTSE 100 +0.05%; CAC 40 +0.35%; DAX +0.35%; STOXX 600 +0.18% closed with positive returns.

### Asia:

Major Asian indices started the week with positive returns. The Chinese market concluded with positive results, as the People's Bank of China left its one- and five-year prime lending rates unchanged at 3.45% and 3.95%, respectively, in line with expectations. Late last week, China also announced a broad package of measures to support its struggling property market, including relaxing mortgage rules and urging local governments to buy unsold homes. In Hong Kong, the market closed in the green after China announced new measures on Friday to stabilize its property sector and stimulate an economic turnaround. The PBOC acted by providing CNY 1 trillion in additional financing and easing mortgage rules, while local governments set about buying apartments. The South Korean market ended on a positive note, driven by gains in automakers and financial stocks, following the government's reaffirmation to push forward with its business reform measures. Automobile and financial stocks are expected to benefit the most from the government's corporate revaluation program, with significant potential for increased dividend payouts. The Japanese market closed higher, following recent U.S. economic data that cemented expectations that the Federal Reserve will begin cutting interest rates this year. In addition, investors are eagerly awaiting a number of economic reports to be released this week in Japan, including data on trade, inflation and business activity. The Australian market ended in the green, where mining stocks led the advance, as China's latest property stimulus measures and expectations of interest rate cuts in the US lifted commodity prices. Thus, NIKKEI +0.73%; HANG SENG +0.42%; CSI 300 +0.35%; S&P/ASX 200 +0.63%; KOSPI +0.64%; SHANGHAI COMPOSITE +0.54% closed with positive returns.


