LATAM

Peru: The BVL General Index is in today's session with a positive result of +0.87%. The index maintains a positive accumulated annual trend of +14.33% in local currency and a positive accumulated trend of +13.46% in currency adjusted in dollars. Regarding the S&P/BVL Peru SEL varied by +0.68% while the S&P/BVL LIMA 25 by +0.84%. The PEN spot reached S/.3.7337. Headline: Minera Poderosa: the thousands of ounces of gold that it is not capturing due to illegal mining

Chile: The IPSA index ended the day with a negative return of -0.13%. The most affected sectors of the day were Energy (-1.20%) and Public Services (-0.93%). The stocks with the worst performance were Enel Chile SA with -1.84% and Banco de Credito e Inversion -1.46%. Headline: Disintegration and increases for individuals: the taxes that are candidates to be removed from the income tax project prepared by the Treasury.

Colombia: The COLCAP index ended the session with a negative return of -0.59%. The most affected sectors of the day were Public Services (-1.71%) and Materials (-0.53%). The worst performing stocks were Interconexion Eléctrica SA with -2.08% and Inversiones Argos SA -1.85%. Headline: With 8 years in Colombia, Smart Fit consolidates itself as the leading fitness company in the country

Mexico: The IPC index closed the day in negative territory of -0.38%. The most affected sectors of the day were Finance (-1.57%) and Communication Services (-1.52%). The worst performing stocks were Grupo Elektra SAB with -9.77% and Megacable Holdings-CPO -4.33%. Headline: Tariff cut helped lower inflation in 2023: WTO

Brazil: The IBOVESPA index closed the day in positive territory of +1.22%. The sectors that benefited the most during the day were Health (+3.95%) and Basic Consumer Goods (+2.51%). The best performing stocks were Azul SA with +6.87% and JBS SA with +6.72%. Headline: The energy tariff flag turns green again in August, without surcharge.






MILA: Intraday Evolution




MILA: Curvas de Deuda Soverana




MILA: Foreign Exchange Indices (3 months)

WORLD

United States:

The US market closed with positive returns. The DOW JONES closed in the green as market sentiment was buoyed by new data suggesting easing inflation, reinforcing expectations for a potential interest rate cut in September. The PCE reading, the Federal Reserve's preferred inflation measure, aligned with expectations, although the core rate increased by 0.2%, slightly above the forecast of 0.1%. The S&P 500 index ended in the green as all sectors posted gains, led by industrials with 3M soaring 23.1%, marking its best day since at least 1972. Deckers Outdoor jumped 6.5% on upbeat quarterly results, while Coursers surged 44.8% following an 11% increase in second-quarter revenue. Lastly, the NASDAQ index finished the day in the green, as investors are preparing for next week's quarterly earnings reports from four of the Magnificent Seven tech giants: Apple, Microsoft, Amazon, and Meta. Thus, the DOW JONES +1.64%, S&P 500 +1.11%, and NASDAQ +1.03% all ended with positive results.

Europe:

Major European indices ended the session with positive returns. The pan-European STOXX 600 index closed higher, helped by investor sentiment ahead of earnings reports on the corporate front. Hermes rose 3.6% after reporting better-than-expected revenue growth and Saint-Gobain added 4.4% as the company reported sales growth in North America and a record operating margin. Mercedes-Benz share pared early losses and traded around the flat line, after hitting January lows of 61.7 euros earlier in the session. ThyssenKrupp sank around 8% after cutting its 2024 guidance. The English market, reflected in the FTSE 100, closed with positive results. As investors await the interest rate decision, AstraZeneca and Unilever rose more than 1%, while Shell and BP gained 0.8% and 0.3% ahead of next week's results. Ahead of earnings, miners Glencore and Rio Tinto gained 0.4% and 1.2% respectively, while Fresnillo fell -1.2%. NatWest rose 6.5% despite a smaller-than-expected 16% drop in first-half pre-tax profit. The German market closed higher. Gainers were Sartorius, Rheinmetall and Merck with 7.2%, 3.6% and 2.4% respectively. In addition, Mercedes-Benz shares managed to recover from early losses and traded around the flat line, after hitting January lows of 61.7 euros earlier in the session, as the carmaker reported a 27% drop in auto profits and cut its annual profit margin forecast. ThyssenKrupp, meanwhile, sank around 8% after cutting its 2024 forecast. The French market, reflected in the CAC40, closed with gains. The biggest gainer was Essilor with a 7.4% rise, after announcing a 5.2% increase in its revenues in the second quarter. Hermès rose 3.4% and Dassault Systèmes 3.6%. In addition, Vinci shares rose 3.5%, despite a decline in first-half net income, thanks to an increase in total revenues. Shares in Capgemini, on the other hand, fell nearly 2.5% after the IT group cut its revenue growth forecast for the year, due to a slowdown in the automotive and aerospace sectors. The FTSE 100 +1.21%; CAC 40 +1.22%; DAX +0.65%; STOXX 600 +0.83% all ended with positive returns.

Asia:

Major Asian indices closed with mostly positive returns. The Chinese market closed positive, as risk sentiment improved, while investors continued to assess the impact of surprise rate cuts on the economy. On Thursday, the People's Bank of China cut its one-year medium-term lending facility rate by 20 basis points to 2.3% in an effort to support the economy with monetary stimulus. Elsewhere, in the Hong Kong market, the Hang Seng index ended with gains, helped by a strong rally in U.S. futures ahead of today's PCE data and next week's Federal Reserve monetary policy decision. The South Korean market ended higher, boosted by a rebound in chipmakers and strong second-quarter earnings reports. Chip giant Samsung Electronics rose 0.6%, while its counterpart SK Hynix gained 1%. In addition, financial stocks rose, with KB Financial soaring 4.6% after solid second-quarter net income and sales. The Japanese market closed lower as investors prepared for next week's Bank of Japan monetary policy meeting, which could see a rate hike. Data also showed that Tokyo's core inflation rate accelerated for the third consecutive month in July, supporting the tightening outlook for domestic monetary policy. The Australian market ended higher, thanks to gains in large mining stocks after China implemented unexpected interest rate cuts, boosting the outlook for the top metals consumer. Iron ore miners led the rise, with gains from BHP Group (2.4%), Rio Tinto (3.1%) and Fortescue (1.1%). Thus, NIKKEI -0.53%; HANG SENG +0.10%; CSI 300 +0.29%; S&P/ASX 200 +0.76%; KOSPI +0.78%; SHANGHAI COMPOSITE +0.14% ended with mostly positive returns.


