

LATAM

Peru: The LSE General index ended today's session with a negative result of -0.23%. The index maintains a positive annual cumulative trend of 15.81% in local currency and a positive cumulative trend of +15.37% in dollar-adjusted currency. The S&P/BVL Peru SEL varied -0.63% while the S&P/BVL LIMA 25 varied -0.10%. The spot PEN reached S/.3.7192.

Headline: Grupo Wong, from selling its business to Cencosud to generating companies: what are they in today?

Chile: The IPSA index ended the day with a positive return +0.25%. The most benefited sectors of the day were Energy (+2.12%) and Materials (+1.40%). The best performing stocks were Inversiones Aguas Metropolitan (+2.46%) and Empresas COPEC SA (+2.12%). Headline: Economists forecast limited effect of public transport fare hike on July CPI.

Colombia: The COLCAP index ended the session with a positive return of +0.05%. The sectors that benefited the most during the day were Energy (+1.32%) and Utilities (+0.25%). The best performing stocks were Mineros SA (+1.94%) and Ecopetrol SA (+1.37%). Headline: Detailed gas production projections raise concerns.

Mexico: The IPC index closed the day in negative territory at -1.17%. The sectors that lost the most during the day were Health Care (+2.65%) and Materials (-2.01%). The worst performing stocks were Qualitas Controladora SAB de C (-3.11%) and Grupo Financiero Inbursa SA (-3.03%). Headline: Grupo Wong, from selling its business to Cencosud to generating companies: where are they today?

Brazil: The IBOVESPA index closed the day in positive territory, +0.33%. The day's top gainers were Information Technology (+1.15%) and Health Care (+1.03%). The best performing stocks were Ez Tec Empreendimentos e Partições (+3.84%) and Suzano Papel e Celulose SA (+3.63%). Headline: Tax reform: experts believe that setting the tax rate cap at 26.5% may not work.

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WORLD

United States:

The U.S. market closed with positive returns. The DOW JONES closed with gains as traders assessed the impact of an assassination attempt on presidential candidate Donald Trump and focused on remarks from Jerome Powell. The Federal Reserve Chair noted that recent inflation data has strengthened confidence in the economy and indicated that while the Federal Reserve's policy stance remains restrictive, it is not overly severe. The S&P 500 ended in the green, as Powell also acknowledged improvements in the labor market, and emphasized that the Fed can act preemptively before inflation reaches 2%, but refused to signal a specific timing for potential rate cuts. Finally, the NASDAQ finished the day in the green, as on the corporate front, Trump Media & Technology Group Corp. surged 31.4%, Goldman Sachs climbed 2.5% to a record \$492 after reporting upbeat quarterly results. Macy's plunged 11.7% after rejecting a \$6.9 billion buyout offer from Arkhose and Brigade. Thus, DOW JONES +0.53%, S&P 500 +0.28%, NASDAQ +0.40%, with the market having positive returns.

Europe:

The main European indices closed with negative returns. The pan-European STOXX 600 index closed with losses. Investors reacted to negative economic news from China and the fallout from an assassination attempt on Donald Trump, which may affect the US presidential election. All major sectors and exchanges were in the red, with household goods leading losses at 2%, followed by utilities at 1.9%. In the English market, the FTSE index closed with negative returns, weighed down by pessimism about the key industries of the London Stock Exchange, while the markets continued to evaluate the extent of the disinflationary trend in the United States and the United Kingdom in search of clues about the future borrowing costs. Burberry sank 16.1% after canceling its dividend payment and changing its chief executive in an effort to stem the company's recent slowdown and its underperformance compared to others in the European luxury sector. In the French market, the session closed with losses. Luxury giants Kering, LVMH and Hermès were among the biggest fallers, down 5.3%, 2.8% and 2.7% respectively, following a JP Morgan report indicating continued weakness in the sector. Other notable losses were those of Eurofins Scientific (-2.9%), Pernod Ricard (-2%) and Sanofi (-2%). Thus, FTSE -0.85%; CAC 40 -1.19%; DAX -0.84%; STOXX 600 -1.02% closed with negative returns.

Asia:

Major Asian indices closed with mixed performances. The Chinese market closed positive in mixed trade on Monday, with mainland bourses struggling to find a clear direction as investors digested recent economic data. Official data showed that the Chinese economy grew by 4.7% year-on-year in the second quarter, down from 5.3% in the previous quarter and below the forecast growth of 5.1%. Meanwhile, the country's industrial production rose more than expected to 5.3%, although it was the weakest in three months, while retail sales fell to 2% in 17 months, missing market forecasts for a 3.3% rise. Elsewhere, the Hang Seng index is in negative territory pressured by disappointing Chinese GDP growth in the second quarter, as the latest data puts the country's 2024 growth target in jeopardy. Investors also closely followed the latest developments related to the assassination attempt on former U.S. President Donald Trump on Saturday and its potential to cause political uncertainty. The South Korean market ended in a positive result as investors assessed the market impact of former U.S. President Donald Trump's increased electoral chances after surviving an assassination attempt. Similarly, the Japanese market closed lower as caution dominated sentiment ahead of this week's key US inflation data, which could influence the Federal Reserve's monetary policy. In Japan, data showed real wages fell by 1.4% in May, dealing a blow to the Bank of Japan's efforts to normalize monetary policy. The Australian market ended positive as expectations that the U.S. Federal Reserve will begin cutting interest rates soon buoyed equity markets. Investors also assessed the implications of an assassination attempt against former U.S. President Donald Trump over the weekend, which analysts said boosted his chances of winning the election. Thus, NIKKEI -2.45%; HANG SENG -1.52%; CSI 300 +0.11%; S&P/ASX 200 +0.73%; KOSPI +0.14%; SHANGHAI COMPOSITE +0.09% ended with mixed performances.




