Peru: The General Index of the BVL of Peru ended today's session with a positive return of +0.23%. The index maintains a cumulative positive annual trend of +27.74% in local currency, while the yield adjusted to foreign currency is +32.42%. Then, the S&P/BVL Peru SEL obtained a positive result of +0.01%, while the S&P/BVL LIMA 25 grew +0.37%. The spot PEN reached S/3.2368.

Chile: The IPSA index ended the day with a negative result of -1.84%. The sectors of the index with the most negative results were Real Estate (-2.81%) and Materials (-2.41%). On the other hand, the values with the most bearish results were Saifacorp SA (-7.60%) and Inversiones La Construcción SA (-6.77%).

Colombia: The COLCAP index closed the session with negative results of +0.22%. The sectors with decreasing returns were Telecommunications Services (-0.39%) and Finance (-0.19%). In addition, the stocks with the lowest yields were Promigas SA (-4.64%) and Grupo Aval Acciones y Valores (-2.29%).

Mexico: Mexico's IPC index closed today's session with a negative yield of -0.13%. The sectors of the index that generated the most negative returns were Industrial (-0.86%) and Finance (-0.42%). Finally, the stocks with the lowest returns were Grupo México SAB de CV (-2.08%) and Wal-Mart de Mexico SAB de CV (-1.55%).

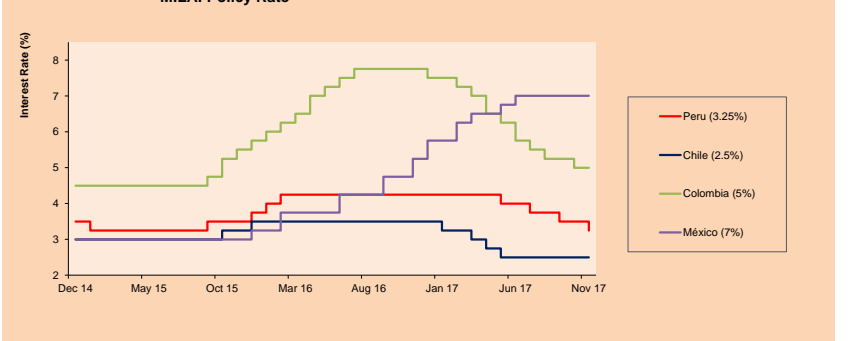

Global Overview

United States:

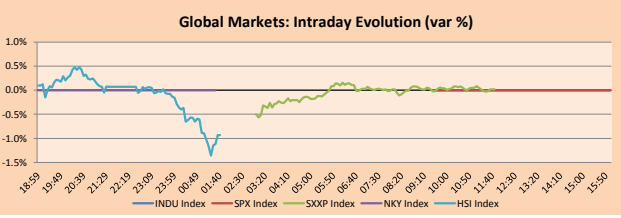
Closed Market, due to Thanksgiving.

Europe:

The European stock market closed today with mixed results among its main indices. Today's news was the performance of the French benchmark index "CAC 40", closing at its peak after November 10, according to FactSet. One of the reasons was the report presented by the Office of Statistics of France "Insee", which said that the confidence indicator of the manufacturing sector increased one point to 112 in November, which demonstrates the growing leadership of this country in the growth of the eurozone. Regarding the eurozone, the European benchmark index "Stoxx 600" closed positive. However, the financial sector and the services sector closed with red results. Meanwhile, the consumer goods sector and telecommunications stocks led the advances. In addition, a preliminary report on services and manufacturing activity had optimistic results exceeding analysts' expectations. The Composite Index of Purchasing Managers rose to 57.5 in November, its highest level since April 2011, said data firm IHS Markit. The analysts expected a reading without changes. On the side of the companies, Thyssenkrupp AG (TKA) won +4% after reporting that their earnings before interest and taxes increased 30% to 1.91 billion euros, exceeding the FactSet forecast of 1.74 billion euros.

