Peru: The LSE General index ended today's session with a negative result of -1.17%. The index maintains a positive accumulated annual trend of +31.58% in local currency and a positive accumulated trend of +27.30% in dollar-adjusted currency. The S&P/BVL Peru SEL varied by -1.04% while the S&P/BVL LIMA 25 varied by -0.72%. The spot PEN reached S/. 3.7644. Headline: Banks' gains accelerate due to the ups and downs of the dollar, who gets more?

Chile: The IPSA index ended the day with a negative return -0.75%. The sectors that lost the most during the day were Industrials (-2.23%) and Energy (-0.99%). The worst performing stocks were Compañía Sud Americana de Vapo (-4.37%) and Quinenco SA (-3.69%). Headline: Fiscal Council puts cooler heads on better GDP perspectives and says that public sector slack will not necessarily increase.

Colombia: The COLCAP index ended the session with a positive return of +0.39%. The sectors that benefited the most during the day were Unclassified (+6.24%) and Energy (+0.84%). The best performing stocks were Patrimonio Autonomo Estrategia (+6.24%) and Banco Davivienda SA (+1.41%). Headline: Meeting between Petro and Swedish Prime Minister ended with trade agreement

Mexico: The IPC index closed the day in negative territory, -1.32%. The sectors that lost the most during the day were Real Estate (-2.60%) and Finance (-1.94%). The worst performing stocks were Grupo Carso SAB de CV (-4.11%) and Grupo Televisa SA (-4.02%). Headline: Banxico could intervene in the market in the face of high volatility

Brazii: The IBOVESPVA index closed the day in negative territory at -0.31%. The sectors that lost the most during the day were Communication Services (-1.26%) and Real Estate (-1.14%). The worst performing stocks were MRV Engenharia e Participações (-4.48%) and Vamos Locacao de Caminhoes Maq (-4.43%). Headline: Import taxes cause Shein to accelerate transition to Brazil, says company's global vice-president.

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# WORLD



## United States:

The US market closed with mixed results. The DOW JONES index closed with negative results. Within its thirty stocks, slight movements were seen in shares such as Apple (0.63%), 3M Co (0.5%) and with negative performances the companies Caterpillar (-1.94%) and Imagen (-1.84%). Likewise, WTI registered a fall after the previous day's report of an increase in crude oil reserves, news that came after expectations that it would fall. The S&P 500 index ended with gains driven by Broadcom's rally, which boosted chip stocks. This result is also explained by higher expectations of rate cuts for the current year given data that would indicate a slowdown in inflation. Finally, the NASDAQ index also ended with positive returns. On the corporate front, TESLA led the gains after posting returns of almost 3%. Its results were due to Elon Musk's publications where he stated that shareholders support his 56 billion dollar salary package. In addition to his reinstatement in Texas. Thus, DOW JONES -0.17%, S&P 500 +0.23% and NASDAQ +0.34% ended the day with mixed results.

### Europe:

The major European indices ended the session with negative returns. The pan-European STOXX 600 closed lower on Thursday, impacted by the widening yield spreads between French and German bonds, and losses in Southern European bonds due to political turbulence. U.S. and German Treasury bonds rose following an un expected drop in U.S. producer prices. The UK market, reflected in the FTSE 100, closed with negative results, mirroring losses in other European markets due to concerns over the rise of far-right parties in Europe. Wise shares fell 12% due to a slower growth forecast, while Crest Nicholson dropped over 11% after warning of significant profit declines; in contrast, Halma rose more than 13% after exceeding expectations and BT increased by 4.3% following Carlos Slim's acquisition of a 3.16% stake in the company. Similarly, the German market, reflected in the DAX index, closed in negative territory due to the widening yield spread between French and German bonds. German bond yields fell, while those of Italy and France rose following U.S. data showing an unexpected drop in producer prices. Siemens, Airbus, and SAP experienced significant declines along with other major German stocks. The French market closed in the red, reaching a four-month low due to political uncertainty. France's budget deficits and debt concerns intensified ahead of the snap elections, with strong support for a far-right populist party. This increased the yield spreads between French and German 10-year bonds and triggered a massive sell-off of French assets. Axa fell 4.6%, followed by Edenred, Eurofins Scientific, and BNP Paribas, while Renault and Stellantis NV also recorded declines due to concerns over tariffs on Chinese electric vehicles. Consequently, the FTSE 100 -0.63%; CAC 40 -1.99%; DAX -1.96%; STOXX 600 -1.31% ended in negative territory.



## Asia:

The main Asian indices closed with mostly positive performances. The Chinese market closed lower, erasing the gains from theprevious session as sentiment was affected by news of additional European tariffs on Chinese electric cars. The European Commission said on Wednesday that it would impose additional duties of up to 38.1% on electric vehicles imported from China amid efforts to support European automakers. On the other hand, in the Hong Kong market, the Hang Seng index endedwith gains, mostly recovering from a 1.3% drop in the previous session as most sectors posted gains. Traders were eager to add new positions after Wall Street's S&P500 and Nasdaq hit record closing highs for the third consecutive day on Wednesday, following soft US inflation data and forecasts that the Fed will cut interest rates once before the end of 2024 and four times in 2025. The South Korean market ended with positive results, closing at its highest level since late March, following an overnight rally on Wall Street after the release of US inflation data and the Federal Reserve's policy decision. The Japanese market closed lower, reversing early session gains as caution prevailed ahead of the Bank of Japan's policy decision at the end of the week. It is widely expected that the BOJ will keep interest rates unchanged, but traders will focus on whether the central bank will announce a reductionin its monthly bond purchases. The Australian market finished in the green, breaking a two-day decline and following a strong overnight rally on Wall Street amid softer-than-expected US inflation data and reassurance that the Federal Reserve will still cut interest rates this year. Thus, NIKKEI-0.40%; HANG SENG +0.97%; CSI 300 -0.51%; S&P/ASX 200 +0.44%; KOSPI +0.98%; SHANGHAI COMPOSITE -0.28% ended with mixed performances.






