LATAM

Peru: The BVL General index ended today's session with a negative result of -0.97%. The index maintains a positive annual cumulative trend of +7.89% in local currency and a positive cumulative trend of +5.04% in dollar-adjusted currency. Regarding the S&P/BVL Peru SEL, it varied -0.62% while the S&P/BVL LIMA 25 varied -0.26%. The spot PEN reached S/3.8056. Headline: Petroperu: what Fitch Ratings says about the state-owned oil company's situation.

Chile: The IPSA index ended the day with a negative return of -0.28%. The sectors that lost the most during the day were Communication services (-1.96%) and Consumer staples (-0.82%). The worst performing stocks were Sociedad de Inversiones Oro BI (-3.68%) and Embotelladora Andina SA (-2.41%). Headline: Vice-president of the Central Bank says that job creation is "weak" and increase in informality is "worrisome".

Colombia: The COLCAP index ended the session with a negative return of -0.32%. The worst performing sectors of the day were Energy (-1.63%) and Utilities (-0.63%). The worst performing stocks were Canacol Energy Ltd (-4.34%) and Sociedades Bolívar SA (-2.10%). Headline: Financing law is not spared from the 'garrote': reactions to the new bill.

Mexico: The IPC index closed the day in negative territory, -1.72%. The worst performing sectors of the day were Communication services (-2.77%) and Non-basic consumer products (-1.13%). The worst performing stocks were Alsea SAB de CV (-3.37%) and Regional SAB de CV (-3.19%). Headline: HSBC navigates in the opposite direction to Citi and Banamex: analyzes merger of commercial and investment banking.

Brazil: The IBOVESPA index closed the day in negative territory, -0.31%. The sectors that lost the most during the day were Energy (-1.77%) and Materials (-0.67%). The worst performing stocks were Ultrapar Participações SA (-3.91%) and Sendas Distribuidora S/A (-3.78%). Headline: IPCA is negative 0.02% in August, the first deflation since June 2023.



WORLD

United States:

The U.S. market closed with mixed performances. The DOW JONES ended in the red, driven by steep declines in banking stocks. JPMorgan fell 5.2% after lowering its expectations for net interest income in 2025, while Goldman Sachs dropped 4.4% due to weak trading revenue projections. Additionally, investors were preparing for a crucial inflation report expected to influence the Federal Reserve's upcoming interest rate cuts. The S&P 500 index finished in the green, marking its second consecutive day of gains. On the other hand, politics also took center stage, with Kamala Harris and Donald Trump set to face off in their first televised debate tonight, adding more uncertainty to market sentiment. Lastly, the NASDAQ index ended the day in the green, as tech stocks, including Nvidia (+1.5%), Microsoft (+2.1%), and Amazon (+2.4%), provided some support, lifting the Nasdaq 100 by 0.9%. Among other stocks, Oracle shares surged 11.5% after beating earnings estimates and securing a deal with Amazon Web Services. Apple closed 0.3% lower following a court defeat in its \$14 billion tax dispute in Ireland. Thus, DOW JONES -0.23%, S&P 500 +0.45%, NASDAQ +0.84%, with the market showing mixed results.

Europe:

Major European indices closed with negative returns. The pan-European STOXX 600 index closed with losses as most sectors and major indices entered negative territory. The automotive sector was the worst performer, falling 3.8% after Continental announced that it would have to set aside a significant amount of money due to a warranty problem with one of its brake systems. In the English market, the FTSE index closed the session in the red as traders were more cautious awaiting key US inflation data and the ECB's policy decision this week. In addition, wage growth slowed in the first three months of July to its lowest level in more than two years, reinforcing expectations of further interest rate cuts by the Bank of England. Similarly, the German market closed in the red, where Continental shares plummeted by more than 10% after the car parts supplier announced provisions worth double-digit millions of euros due to a warranty issue with one of its brake systems. On the French market, the session closed in the red, as traders remained cautious awaiting US inflation data and the European Central Bank's policy decision this week. Market participants are also closely monitoring final French inflation data, expected on Friday. Thus, STOXX 600 -0.54%; FTSE 100 -0.78%; DAX -0.96%; CAC 40 -0.24% closed with negative returns.

Asia:

The main Asian indices closed with mixed performances. The Chinese market closed positive, this movement was influenced by China's trade surplus data which indicated growth in the month of August, mainly explained by higher exports versus expectations. On the corporate front, Zhongguo Innolight rose 4.3%, Eoptolink Technology 1.7% and Zhejiang Wanfeng 4.1%. The South Korean market closed negative, affected mainly by the chip and battery sector. Investors were keeping an eye on upcoming US inflation data, which could influence a possible rate cut by the US central bank. In South Korea, industrial credit growth slowed in the second quarter, rising by 25 trillion won to 1.941.6 trillion won from 27 trillion won in the previous quarter. On the other hand, the Hang Seng index is in positive territory, after being in the red during the morning session. The consumer, technology and financial sectors led the gains. On the corporate front Ssangyong China rose 3.9% following the announcement by its majority shareholder Las Vegas Sands Corp. to increase its stake in the company. The Japanese market also closed in negative territory. Expectations of tighter monetary policy from the Bank of Japan drove the yen's rally since mid-July and led to a dismantling of the yen carry trade, which also put pressure on local equities. In economic data, Japan's second-quarter GDP growth was revised downward, although the latest figures showed rising wages and persistent inflationary pressures. The Australian market ended positive, boosted by optimism on Wall Street. In economic data, consumer confidence in Australia declined in September, while business confidence fell to a nine-month low in August. Thus, NIKKEI -0.16%; HANG SENG +0.22%; CSI 300 +0.09%; S&P/ASX 200 +0.30%; KOSPI -0.49%, SHANGHAI COMPOSITE +0.28% ended with mixed performances.




Market Intraday Evolution (var %)




Principal Metals Index (3 months)


