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LATAM

Peru: The BVL General index ended today's session with a negative result of -0.50%. The index maintains a positive annual cumulative trend of +8.81% in local currency and a positive cumulative trend of +7.68% in dollar-adjusted currency. The S&P/BVL Peru SEL varied -0.31% while the S&P/BVL LIMA 25 varied -0.35%. The spot PEN reached S/3.7364. **Headline:** Mincetur: We are close to inaugurate 10 tourism works for an amount of S/ 85.7 million.

Chile: The IPSA index ended the day with a negative return of -0.97%. The sectors that lost the most during the day were Non-Basic Consumer Products (-1.55%) and Materials (-1.32%). The worst performing stocks were SOC Inversiones Oro Blanco (-4.41%) and Cencosud SA (-1.99%). **Headline:** Market forecasts a low CPI for August thanks to food, but this will not prevent the annual figure from approaching 5%.

Colombia: The COLCAP index ended the session with a negative return of -0.20%. The most negatively affected sectors of the day were Finance (-0.93%) and Energy (-0.76%). The worst performing stocks were Canacol Energy Ltd (-2.31%) and Grupo de Inversiones Suramerica (-2.23%). **Headline:** Will ticket prices go up with the importation of jet fuel?

Mexico: The IPC index closed the day in negative territory at -1.31%. The worst performing sectors of the day were Real Estate (-4.47%) and Health Care (-2.92%). The worst performing stocks were Corp Inmobiliaria Vesta SAB de (-4.47%) and El Puerto de Liverpool SAB (-4.21%). **Headline:** 'Not to be taken seriously': AML0 to rating agencies that threaten to downgrade Mexico's rating.

Brazil: The IBOVESPA index closed the day in negative territory, -0.08%. The sectors that lost the most during the day were Health (-1.41%) and Energy (-1.06%). The worst performing stocks were São Martinho SA (-3.49%) and Petroreconcavo S/A (-2.73%). **Headline:** Brazilian revenue growth may be 'leaking' to online gaming and betting, suggests Galípolo.

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WORLD

United States:

The U.S. market closed with positive performance. The DOW JONES ended in the green after hitting a record high. The tech sector led the day's gains, with Nvidia's (+1.5%) highly anticipated results expected to influence the tech sector and AI investments. The S&P 500 index also closed in the green, as corporate news included Apple's (+0.4%) replacement of its CFO and Paramount's (-7.1%) acquisition by Skydance Media nearing completion. Eli Lilly (+0.4%) announced that its weight-loss drug Zepbound is now available at a significantly lower price than other weight-loss medications for self-pay patients. Lastly, the NASDAQ index ended the day in the green, as investors await Nvidia's earnings report, which will determine the market's direction. Thus, DOW JONES +0.02%, S&P 500 +0.16%, NASDAQ +0.16%, with the market showing positive performance.

Europe:

Major European indices closed with mostly positive returns. The pan-European STOXX 600 index closed with gains, supported by key mining stocks in the broader index, as the London Stock Exchange reopened after a long weekend. Markets were also still assessing the latest economic data and gauging potential responses from major central banks. In the UK market, the FTSE index closed the session in positive territory, with investors looking ahead to corporate earnings and awaiting this week's key economic data, including the U.S. per capita consumption report. Bunzl led gains in London, rallying more than 10%, after increasing its interim dividend by 10%, launching a €250 million share buyback and raising its guidance for the year in its results. Similarly, the German market closed in the green, where gains were led by technology stocks, as the market prepared for Nvidia's key results to be released tomorrow after the close. Elsewhere, domestic consumer confidence, as measured by GfK, unexpectedly fell to its lowest level since May, underscoring weak confidence in the German economy following yesterday's poor Ifo results. In the French market, the session closed in the red as luxury stocks weighed on the index as investors awaited this week's key economic data, including Friday's EU inflation figures, which could offer clues on the ECB's future policy stance. Attention is also focused on domestic data from France, in particular preliminary inflation figures and the final reading of Q2 GDP. Thus, STOXX 600 +0.16%; FTSE 100 +0.21%; DAX +0.35%; CAC 40 -0.32% closed with mostly positive performances.

Asia:

The main Asian indices closed with mixed performances. The Chinese market closed negative in response to the People's Bank of China's decision to leave the one- and five-year interest rates unchanged. Despite this, the market continues to anticipate further monetary policy easing to boost China's economic growth. Companies that posted significant losses included Seres Group (-1.7%), Chongqing Changan (-4.3%), Dazhong Transportation (-2%), Xiamen King Long (-6.8%) and Foxconn Industrial (-0.6%). The South Korean market closed in positive territory, boosted by the technological rally on Wall Street. Investors are also awaiting the minutes of the latest US Federal Reserve meeting, which will be released on Wednesday. They are also looking ahead to the Bank of Korea's interest rate decision on Thursday, where it is expected to remain steady. On the other hand, the Hang Seng index is in negative territory. The drop came after Goldman Sachs warned of increased downside risks to Chinese GDP growth. Among the hardest hit stocks were Tencent Holdings (-0.7%) and Meituan (-1.0%), as well as Smoore International (-6.0%), China Resources Beer (-5.8%) and JD Health International (-5.0%). The Japanese market also closed in positive territory due to the rebound of the technology sector on Wall Street. In addition, traders are keeping a close eye on the yen's movements, concerned about its impact on carry trades. Japan's inflation figures are expected on Friday, which could influence the Bank of Japan's policy. The Australian market ended positive, boosted by strong Wall Street and a rise in local equities. Recent minutes from the Reserve Bank of Australia suggested that interest rates will remain steady for a while, although a rate hike was considered earlier in the month. Stocks leading the gains were BHP Group (1.3%), Fortescue (1.5%), Rio Tinto (0.6%) and Northern Star Resources (0.8%) and South32 (1.7%). Thus, NIKKEI +1.80%; HANG SENG -0.33%; CSI 300 -0.72%; S&P/ASX 200 +0.22%; KOSPI +0.83%; SHANGHAI COMPOSITE -0.93% ended with mixed performances.


