

LATAM

Peru: The LSE General index ended today's session with a negative -0.30%. The index maintains a positive annual cumulative trend of +18.16% in local currency and a positive cumulative trend of +16.25% in dollar-adjusted currency. Regarding the S&P/BVL Peru SEL, it varied -0.10% while the S&P/BVL LIMA 25 varied +0.27%. The spot PEN reached S/.3.7660. **Headline:** Metax, Peruvian manufacturer seeks to export medical furniture to North America.

Chile: The IPSA index ended the day with a positive return +0.41%. The most benefited sectors of the day were Industrials (+1.92%) and Consumer Staples (+0.98%). The best performing stocks were South American Vapo Company (+2.82%) and Lan Airlines SA (+2.07%). **Headline:** The new reality? Investment banking anticipates that the Chilean economy will grow around 2% in the next decade.

Colombia: The COLCAP index ended the session with a negative return of -0.42%. The most negative sectors of the day were Energy (-2.02%) and Materials (-1.71%). The worst performing stocks were Interconexión Canacol Energy Ltd (-3.10%) and Inversiones Argos SA (-2.24%). **Headline:** Household spending is still "fragile and uneven", according to Raddar.

Mexico: The IPC index ended the day with a negative return -0.40%. The sectors that lost the most during the day were Finance (-1.52%) and Communication services (-0.94%). The worst performing stocks were Kimberly-Clark de México SAB d (-2.92%) and Grupo Aeroportuario del Centro (-2.79%). **Headline:** Mexico becomes the main supplier of technology to the US.

Brazil: The IBOVESPA index closed the day in negative territory at -0.11%. The sectors that lost the most during the day were Energy (-1.30%) and Health Care (-1.00%). The worst performing stocks were Hapvida Participacoes e Invest (-2.93%) and Petróleo Brasileiro SA (-1.83%). **Headline:** Bradesco changes projection and predicts higher interest rate hike in next Copom meeting.

WORLD

United States:

The US market closed with mixed results. The DOW JONES ended in the red after its longest weekly rally of the year, as investors prepared for another week filled with earnings reports, and rising Treasury yields dragged down consumer and homebuilder stocks. The S&P 500 also closed lower, with homebuilders and large-cap stocks retreating. Builders FirstSource (-5.2%) and Lennar (-4.3%) saw significant declines. Meanwhile, the NASDAQ ended the day in the green. Tesla (-0.8%) generated market anticipation ahead of its upcoming earnings report, despite some disappointment over its recent robotaxi unveiling. Boeing shares rose by 3.1% after news of a tentative union agreement, while Nvidia jumped 4.1%, reaching a record high. Thus, the DOW JONES closed down by -0.80%, the S&P 500 by -0.18%, and the NASDAQ ended up by +0.20%, resulting in mixed market performance.

Europe:

The main European indices closed with negative returns. The pan-European STOXX 600 index closed with negative returns. Most major sectors closed lower, led by insurance stocks, which fell by 0.9%, while oil and gas stocks gained 1.2%. In the corporate sector, investors are closely watching German software company SAP's third-quarter results (-0.9%), especially after last week's disappointing ASML report weighed on technology stocks. In the UK market, the FTSE index closed with negative returns. Most major sectors on the London Stock Exchange closed in the red, with Intertek, Easyjet and Entain falling between 4% and 2.5% to lead the losses. In addition, HSBC and Barclays lost about 2% each to pace the banks. In the French market, the session closed with negative returns. Among stocks, LVMH fell 2% and extended last week's heavy losses, when it reported disappointing third-quarter results, with revenue down 3% and, for the first time since the pandemic, a drop in sales in its key fashion and leather goods sector. The German market, as measured by the DAX index, closed in the red. German software giant SAP fell 0.9% ahead of its expected Q3 earnings report, with traders likely to scrutinize the results following last week's disappointing ASML report, which negatively impacted tech stocks. Thus, FTSE -0.48%; CAC 40 -1.01%; DAX -1.00%; STOXX 600 -0.66% closed with negative returns.

Asia:

Major Asian indices closed with mixed performances. The Chinese market closed in the green, extending the previous session's gains after the People's Bank of China cut one- and five-year lending rates by 25 basis points, as Governor Pan Gongsheng indicated last week. The decision is part of a broader monetary stimulus package to curb the slowdown in the world's second-largest economy. In the Hong Kong market, the Hang Seng index ended lower as traders were unimpressed by the 25 basis point cut in China's one- and five-year lending rates, as Bank of China Payments Governor Pan Gongsheng had already announced these measures last Friday. The South Korean market ended on a positive note as investors focused on third-quarter corporate earnings. An upbeat session on Wall Street on Friday also helped lift the market's mood. Index heavyweights such as chipmaker SK Hynix, automakers and financial companies will release their third-quarter results this week. The Japanese market ended lower amid political uncertainty ahead of Japan's general election this weekend. A slight rally in the yen also pressured local equities, as last week's drop to 150 to the dollar prompted further verbal interventions from Japanese authorities. The Australian market ended higher as strong corporate earnings bolstered investor confidence. In Australia, investors are looking forward to the latest PMI reports to gauge the strength of the economy and guide the outlook for monetary policy. Thus, NIKKEI -0.07%; HANG SENG -1.57%; CSI 300 +0.25%; S&P/ASX 200 -0.14%; KOSPI +0.43%; SHANGHAI COMPOSITE +0.20% ended with mixed performances.




