## LATAM

Peru: The General Index of the Lima Stock Exchange (BVL) ended today's session with a positive result of +0.28%. The index maintains a positive cumulative annual trend of +9.94% in local currency and a positive cumulative trend of +9.02% in dollar-adjusted terms. The S&P/BVL Peru SEL varied by -0.04%, while the S&P/BVL LIMA 25 dropped by -0.17%. The spot PEN reached S/.3.7364. Headline: MTC considers changes to the bypass road between Chancay and Chancaillo.

Chile: The IPSA index ended the day with a positive return of +0.57%. The most benefited sectors of the day were Communication Services (+3.10%) and Basic Consumer Goods (+1.10%). The best-performing stocks were EMPRESA NACIONAL DE TELECOM (+3.10%) and EMBOTELLADORA ANDINA (+2.86%). Headline: Boric states that the UNDP report "confirms that structural changes are desired gradually."

Colombia: The COLCAP index closed the session with a positive return of +0.51%. The most benefited sectors of the day were Utilities (+2.16%) and Non-basic Consumer Products (+1.73%). The best-performing stocks were INTERCONEXION ELECTRICA (+5.27%) and PROMIGAS (+3.20%). Headline: Ministry of Finance explains the composition of the 2025 Budget.

Mexico: The IPC index closed the day in positive territory at +0.09%. The most benefited sectors of the day were Finance (+1.08%) and Health (+0.78%). The best-performing stocks were ALFA S.A.B (+3.37%) and PROMOTORA Y OPERADORA DE INF (+2.20%). Headline: Pemex closes deal to 'revive' the massive Ku-Maloob-Zaap field: What is the agreement about?

Brazil: The IBOVESPA index closed the day in positive territory at +0.69%. The most benefited sectors of the day were Non-basic Consumer Products (+3.44%) and Health (+2.83%). The best-performing stocks were Basic Consumer Goods (+2.00%) and Utilities (+1.89%). Headline: The project on state debt includes changes that could lower the spending floor in health and other modifications.



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## WORLD

### United States:

The U.S. market closed with negative results. The DOW JONES index closed positive after CPI data revealed a year-over-year increase in consumer prices of 2.9% in July, marking the first time since 2021 that headline inflation fell below 3%. The data reassured investors and sparked speculation that the Federal Reserve could begin cutting interest rates as early as next month. The S&P 500 index closed in positive territory, where financial and energy stocks outperformed, while communication services lagged, led by a 2.3% drop in Alphabet shares after a report suggested that the U.S. Department of Justice is considering options, including the possible dissolution of the company. Finally, the NASDAQ ended slightly in the green. Among large-cap stocks, Apple rose 0.2%, its sixth consecutive day of gains and longest streak since early July, while Nvidia added 1.6% and Broadcom gained 1%. Thus, the DOW JONES +0.61%, the S&P 500 +0.38% and the NASDAQ +0.03% ended with negative returns.

### Europe:

The main European indices closed in positive territory after the US CPI came in line with expectations. In addition, inflation in the United Kingdom came in below expectations, a decision that makes the idea of interest rate cuts more difficult. On the corporate front, the automotive sector led the gains with Stellantis (1.5%) and Mercedes-Benz (1.5%). The British market, reflected in the FTSE 100, closed with gains after the country's CPI for July increased less than expected. In general, all sectors made gains, with the exception of the industrial metals mining sector. In addition, inflation rose to 2.2%, which was below expectations. Similarly, the German market closed in positive territory with companies such as Adidas (1.8%), Rhenimetal (1.9%), Hannover Re (2.1%) and Munich Re (2%) leading the rise. Finally, the main index of the Paris Stock Exchange rose after July's inflation figures were slightly up. Finally, with respect to companies Hermes (1.8%), LVMH (1.5%), Stellantis NV (1.5%) and Michelin (1.4%) were upward drivers. Thus, FTSE 100 +0.56%; CAC 40 +0.79%; DAX +0.41%; STOXX X 600 +0.49% ended with positive performances.

### Asia:

The Chinese market ended the session with gains. This week, traders will review recent results from Foxconn Industrial, China United Network and Shanghai Airport, among other companies. In terms of economic data, China's industrial production, retail sales and unemployment figures will be released on Thursday. Meanwhile, reports revealed that new loans granted by Chinese banks in July fell short of expectations. In the South Korean market as measured by the Kospi index closed with gains. Samsung Electronics' largest labor union in South Korea plans a four-day strike starting Thursday due to wage disputes. In economic news, South Korea's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate fell to 2.5% in July, the lowest since October, after holding at 2.8% for four months. In Hong Kong, the Hang Seng index closed in the red as investors awaited the results of Tencent Holdings and its share buyback plans. The main losers were Hansoh Pharmaceutical, Innocent Biologics and Sinopharm Group who fell by 3.8%, 2.7% and 2.4% respectively. In Japan, the Nikkei index closed with gains, as a Reuters Tankan survey revealed that business confidence among manufacturers weakened slightly in August due to low demand from China. In addition, Prime Minister Fumio Kishida announced that he will not run for re-election as party leader in September. In the Australian market, returns were positive. Commonwealth Bank rose 1.1% after reporting a smaller-than-anticipated drop in annual profit. AGL Energy also advanced 2% after the power company reported a near threefold increase in annual profit. In summary, NIKKEI +0.58%; HANG SENG -0.35%; CSI 300 -0.75%; S&P/ASX 200 +0.30%; KOSPI +0.88%; SHANGHAI COMPOSITE +0.60% ended with mixed performances.
