

LATAM

Peru: The General Index of the BVL ended today's session with a positive result of +0.74%. The index maintains a positive cumulative annual trend of +18.52% in local currency and +16.97% in dollar-adjusted terms. The S&P/BVL Peru SEL rose by +0.97%, while the S&P/BVL Lima 25 increased by +0.63%. The PEN spot rate reached S/.3.7544. Headline: Indecopi approves the acquisition of Grupo Chema by Sika with conditions.

Chile: The IPSA index closed the day with a positive return of +1.09%. The best-performing sectors were Materials (+2.11%) and Industrials (+1.65%). The top-performing stocks were Sociedad Química y Minera Chile-B (+3.07%) and Quiñenco S.A. (+1.99%). Headline: Boric states that he was informed on Tuesday "of a complaint, not of its content" against Monsalve and acknowledges that the former undersecretary reviewed hotel cameras.

Colombia: The COLCAP index ended the session with a positive return of +1.17%. The best-performing sectors were Financials (+2.36%) and Energy (+1.18%). The top-performing stocks were Corporación Financiera Colombiana-Pref Sec (+4.93%) and Banco Davivienda SA (+4.17%). Headline: Sorrow and indignation grow in the country over the murder of young Sofía Delgado.

Mexico: The IPC index closed the day with a positive return of +1.08%. The best-performing sectors were Materials (+1.45%) and Consumer Discretionary (+1.44%). The top-performing stocks were Industrias Peñoles SAB de CV (+4.31%) and Alfa S.A.B.-A (+3.43%). Headline: Hacienda freezes tax incentives for Premium gasoline and diesel: What happens to Magna?

Brazil: The IBOVESPA index closed the day in negative territory, down by -0.22%. The most affected sectors were Industrials (-1.07%) and Consumer Discretionary (-1.04%). The worst-performing stocks were Atacadão SA (-4.25%) and Brava Energia (-3.53%). Headline: Child labor falls to its lowest level in the historical series, but Brazil still has 1.6 million in this situation.

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WORLD

United States:

The U.S. market closed with positive returns. The DOW JONES closed in the green, led by strong gains in the technology sector following Netflix's upbeat earnings report. The U.S. streaming company rose 11% after reporting better-than-expected third-quarter earnings, revenue and subscriber growth. The S&P 500 index finished in the green. Apple shares rose 1.2% after an industry report showed an increase in iPhone sales in China. Nvidia (0.7%), Amazon (0.7%) and Alphabet (0.3%) also finished in the green. Finally, the NASDAQ index ended the day in the green. The US government posted a budget surplus of \$64 billion in September 2024, compared to a deficit of \$170 billion in the same period last year and slightly above estimates, which pointed to a surplus of \$61 billion. Thus, DOW JONES +0.09%, S&P 500 +0.40% and NASDAQ +0.63% ended with positive results.

Europe:

The major European indices ended the session with mixed performances. The pan-European STOXX 600 closed higher, supported by bets that the European Central Bank (ECB) will continue lowering its key interest rates, as well as by favorable developments for stocks with significant exposure to China. The UK market, represented by the FTSE 100, ended in the red, as investors assessed an unexpected rise in UK retail sales, which grew by 0.3% in September compared to an expected decline of 0.3%. Gains in the industrial metal miners' sector, which rose by 1.3% thanks to higher copper prices amid Chinese stimulus, helped limit losses. Germany's market closed higher, following gains from its European peers, as traders continued to digest higher-than-expected US inflation data while awaiting further stimulus updates from China over the weekend. France's CAC 40 also closed with gains, driven by a rebound in luxury stocks, as economic support measures from the People's Bank of China (PBoC) benefited companies with large exposure to China. Additionally, strong results from Italy's Brunello Cucinelli further boosted luxury stocks. As a result, FTSE 100 -0.32%; CAC 40 +0.39%; DAX +0.38%; STOXX 600 +0.21% finished the day with mixed performances.

Asia:

Major Asian indices closed with mixed performances. The Chinese market closed positive after the Chinese central bank launched a loan program to support share buybacks of qualified companies and opened a swap line to bolster liquidity for financial companies. The PBOC also announced that it could further reduce banks' reserve requirements before the end of the year, depending on liquidity conditions. These surprise moves came as a relief to investors as the recent stimulus rally lost momentum following Beijing's lackluster fiscal policy plans. In the Hong Kong market, the Hang Seng index closed in the green, thanks to solid gains across all sectors. Traders welcomed the Chinese central bank's announcement of new details on measures to boost stock markets, shortly after official data showed the Chinese economy grew 4.6% year-on-year in Q3 2024, the slowest rise in six quarters. The South Korean market ended with negative results, weighed down by heavy losses in the chip manufacturing and shipbuilding sectors. SK Hynix, a chip giant, plunged 4.6%, while HD Heavy Industries, one of South Korea's leading shipbuilders, fell 2.8%. The Japanese market closed higher as slowing domestic inflation countered bullish bets on the Bank of Japan's monetary policy. Data showed Japan's headline and core inflation rates slowed to a five-month low of 2.5% and 2.4%, respectively, in September. The Australian market finished lower, with mining stocks leading the decline, amid weakness in underlying commodity prices. These moves came at a time when China's property sector failed to adopt aggressive stimulus measures, which hurt the outlook for metals demand. Thus, NIKKEI +0.18%; HANG SENG +3.61%; CSI 300 +3.62%; S&P/ASX 200 -0.87%; KOSPI -0.59%; SHANGHAI COMPOSITE +2.91% ended with mixed performances.