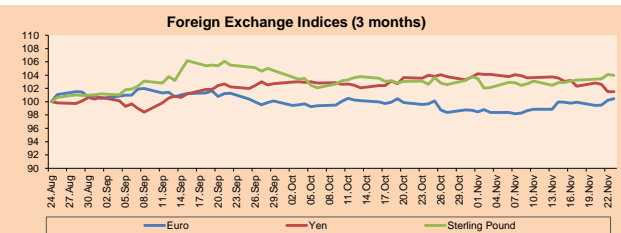
Asia:

The Asian stock market ended today's session with mixed results among its main indices. Among the news that stood out the most, in Japan, the markets are closed by Thanksgiving Day, just like the US markets. If after this date, the yen maintains its overnight gains, there is a high probability of the Tokyo shares to fall because the exporters will have to negotiate their goods with a more expensive price, taking away their international competitiveness. In South Korea, the Kospi benchmark fell 0.1% as investors continued to assess the impact of the new sanctions against North Korea. Regarding Australia, the S&P/ASX 200 stock index was slightly unchanged, as weakness in bank shares was offset by increases in commodity-related stocks (benefit caused by the depreciation of the US dollar). On the other hand, in China, the Shenzhen index fell by 2.9% after Beijing took measures to stop the proliferation of small online lenders, days after saying it plans to streamline oversight of asset-management products sold by financial institutions. According to some experts, investors are moving from smaller capitalization companies (which make up much of the Shenzhen) to larger capitalization companies.



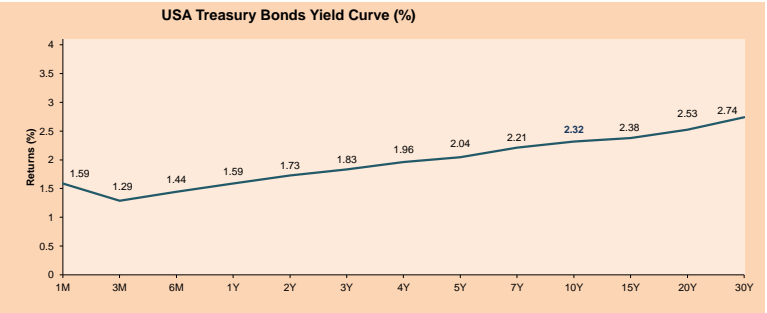
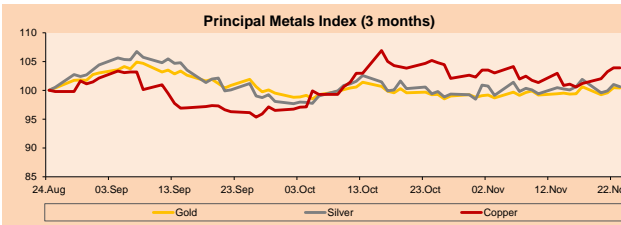

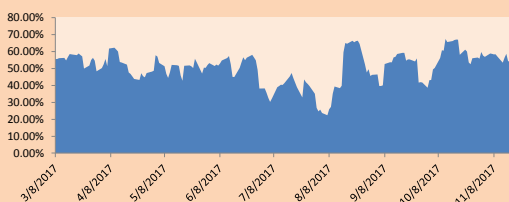

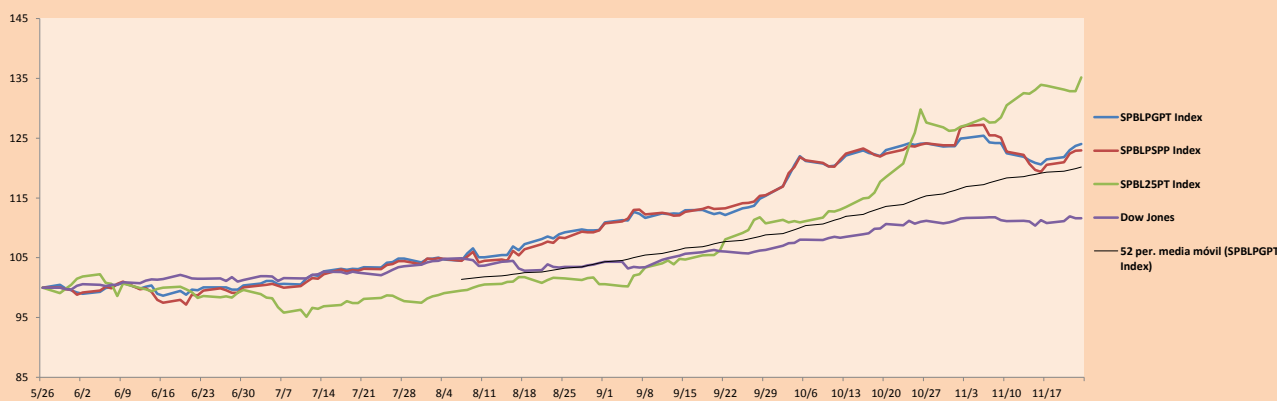
