## LATAM

**Peru:** The LSE General index ended today's session with a positive result of +0.99%. The index maintains a positive accumulated annual trend of +9.03% in local currency and a positive accumulated trend of +6.58% in dollar-adjusted currency. Regarding the S&P/BVL Peru SEL, it varied +0.54% while the S&P/BVL LIMA 25 varied +0.54%. The PEN spot reached S/. 3.7755. Headline: BCRP: Peru reached historical record of continuous single digit inflation

**Chile:** The IPSA index ended the day with a negative return of -0.43%. The sectors that lost the most during the day were Industrials (-1.49%) and Materials (-0.70%). The worst performing stocks were Sociedad de Inversiones Oro BI (-4.24%) and Compañía Sud Americana de Vapo (-3.19%). Headline: Market surprised by more expansionary monetary tone and concern over weak demand.

**Colombia:** The COLCAP index ended the session with a positive return of +0.41%. The sectors that benefited the most during the day were Non Basic Consumer Products (+1.71%) and Unclassified (+1.10%). The best performing stocks were Corporación Financiera Colombi (+2.24%) and BanColombia SA (+2.08%). Headline: The undesired effects of the transporters' blockades on interest rates.

**Mexico:** The IPC index closed the day in negative territory at -0.29%. The worst performing sectors of the day were Health Care (-1.02%) and Non-Basic Consumer Products (-0.75%). The worst performing stocks were Bedel SAB de CV (-3.71%) and Regional SAB de CV (-2.99%). Headline: Mexican exports to the U.S. reach historic level in July

**Brazil:** The IBOVESPA index closed the day in positive territory, +0.29%. The day's top gainers were Non-Basic Consumer Products (+1.49%) and Communication Services (+1.35%). The best performing stocks were IRB-Brasil Resseguros SA (+6.14%) and MRV Engenharia e Participações (+5.99%). Headline: Blocking X in Brazil costs Musk millions of users, but has little impact on business revenue



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## WORLD

### United States:

The U.S. market closed with mixed results. The DOW JONES index closed negative as investors adjusted their positions ahead of Friday's crucial jobs report. These provided mixed signals about the health of the economy. In August, private payroll growth was the weakest since January 2021, with only 99,000 new jobs, well below expectations. However, weekly jobless claims fell, providing some relief. The S&P 500 index closed in negative territory, given concerns about lower job openings data that increased worries about a possible recession and how the Federal Reserve might handle future interest rate cuts. On the corporate side, the healthcare sector led losses, with Eli Lilly falling 3.5% and UnitedHealth down 1.5%. Finally, the NASDAQ ended positive, mainly on positive corporate results in the consumer discretionary sector that was highlighted by strong results from Amazon (+2.6%) and Tesla (+4.9%). Thus, the DOW JONES -0.54%, the S&P 500 +0.30% and the NASDAQ +0.25% ended with negative returns.

### Europe:

Major European indices ended the session with negative returns. The pan-European STOXX 600 index closed lower on Thursday. The main declines came from Paris-based luxury majors, with Hermes plunging 6.4% following reports that its CFO anticipated slower revenue growth at a roadshow in Paris. LVMH and Ferrari were also down 3.6% and 2.5%, respectively. The technology sector also contributed to the losses, with ASML and SAP falling 2.3% and 1.1%. The UK market, reflected in the FTSE 100, closed with negative results. Among individual companies, AB Foods, owner of Primark, led the losses with a fall of 8.5% after reporting a decline in same-store sales over the past six months. In addition, Admiral, Antofagasta, DS Smith, Aviva, Croda, IAG and Prudential weakened as they traded without dividend entitlement. The German market, reflected in the DAX index closed negative, its third consecutive session of losses since reaching an all-time high on Monday, and following the poor momentum in European equities as markets' position for volatility ahead of tomorrow's US jobs report. Siemens and SAP each retreated nearly 1%, while Airbus fell 1.4% and Rheinmetall fell 1.6%. The French market closed the session in the red with sharp declines in the luxury sector. Kering was down 1.4% to €245, a level not seen since April 2017. In addition, shares of Schneider Electric, Essilor, Air Liquide and Dassault Systèmes fell between 2% and 4.2%. Thus, FTSE 100 -0.34%; CAC 40 -0.92%; DAX -0.08%; STOXX 600 -0.54% ended with negative returns.

### Asia:

The major Asian indices closed with mostly mixed returns. The Chinese market ended in the green, recovering some losses from the previous session as risk sentiment improved, while investors continued to assess economic and policy prospects in China. On the other hand, the Hong Kong market saw the Hang Seng index close lower, falling for the fourth consecutive session and reaching its lowest level in two weeks due to declines in the consumer and financial sectors. The Japanese market ended in red, extending losses from the previous session and following another down day on Wall Street amid a rocky start to September. Investors also absorbed data showing that real wages in Japan increased for the second consecutive month in July, reinforcing expectations that the Bank of Japan will raise interest rates again before the end of the year. The South Korean market closed with negative returns, as investors remained cautious ahead of the U.S. employment report expected later this week. Locally, the Bank of Korea indicated a possible policy shift by the end of this year, suggesting that inflation is likely to remain stable. The Australian market finished in the green, recovering some of the previous session's losses thanks to a rebound in technology and financial stocks. Meanwhile, Reserve Bank of Australia Governor Michele Bullock reiterated that the central bank decided to keep rates unchanged at the August meeting as inflation remains too high. Thus, NIKKEI -1.05%; HANG SENG -0.07%; CSI 300 +0.17%; S&P/ASX 200 +0.40%; KOSPI -0.21%, SHANGHAI COMPOSITE +0.14% ended with mixed returns.




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
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### Principal Metals Index (3 months)
