## LATINOAMERICA

Peru: The BVL General index ended today's session with a positive result of +0.64%. The index maintains a positive annual cumulative trend of +16.08% in local currency and a positive cumulative trend of +15.65% in dollar-adjusted currency. With respect to the S&P/BVL Peru SEL, it varied by +0.81% while the S&P/BVL LIMA 25 by +0.25%. The spot PEN reached S/3.6991. Headline: China responds to international "nervousness" over its investments in Peru.

Chile: The IPSA index ended the day with a negative return of -0.64%. The sectors that lost the most during the day were Communication Services (-1.52%) and Real Estate (-1.18%). The worst performing stocks were Empresas CMPC SA (-2.81%) and SACI Falabella (-2.31%). Headline: Budget 2025 opens debate on the magnitude of the increase in spending and whether it contributes to the achievement of fiscal goals.

Colombia: The COLCAP index ended the session with a negative return of -0.03%. The sectors that lost the most during the day were Utilities (-0.46%) and Financials (-0.26%). The worst performing stocks were Interconexión Eléctrica SA ESP (-2.11%) and Grupo Aval Acciones y Valores (-0.95%). Headline: Labor reform: how many and which articles have been approved so far in the House of Representatives.

Mexico: The IPC index closed the day in negative territory -0.57%. The worst performing sectors of the day were Materials (-1.54%) and Financials (-1.11%). The worst performing stocks were Industrias Peñoles SAB de CV (-3.84%) and Grupo Financiero Inbursa SA (-2.83%). Headline: Sheinbaum limits oil production before energy transition: How many barrels per day will she produce?

Brazil: The IBOVESPA index closed the day in positive territory of +0.51%. The sectors that benefited the most during the day were Energy (+2.40%) and Consumer Staples (+2.33%). The best performing stocks were MRV Engenharia e Participações (+4.56%) and Ambev SA (+3.98%). Headline: Haddad celebrates Moody's upgrade of Brazil's rating and acknowledges that there is work to be done in spending and revenues.





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
### MILA: Evolución Intraday




### MILA: Curvas de Deuda Soverana




### MILA: Índices de Tipo de Cambio ( 3 meses )

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## MUNDO

### Estados Unidos:

The US market closed with negative returns. The DOW JONES closed in the red, as investors reacted to Iran's retaliatory missile strikes against Israel and a series of economic data. Iran launched a barrage of missiles at Israel in response to Israel's invasion of southern Lebanon, intensifying tensions in the region. The S&P 500 ended in the red, as in economic news, job openings in August unexpectedly rose to 8.04 million, up from 7.71 million in July, indicating that while the labor market is cooling, it's not doing so rapidly. Meanwhile, US manufacturing activity remained stagnant in September, with the ISM manufacturing PMI steady at 47.2, signaling ongoing contraction. Lastly, the NASDAQ index finished the day in the red, as tech stocks struggled, with Apple and Nvidia dropping 2.9% and 3.7%, respectively. In contrast, energy companies rose along with oil prices, led by Exxon Mobil's 2.3% gain. Defense stocks, including Northrop Grumman (3%) and Lockheed Martin (3.6%), also benefited from geopolitical tensions. Thus, DOW JONES -0.41%, S&P 500 -0.93%, NASDAQ -0.91%, with the market posting negative returns.

### Europa:

The main European indices closed with mostly negative performances. The pan-European STOXX 600 index closed with losses, following news that the US detected signs that Iran is preparing a missile attack against Israel. On the economic front, eurozone inflation fell to 1.8% in September, its lowest level since 2021, below the expected 1.9%. This decline increases the chances of an interest rate cut by the European Central Bank. In the UK market, the FTSE index closed the session in positive territory as markets continued to assess the outlook for monetary policy from major central banks and gauge geopolitical risks. Federal Reserve Chairman Jerome Powell signaled that he central bank will lower interest rates "over time" and opposed calls for another sharp rate cut of 50 basis points this month. In addition, Megan Greene, head of monetary policy at the Bank of England, noted that the stickiness of UK services inflation is a concern and threatens the sustainability of lower overall price growth. Similarly, the German market closed in the red, where both German and Eurozone manufacturing PMIs were revised slightly higher, but continued to point to deep contractions in the sector. SAP (1.4%), Airbus (0.6%), Bayer (1.4%), Vonovia (0.8%) and Rheinmetall (1.3%) posted gains. In the French market, the session closed in the red, pressured by luxury stocks. LVMH, Hermès and Kering plunged 3.6%, 2.7% and 2.9%, respectively, amid a pessimistic outlook for demand in the main markets. Thus, STOXX 600 -0.38%; FTSE 100 +0.48%; DAX -0.58%; CAC 40 -0.81% closed with mostly negative performances.

### Asia:

The main Asian indices closed with mixed performances. The Chinese market closed positive, boosted by an economic stimulus package from Beijing that attracted investors. Indices reached one-year highs, rising more than 20% since September. The measures included easing homeowner rules and reducing mortgage rates, as well as lowering banks' reserve requirements and interest rates to encourage lending. The South Korean market closed negative affected by losses in the chip and auto sectors. There was also pressure on financial stocks. Investors anticipate that the Bank of Korea will cut interest rates following the U.S. Federal Reserve's rate cuts. In August 2024, retail sales and industrial production rebounded, but the Kospi index posted its third consecutive monthly decline. Markets will be closed on Tuesday and Thursday for public holidays. On the other hand, the Hang Seng index is in negative territory, with gains in all sectors. The index rose 17.5% month-on-month and had its biggest quarterly rise since 2009, boosted by China's measures to support its economic recovery. The Japanese market also closed in positive territory. The depreciation of the yen improved the outlook for Japanese export industries. Japanese stocks also followed Wall Street's rise, boosted by Federal Reserve Chairman Powell's comments on future interest rate cuts in the U.S. The Australian market ended in negative territory, with the financial and commodity sectors leading the losses. In Australia, better retail sales in August reduced the likelihood of a rate cut by the Reserve Bank of Australia (RBA). Thus, NIKKEI +1.93%; HANG SENG +2.43%; CSI 300 +4.33%; S&P/ASX 200 -0.74%; KOSPI -2.13%; SHANGHAI COMPOSITE +8.06% ended with mixed performances.





### Mercado Evolución Intraday (var %)




### Índices de Tipo de Cambio (3 meses)








